

## **An improved apparatus for steaming the face / [Carl Becker].**

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COMPLETE SPECIFICATION.

An Improved Apparatus for Steaming the Face.

I, CARL BECKER, of 1A, Pots-damerstrasse, Berlin, in the Empire of Germany, Manufacturer and Property Owner, do hereby declare the nature of this invention and in what manner the same is to be performed, to be particularly described and ascertained in and by the following statement:—

- 5 This invention has for its object an apparatus for steaming the face, and consists of a steam generator which is brought into removable connection, by means of a tube, with a folding or collapsible receiver, the mouth of which serves to receive the face, and for this object has a ring, adjustable in width combined with a handle.
- 10 The object of the invention is shown in the accompanying drawing, in which:  
 Figure 1 is an elevation of the apparatus in use.  
 Figure 2 a side view of a modified construction of the receiver;  
 Figure 3 a detail view of the ring or loop and the handle.  
 Figure 4 a separate view of the handle.
- 15 A suitably formed generator *a e b*, of which the boiler *b* is removable and carries a pipe *c* with a removable mouth piece *d* is connected by means of the said pipe *c* and mouth piece *d* with a removable and collapsible receiver or vessel, the parts *f* and *k* of which (made for instance of metal, glass, or vulcanite as regards the part *f*, and of cotton- linen- or silk-material or the like as regards the part *k*)  
 20 are connected at the point *o*. This receiver may however be entirely made of fabric as shown in Figure 2 and provided with a ring *n* for holding it stretched and the receiver *k* may then be directly connected at the point *p* with the tube *c* or rather the neck *d*. The receiver *f k* in the first form or *k* in the second form may have a pipe *g* for discharging any water of condensation which may accumulate therein, which water may be carried off into a vessel or cup *i* by means of  
 25 a pipe *h*. The wide opening of the receiver *f k* or *k* as the case may be has a loop or bent piece *m* adjustable in width, which with one end, for instance at the point *r* is attached to a handle *s*, through the opening, the other end *m*<sup>1</sup> of the bent piece or loop *m* being inserted in a hole *m*<sup>2</sup>, Figure 4, and by being pushed  
 30 up or drawn down in the handle produces the various widths or sizes of opening or of adjustment of the loop, or in other words the opening of the receiver *f k* or *k*.
- Having now particularly described and ascertained the nature of my said invention and in what manner the same is to be performed, I declare that what I claim is:—
- 35 A face steaming apparatus, comprising a suitable steam generator (*a e b*) placed into removable connection by means of a continuation pipe (*c*) and mouth piece (*d*) with a collapsible receiver (*f k* or *k*) of suitable materials, the wide opening of said receiver (*k*) being held apart to receive the face by means of an adjustable loop piece or ring (*m*) provided with a handle (*s*), substantially as hereinbefore  
 40 described.

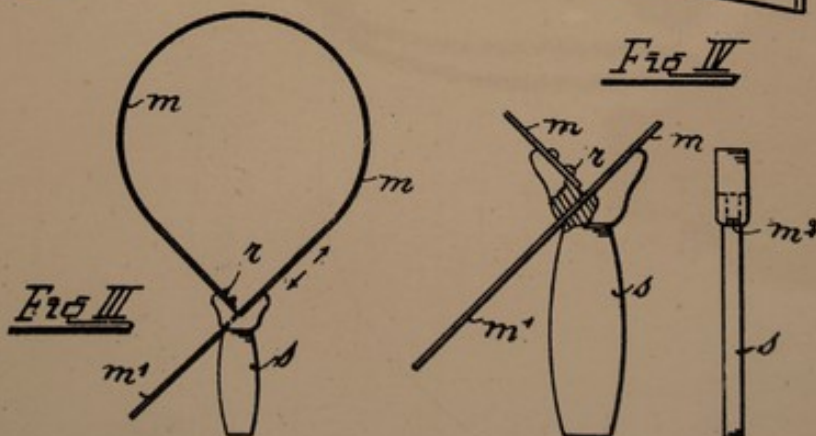
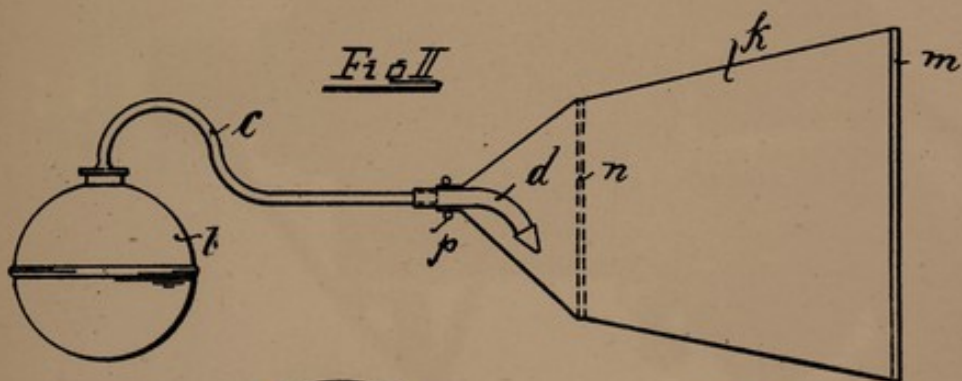
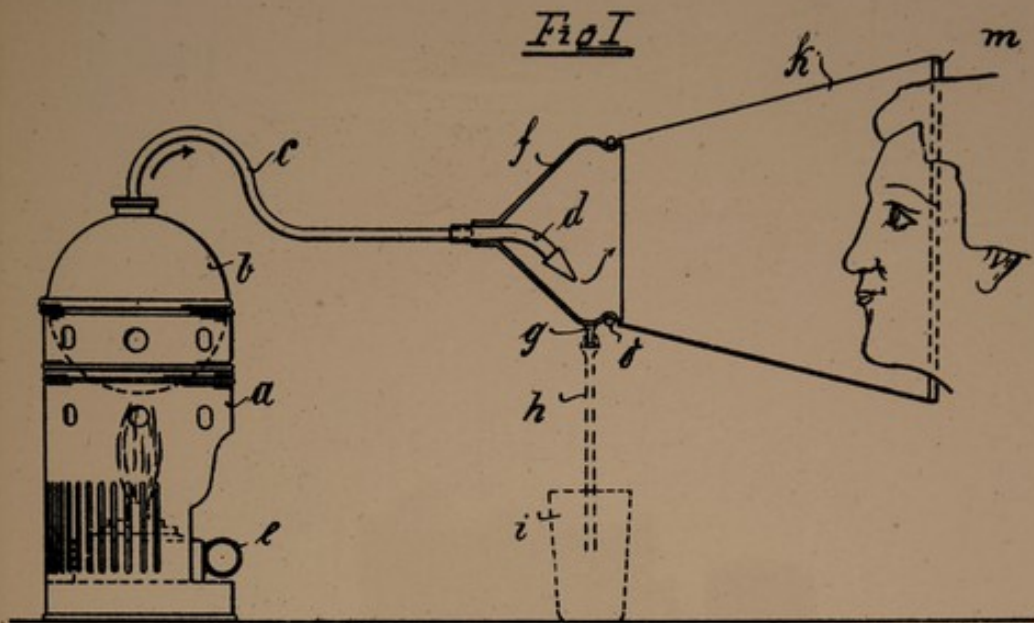
