

LETTERS PATENT to François Dupuy, of Bayonne, and of No. 37, Boulevard Bonne Nouvelle, Paris, in the Empire of France, for the Invention of "AN IMPROVED ANTI-HEMORRHOIDAL APPARATUS OR ANTI-HEMORRHOIDAL PLATE."

Sealed the 6th December 1870, and dated the 15th June 1870.

PROVISIONAL SPECIFICATION left by the said François Dupuy at the Office of the Commissioners of Patents, with his Petition, on the 15th June 1870.

I, François Dupuy, of Bayonne, and of No. 37, Boulevard Bonne 5 Nouvelle, Paris, in the Empire of France, do hereby declare the nature of the said Invention for "An Improved Anti-Hemorrhoidal Apparatus or Anti-Hemorrhoidal Plate," to be as follows:—

My anti-hemorrhoidal apparatus consists of a plate of cast steel of the best quality magnetized.

10 This magnetic plate carried on the body (usually suspended over the chest) has the effect of curing hemorrhoids.

The accumulation of the magnetic fluid is proportionate to the date

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, I, FRANÇOIS DUPUY, of Bayonne, and of No. 37, Boulevard Bonne Nouvelle, Paris, in 10 the Empire of France, send greeting.

WHEREAS Her most Excellent Majesty Queen Victoria, by Her Letters Patent, bearing date the Fifteenth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy, in the thirtythird year of Her reign, did, for Herself, Her heirs and successors, give 15 and grant unto me, the said François Dupuy, Her special licence that I, the said François Dupuy, my executors, administrators, and assigns, or such others as I, the said François Dupuy, my executors, administrators, and assigns, should at any time agree with, and no others, from time to time and at all times thereafter during the term therein expressed, 20 should and lawfully might make, use, exercise, and vend, within the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, the Channel Islands, and Isle of Man, an Invention for "AN IMPROVED ANTI-HEMOREHOIDAL APPARATUS OR ANTI-HEMORRHOIDAL PLATE," upon the condition (amongst others) that I, the said François Dupuy, my executors or administrators, by an 25 instrument in writing under my, or their, or one of their hands and seals, should particularly describe and ascertain the nature of the said Invention, and in what manner the same was to be performed, and cause the same to be filed in the Great Seal Patent Office within six calendar months next and immediately after the date of the said Letters 30 Patent.

NOW KNOW YE, that I, the said François Dupuy, do hereby declare the nature of my said Invention, and in what manner the same is to be performed, to be particularly described and ascertained in and by the following statement:—

Dupuy's Improved Anti-hemorrhoidal Plate.

My anti-hemorrhoidal apparatus consists of a plate of cast steel of the best quality magnetised.

This magnetic plate carried on the body (usually suspended over the chest) has the effect of curing hemorrhoids.

5 The accumulation of the magnetic fluid or magnetization of the plate is proportioned to the intensity of the disease.
