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### Composition for Skin Rasps.

PROVISIONAL SPECIFICATION left by Samuel Henry Musgrave at the Office of the Commissioners of Patents, with his Petition, on the 24th April 1875.

I, SAMUEL HENRY MUSGRAVE, 8, Middleton Road, Camden Road, 5 Islington, do hereby declare the nature of the said Invention for "**AN IMPROVED METHOD OF APPLYING COMPOSITION TO HANDLES FOR FORMING SKIN RASPS FOR THE HANDS,**" to be as follows :—

I use a composition of Portland cement, pumice stone, zinc, chalk, fine sand, emery, crushed glass, common clay, Stourbridge, China, pipe 10 clay, or other suitable material; these I form into a mass by the addition of india-rubber, gutta percha, gums, boiled oil, white lead, or water; I then coat the portion of the handle required by the means of pressure or other method.

The handles I use of various shapes, sizes, and colours.

15 I sometimes use metal, wood, bone, horn, india-rubber, vulcanite, gutta percha, papier maché, composition, or other suitable material.
