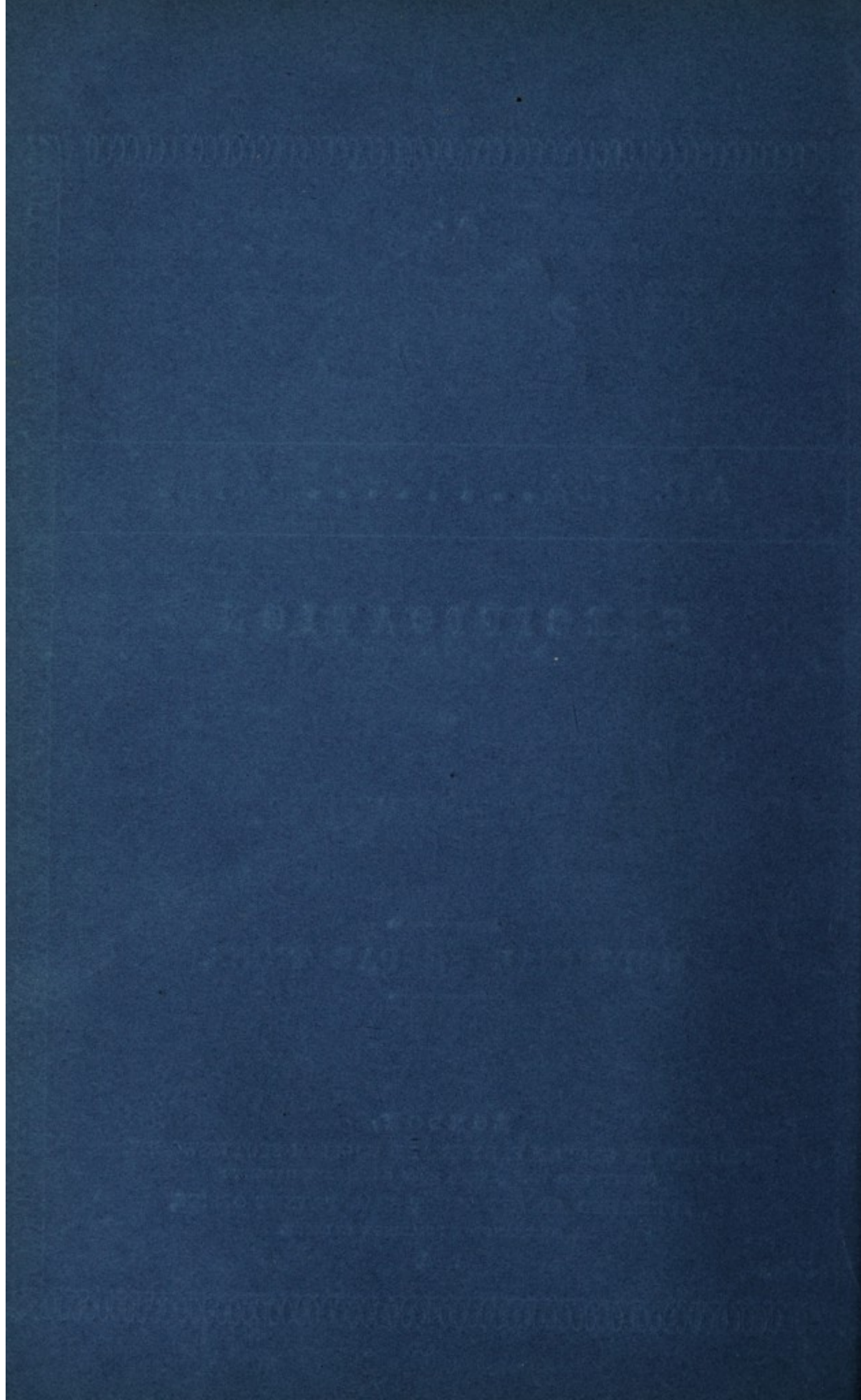

LOWTHER'S SPECIFICATION.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, I, WILLIAM LOWTHER, of Hatton Garden, in the Parish of Saint Andrew, Holborn, in the County of Middlesex, Esquire, send greeting.

WHEREAS His most Excellent Majesty King George the Second, by His Letters Patent, under the Great Seal of Great Britain, bearing date the Twelfth day of November, in the thirty-first year of His said Majesty's reign, did give and grant to me, the said William Lowther, His special licence, full power, sole priviledge and authority, that I, the said William Lowther, my executors, administrators, and assigns, should and lawfully might, during the term of years therein expressed, use, exercise, and vend, throughout that part of His said Majesty's Kingdom of Great Britain called England, the Dominion of Wales, and Town of Berwick-upon-Tweed, and also in His Majestie's Plantations abroad, my new-invented "POWDERS AND DROPS;" in which said recited Letters Patent is contained a proviso obliging me, the said William Lowther, by writing under my hand and seal, to cause a description of my said new-invented Powders and Drops to be inrolled in His Majesty's High Court of Chancery within four calendar months from the date of the said recited Letters Patent, as in and by the same, relation being thereunto had, may more at large appear.

NOW KNOW YE, that in compliance with the said proviso, I, the said William Lowther, do hereby declare that my said new-invented powders are made of the several particulars and in manner following, thati s to say:—

Pulvis compositiones laureticus corvni nigrum cum plumis exsiccatu, tur-
merick, mund. secundine ex placenta moles serpens Virgiana, salis nitrae depu-
rate rad. briionnia lumbricorum preparatore pulverise, et m. f. s. a. Dosis
No. q^r X. ad ʒ i. And I do hereby, in farther compliance with the said proviso,
declare that my said new-invented drops are made of the several particulars, 5
and in manner following, that is to say:—Compositione guttae laureticus,
ether preperatorae, carranae, teccha, machacca, chammumele floris, aī salis et
spiriti camphiri, potestes succini, opoponae cardamoms, wild carrot, long
pepper. Mithridate of each, q. s. m. f. After you have dissolved the gum,
put all into a close vessel, overtop the whole with spirit. vini, and let them 10
digest till the whole are thoroughly incorporated.
