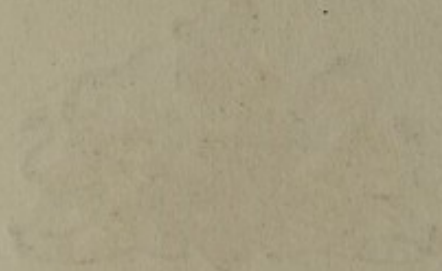
I, FREDERICK GRINDLAY HOWARD WOODWARD, of No. 3, Horatio Terrace, 5 Trafalgar R^d, Old Kent R^d, do hereby declare the nature of the said Invention for "**MEDICINE FOR THE CURE OF DROPSY**," to be as follows:—

1oz. of elicompane root,
1 „ „ stick liquorice pulled,
1 „ „ anniseeds,
1 „ „ corriander seeds,
1 „ „ guracum,
 $\frac{1}{2}$ „ „ jallop root,
 $\frac{1}{2}$ „ „ Malaga raisins.

10 These ingredients are put into a jar with 2 quarts of the best Hollands gin,
15 to have a gentle heat for 14 days, shaking the ingredients twice each day; at the expiration of 14 days it will be reduced to half the quantity. When strained it is fit for use.
