

PROVISIONAL SPECIFICATION left by Thomas Atkinson at the Office of the Commissioners of Patents, with his Petition, on the 25th November 1871.

I, THOMAS ATKINSON, of Lower Turnings, Straffan, in the County of 5 Kildare, Esquire, do hereby declare the nature of the said Invention for "IMPROVED TREATMENT OF CATTLE SUFFERING FROM PLEURO-PNEUMONIA AND FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE," to be as follows :---

This Invention consists of a liniment composed of three parts of tincture of iodine and two parts of spirit of ammonia.

10 This liniment if applied externally to the throat and trachea or windpipe, and also on the sides of the animal over the seat of the lungs, stops the progress of the disease and effects a speedy cure.

When the disease is attended with murrain or constipation of bowels, 1 drachm of calomel and 1/2 an oz. of gentian powder mixed in about 15 one pint of linseed gruel is to be administered.

In the case of foot and mouth desease the liniment may be applied to the throat and trachea or windpipe only, or to the trachea or windpipe and to the sides as in the case of pleuro-pneumonia, and a mixture of borax and honey is to be applied to the tongue and mouth of the animal.
