5 Dentist, do hereby declare the nature of the said Invention for "**IMPROVEMENTS IN THE PRESERVATION OF TEETH, AND IN THE MANUFACTURE AND APPLICATION OF ARTIFICIAL TEETH,**" to be as follows:—

These improvements consist in the employment of the metal aluminium for the purpose of stopping decayed teeth, and in the manufacture of artificial
10 teeth or blocks, with the plates, pins, rivets, springs, or other attachments for the same, either wholly or in part of aluminium.
