



I have pleasure in sending for the Library under your charge a copy of a bibliographical booklet dealing with the writings of Dr. DUNCAN LIDDEL, a native of Aberdeen, and Professor in the University of Helmstedt. I trust you will pardon a professional brother for troubling you with a query regarding its subject.

The works of Dr. LIDDEL (especially Nos. 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11 in my List) prove that while he was at Helmstedt he acted as Praeses in connexion with at least 82 Theses. Of these, in their original form, I have been able to examine only 44, copies of which are either in this Library or in that of the British Museum.

I shall esteem it a great favour if you will kindly inform me on the appended leaf whether your Library possesses copies of any of the works of Liddel (Nos. 1 to 20); or of Theses under his presidency (Nos. 21 to 102; or others unknown to me); or of Nos. 103 and 107, which also I have been unable to examine.

1561. Born at Aberdeen.  
15—. Pupil at the Grammar School, Aberdeen.  
15—. M.A., King's College, Aberdeen.  
1579-82. Studies at the University of Frankfurt a. O..  
1582-83. Studies at Breslau.  
1584-87. Studies at Frankfurt a. O.  
1587-90. Studies at the University of Rostock.  
1587. Graduates Master of Arts at Rostock.  
1591-94. Professor of Mathematics at the University of Helmstedt.  
1594-1603. Professor of Higher Mathematics.  
1596. Graduates Doctor of Medicine at Helmstedt.  
1596-1607. Professor of Medicine.  
1599. Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy.  
1604. Pro-rector of the University.  
1605. Publishes his *Disputationes Medicinales* at Helmstedt.  
1607. Returns to Scotland, and publishes his *Ars Medica* at Hamburg.  
1610. Publishes his *De Febribus* at Hamburg.  
1612. Mortifies his lands of Pitmedden to found six bursaries at Marischal College, for sons of honest poor men, burgesses of New Aberdeen, who are not able to sustain their bairns at College; also a prize for Latin verse.  
1613. Endows a professor of Mathematics at Marischal College, the learnedest that can be had or gotten.  
1613, Dec. 17. Dies at Aberdeen, aged 52.

1617. The Scots Parliament ratifies his mortification.
1620. The *Disputationes Medicinales* reissued at Helmstedt as *Universae Medicinae Compendium*.
1622. The Aberdeen Town Council erects a memorial brass in St. Nicholas' Kirk.
1624. Serranus republishes (at Lyon) the *Ars Medica* and *De Febribus* combined, as *Opera Medica*.
1637. The Town Council erects a memorial pillar on the lands of Pitmedden.
1651. Principal Patrick Dun publishes Liddel's *Ars Conservandi Sanitatem* at Aberdeen.
1688. Liddel's arms included in the heraldic ceiling of the principal's chamber, Marischal College.
1790. Professor John Stuart publishes his sketch of the life of Dr. Liddel.
1857. Dr. Alexander Kilgour refunds the amount of the Liddel bursary held by him, to found, in gratitude to Dr. Liddel and to keep the name of a very learned man and one of the most generous benefactors of Marischal College before the students, the Liddel prize for Greek and Latin verse.
1863. The University Commissioners of 1859, by Ordinance No. 49, regulate the Liddel bursaries.
1881. The Aberdeen (Endowed Institutions) Provisional Order regulates the Liddel bursaries, assigning them to the Faculty of Medicine.
1895. Liddel's arms included in the heraldic window of the Mitchell Hall, Marischal College.
