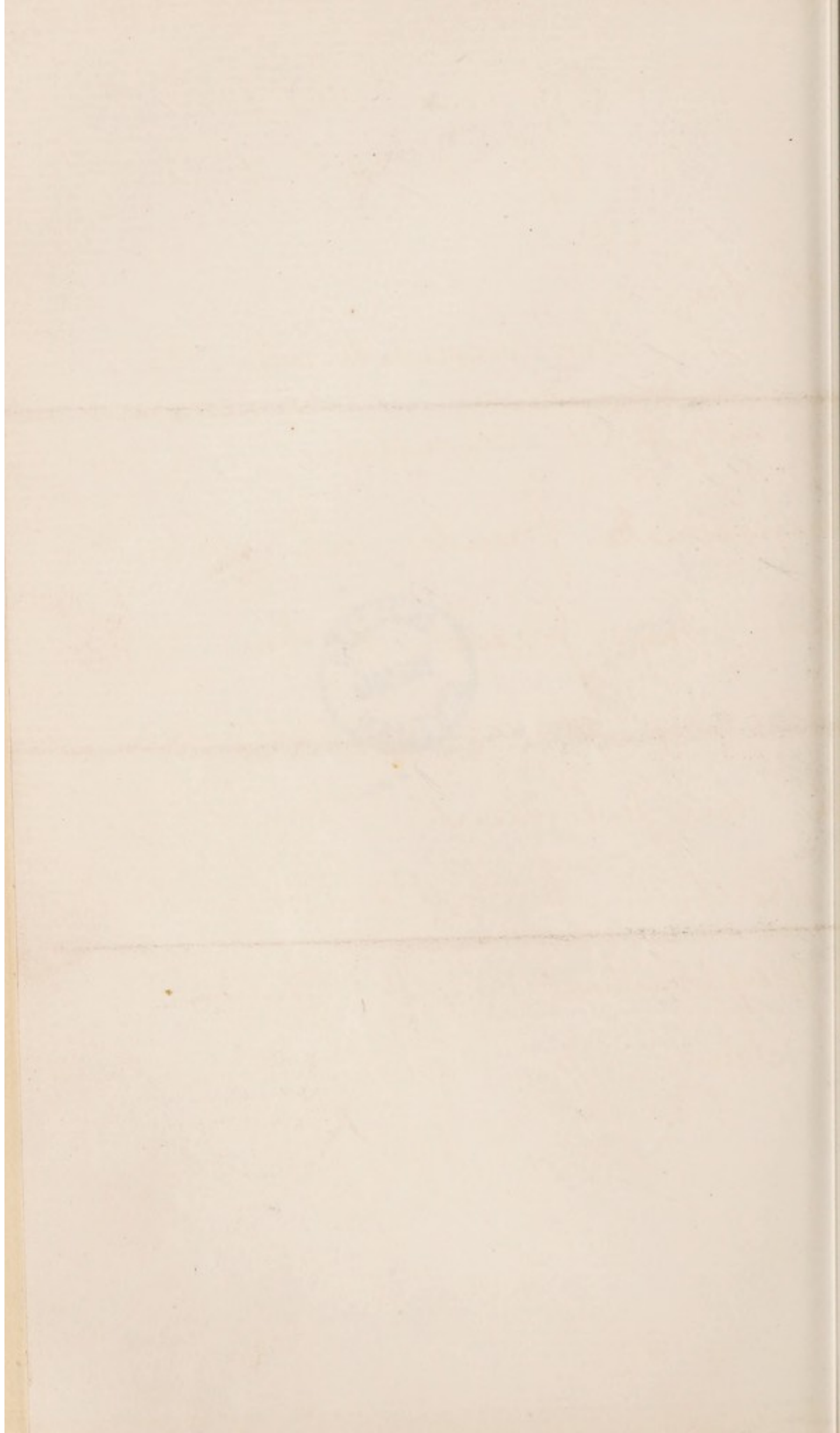
SIR,
