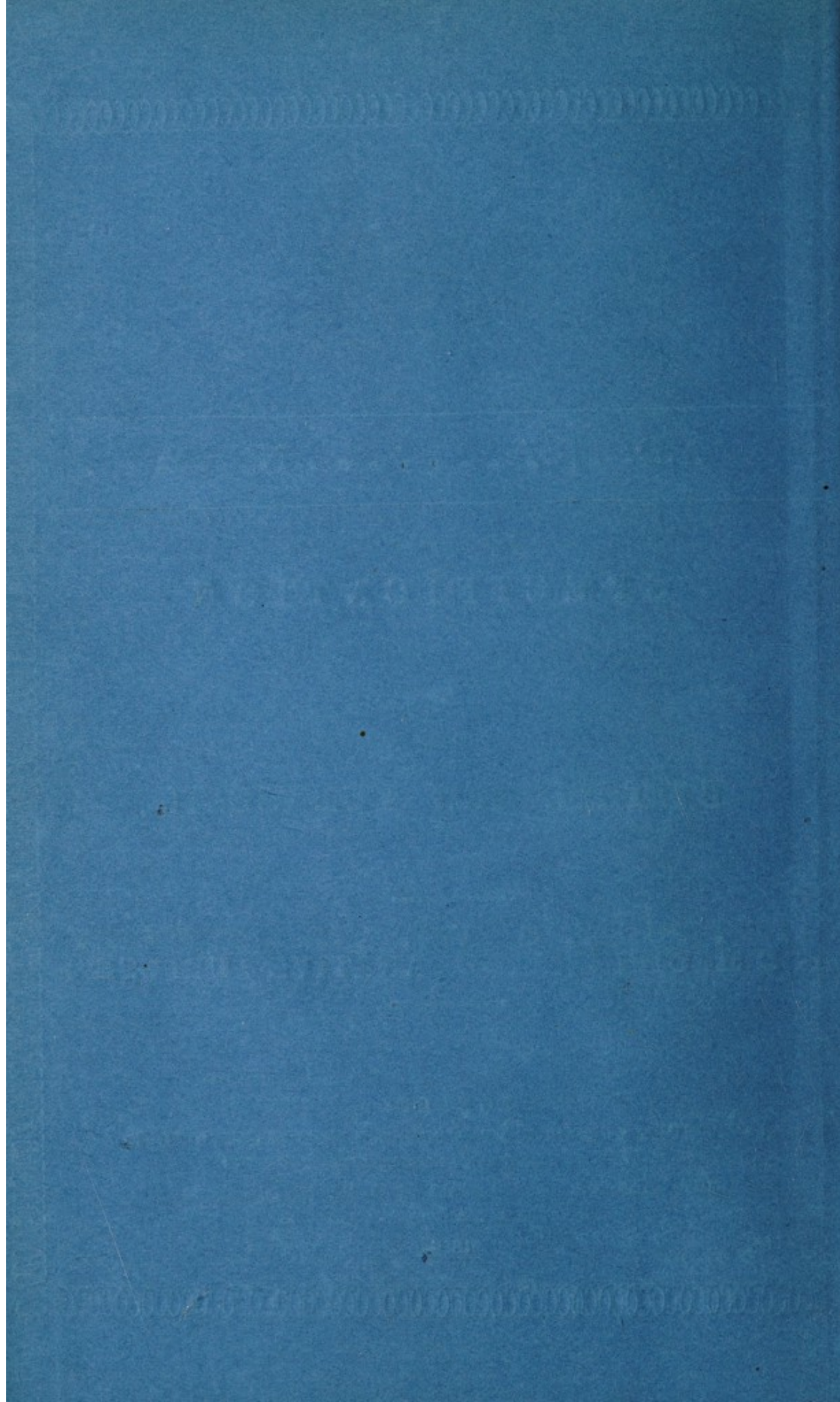

DOMINICETTI'S SPECIFICATION.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, I, BARTHOLOMEW DOMINICETI, of Chelsea, in the County of Middlesex, Doctor of Physick, send greeting.

WHEREAS His most Excellent Majesty King George the Third, by His
5 Letters Patent under the Great Seal of Great Britain, bearing date on or
about the Eighth day of September, in the seventh year of His reign, did
give and grant unto me, the said Bartholomew Dominiceti, His especial
licence that I, the said Bartholomew Dominiceti, during the term of years
therein expressed, should and lawfully might use, exercise, and vend, within
10 England, Wales, and Town of Berwick-upon-Tweed, my "**DISCOVERY OR
INVENTION OF THE METHOD OF MAKING THE ARBITRARILY HEATED AND MEDICATED
SALUBRIOUS BATHS, PUMPS, AND STOVES, BOTH MOIST AND DRY, AND A VARIETY OF
FUMIGATIONS FROM HERBS, SEEDS, ROOTS, FLOWERS, GUMS, MINERALS, AND OTHER
DRUGS, AND AN INFINITE VARIETY OF MACHINES FOR CONVEYING AND APPLYING THE**
15 **EFFICACY OF THE ABOVE DRUGS AND MINERALS TO THE DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE
HUMAN BODY, ACCORDING TO THE NATURE OF THE DISEASE ;**" in which said Letters
Patent there is contained a proviso obliging me, the said Bartholomew Domi-
niceti, under my hand and seal, to cause a particular description of the nature
of my said Invention, and how the same is to be performed, to be inrolled in
20 His Majesty's High Court of Chancery within four calendar months after the
date of the said recited Letters Patent, as in and by the same (relation being
thereunto had) may more fully and at large appear.

Dominiceti's Baths, Pumps, Stoves, &c.

NOW KNOW YE, that in compliance with the said proviso I, the said Bartholomew Dominiceti, do hereby declare that my said Invention of the Method of Making the arbitrarily Heated and Medicated Salubrious Baths, Pumps, and Stoves, both Moist and Dry, and a Variety of Fumigations from Herbs, Seeds, Roots, Flowers, Gums, Minerals, and other Drugs, and an 5 Infinite Variety of Machines for Conveying and Applying the Efficacy of the above Drugs and Minerals to the different Parts of the Human Body, according to the Nature of the Disease, is described in the Plans thereof, and references thereto hereunto annexed.

In witness whereof, I, the said Bartholomew Dominiceti, have hereunto 10 set my hand and seal, this Thirtieth day of December, One thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven.

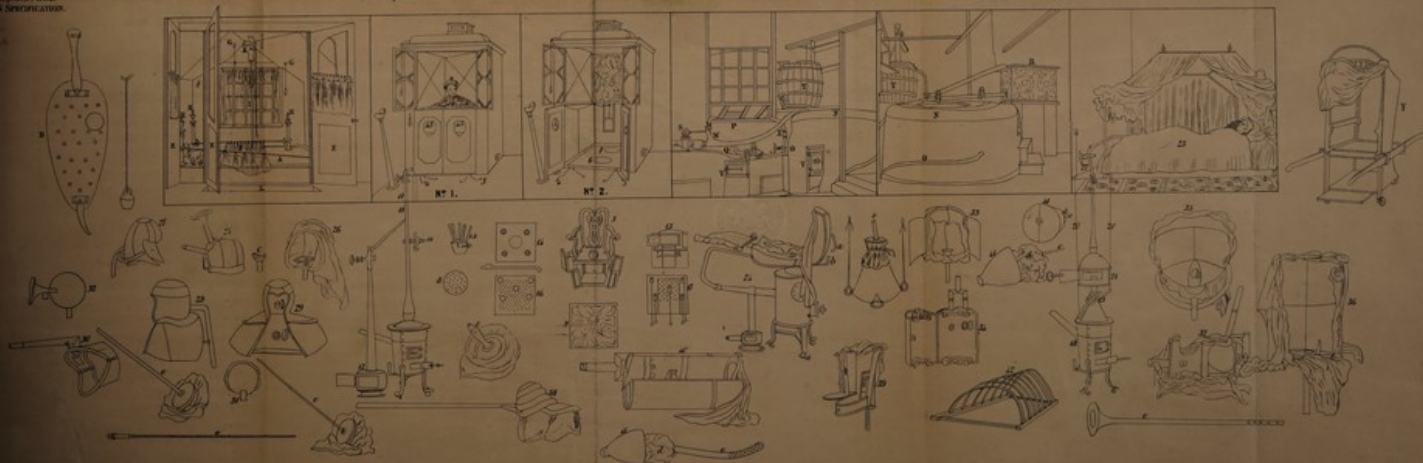
