During a visit in 1925 to the Field Museum-Oxford University Joint Expedition to Kish, Iraq, I decided to concentrate my researches on the Anthropogeography of Southwestern Asia, particularly from the Suez Canal to the Caucasus Mountains. At that time Dr. L. H. Dudley Buxton, my tutor at Oxford, proposed this twenty-five year project, which is now nearing completion.

This list of 310 titles includes and supplements my "Bibliografia," which was published in Boletin Bibliografico de Antropologia Americana, vol. 9, pp. 325-333, Mexico City, 1948. The minor Errata have been corrected.

C., where copies may be purchased at a nominal figure. These microfilmed documents contain supplementary data to the published materials such as articles, statistical tables, photographs, and foreign texts.

The subject matter includes the following arranged by continent:

Asia. -- (a) Physical Anthropology, Prehistory, Archaeology and Anthropogeography of Southwestern Asia.

(b) Physical Anthropology, Prehistory and Archaeology of the Soviet Union. These were based on personal studies from Baku to Leningrad, or based on translated summaries of published and unpublished reports received mainly through VOKS, Moscow, prior to December 31, 1948.

Africa. -- (a) Physical Anthropology and Prehistory of Egypt (Sinai) and the northern Sudan.

(b) Physical Anthropology of the Faiyum (Egypt) and the Masai of Kenya.

Europe. -- Prehistory, Archaeology and Physical Anthropology.

Central America. -- In Mexico the Physical Anthropology of the Tepoztecos and the Prehistory of Morelos.
