**MARGARY'S MEMORANDUM OF ALTERATION.**

In the Matter of Letters Patent granted to Joshua John Lloyd Margary, of Wellington Road, St. John's Wood, in the County of Middlesex, Esquire, for "**A NEW MODE OF PRESERVING ANIMAL AND VEGETABLE SUBSTANCES FROM DECAY**," bearing date at Westminster, the 19th day of December 1837.

**MEMORANDUM OF ALTERATION** entered by the said Joshua John Lloyd Margary with the Clerk of the Patents of England, pursuant to an Act passed in the 5th & 6th years of His late Majesty's reign, entitled "An Act to amend the Law touching Letters Patent for  
"Inventions."

I, the said JOSHUA JOHN LLOYD MARGARY, do hereby declare, that since the granting of the said Letters Patent as aforesaid I have been advised that it is doubtful whether the aforesaid new mode of preserving animal and vegetable substances from decay is applicable to all animal and vegetable  
substances; and for this reason I, the said Joshua John Lloyd Margary, do hereby alter the said title of the said Letters Patent, by introducing the word  
"certain" between the word "preserving" and the word "animal" in the

*Margary's Improvements in Preserving Animal and Vegetable Substances.*

said title, the said alteration not being such as will extend the exclusive right granted by the said Letters Patent.
