No. 2. Podophylli resina $\frac{1}{4}$ of a grain Extract of coloc co $1\frac{1}{4}$ grain Extract 10 hyoscyami $1\frac{1}{4}$ grain Caraway powder $\frac{1}{8}$ of a grain.

No. 3. Podophylli resina $\frac{1}{2}$ of a grain Extract of coloc co $1\frac{1}{4}$ grain Extract hyoscyami $1\frac{1}{4}$ grain.
