

I, CHARLES BODENHAM GARRETT, of Hastings, in the County of Sussex, Doctor of Medicine, do hereby declare the nature of the said Invention for "The External Administration of Application of Electricised Oxygen or Ozone Gas to the Human Body by Means of Baths or Closed Vessels," to be as follows:—

The generation of electricised oxygen or ozone in a proper vessel, 10 receivers for the same, means for forwarding the gas into closed baths, conduit pipes for removing the used gas.
