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

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



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ANNUAL REPORT

ON THE

Hospitals and Dispensaries in Burma

FOR THE YEAR 1939.

I.—INTRODUCTION.

1. This report deals with the working of hospitals and dispensaries in Burma including Shan States for the year ending 31st December 1939.

The post of Inspector-General of Civil Hospitals, Burma was held by Lieut.-Colonel J. Findlay, I.M.S., from the 1st January to the 26th January ; by Colonel N. S. Sodhi, M.C., I.M.S., from the 27th January to the 7th March ; by Lieut.-Colonel A. Ba Thaw, I.M.S., from the 8th March to the 25th April and by Colonel R. H. Candy, I.M.S., from the 26th April till the end of the year.

Lieut.-Colonel A. Ba Thaw, I.M.S., held the post of the Assistant Inspector-General of Civil Hospitals, Burma from the 1st January to the 7th March and again from the 26th April to the 10th May 1939. The post remained unfilled from the 8th March to the 25th April. With effect from 11th May, U Ba Than Chain, M.B., Ch.B., was the Assistant Inspector-General of Civil Hospitals, Burma, and he remained so till the end of the year. The appointment of Assistant Inspector-General of Civil Hospitals, Burma is a valuable asset to the Department.

II.—HOSPITAL ACCOMMODATION.

2. The number of hospitals and dispensaries at the beginning of the year was 308. During the year 4 new Statement "A". dispensaries were opened under the 5 years scheme for providing medical relief to rural areas, *viz.* (1) a Travelling Dispensary, Zebyubin (Sittang Colony), Hanthawaddy District ; (2) a Travelling Dispensary, Kyannyat, Mogôk Sub-division, Katha-District, (3) a Floating Dispensary, Maingkaing, Upper Chindwin District and (4) a Travelling Dispensary, Salin, Minbu District. Besides these, a fuel extraction Camp Dispensary was opened in the Myaungmya District and a dispensary at Yakaingyaung, Hanthawaddy District, a Bazaar Dispensary at Kyatpyin, Katha District and a Municipal Employees Dispensary at Rangoon were opened during the year.

Statistics of Contagious Diseases Hospital, Mandalay are included in this year's report, and it is shown as a newly opened hospital. A Public Works Department dispensary at Thilawa, Hanthawaddy District was opened and closed during the year. The Civil Hospitals, at Mansi, Katha District and Sakantha, Northern Shan States were closed. Three hundred and fifteen hospitals and dispensaries remained open on the 31st December 1939.

The progress of establishing dispensaries under the 5 years scheme for providing medical relief in rural areas is very slow, for reasons stated in the Report for 1938. However, in 1939, 4 dispensaries were opened, and buildings for 5 fixed dispensaries were under construction. Of the 5 under construction, 2 have since been opened and the remaining 3 are expected to be ready shortly.

In places remote from hospitals and dispensaries medical aid is being afforded by means of medicine chests. The object is to supply simple medical treatment to the people in outlying areas. Care was taken to select only such drugs as will not prove dangerous in the hands of laymen. In 1939, 222 such medicine chests with instructions for their use were distributed in many villages to headmen, teachers and other persons approved by Government.

3. *New Constructions.*—The following are a few important works carried out during the year under report :—

- (1) A new out-patient and administration block at the Civil Hospital, Insein.
- (2) A maternity ward at the Civil Hospital, Dedaye, Pyapôn District.
- (3) A maternity block, an out-patient and administration block and new quarters for midwife and servants at the Civil Hospital, Henzada.

Construction of new hospital buildings at Tavoy, Mergui and Kyaiklat in Pyapôn District and an X-Ray building at the Civil Hospital, Pegu were in progress. The construction of 5 dispensaries under the 5 years scheme for providing medical relief to rural areas was also in progress while the plans and estimates for new hospital buildings at Tharrawaddy, Pyinmana, Myanaung and Shwegen were under preparation. It is expected that the construction of these hospital buildings will soon be started. The question of site for new hospitals at Sagaing and Moulmein was settled after the close of the year under report and it is hoped that the schemes will proceed by stages as far as funds permit.

Buildings of many Headquarters hospitals such as at Bassein, Kyaukpyu, Sandoway have already served their purpose and have become out-of-date long ago. New up to date buildings in place of the existing one are overdue ; but owing to financial difficulties nothing could be done as yet.

III.—MEDICAL ESTABLISHMENT.

4. *Indian Medical Service*.—The sanctioned number of Indian Medical Service Officers in Burma on the Statement "B", 1st January 1939 was 28 *plus* a leave reserve of 8 *plus* 4 appointments temporarily reserved for certain protected officers of the Indian Medical Service.

The number of Indian Medical Service Officers on the rolls on the 31st December 1939 was 38 of whom 29 were on duty in the Civil Medical, Jail and Public Health Departments, 2 on Military duty, 3 on Foreign Service (2 under the University of Rangoon and 1 in the Federated Shan States), 1 enroute to Chin Hills for Special duty on Goitre Survey and 2 were on leave.

5. *Indian Medical Department*.—The sanctioned number was 5, *viz* :—2 Civil Surgeons and 3 Subordinate appointments. Two Civil Surgeons appointments and only one of the Subordinate appointments were filled.

6. *Burma Civil Surgeons*.—The sanctioned number of Burma Civil Surgeons was 18 ; but on the 31st December 1939 the number on the rolls was 13 of whom 8 were on duty and 5 on leave.

7. *Civil Assistant Surgeons*.—During the year the cadre of Civil Assistant Surgeons was split into 2 groups, men and women.

The permanent cadre for male Civil Assistant Surgeons was 56 *plus* a reserve of 8 while the permanent cadre of female Civil Assistant Surgeons was 14 *plus* a reserve of 3. All except 3 appointments in the cadre of female Civil Assistant Surgeons were filled. Besides the above there were 20 officiating Civil Assistant Surgeons. Of the 2 appointments for Lady Doctors 1 only was filled. On the 31st December 1939 there were therefore 98 Civil Assistant Surgeons and 1 Lady Doctor of whom 90 were on duty and 9 on leave.

8. *Sub-Assistant Surgeons*.—The sanctioned strength was 407 as against 404 in the previous year and 397 were on the rolls. The total number of Sub-Assistant Surgeons employed in all hospitals was 378 as against 369 in 1938.

9. *Honorary Graduates and Licentiates*.—There were 33 Honorary Graduates (House Surgeons) and 15 Honorary Licentiates (Assistant House Surgeons) as against 26 and 25 respectively in the previous year.

10. *Nurses, Midwives and Compounders*.—The number of Nurses on duty was 471 (439). The increase is appreciable. The number of Ward Assistants (male nurses) was 165 (130) and there were 139 (134) Midwives and 326 (307) Compounders.

IV.—HOSPITAL STATISTICS.

11. The Statement "C" shows the number of in-door and out-door patients treated in State-Public, Local Fund Statement "C" and Appendix I. and Private-Aided Hospitals and Dispensaries while the Appendix I shows the number by race and sex. The total number of patients treated in 1939 in the above classes of hospitals and dispensaries was 3,983,747 (3,667,058).

V.—DISEASES.

12. This statement shows the geographical distribution of the infectious and other diseases treated in all Statement "D". classes of medical institutions in Burma including Shan States. Total number of patients treated in 1939 in all hospitals and dispensaries in Burma including Shan States was 4,322,310 (3,954,867). This marked increase of over 3·5 lakhs is a sure indication of the extent to which the popularity of the Western system of medicine has advanced in Burma.

Malaria accounted for the largest number of patients. The incidence of Malaria is on the increase, the number treated being 604,049 in 1939 as against 516,379 in 1938 and 469,074 in 1937. Among many other important diseases which prominently figure in the statement, Tuberculosis, Leprosy, Yaws and Goitre are of special interest.

The Burma Tuberculosis and Leprosy Relief Association which was formed in 1937-38 under the aegis of His Excellency the Governor is gradually coming into action.

Besides the 4 Leper Asylums (1 at Rangoon, 2 at Mandalay and 1 at Moulmein), Leper Clinics are held at many important centres while facilities for treatment of lepers exist in many Civil Hospitals.

The incidence of Goitre continued to be high. Captain R. L. Raymond, I.M.S., was deputed on special duty to conduct a Goitre Survey in the Chin Hills District. His survey actually started on the 9th January 1940.

VI.—SURGICAL TREATMENT.

13. The total number of surgical operations performed during 1939 including secondary operations was 154,198 Statement "E". (165,239).

Sixty Blood Transfusion were carried out in the Rangoon General Hospital and 37 in Mofussil.

VII.—FINANCE.

14. The Statement "F" shows the income and expenditure of State Public, Local Fund and Private-Aided Hospitals Statements "F" and "G" and Dispensaries while the Statement "G" shows the investments. No comment is called for. The income in 1939 was Rs. 68,55,316 (Rs. 67,64,689) and the expenditure was Rs. 50,06,848 (Rs. 48,95,689) while the investments amounted to Rs. 14,26,488 and the withdrawals Rs. 1,68,969. The year terminated with the closing balance of Rs. 12,57,519.

It is common knowledge that all hospitals maintained under the Hospital Finance Scheme are in financial difficulties. Government however, has now sanctioned a scheme to assist every District Headquarters hospital under the Hospital Finance Scheme by giving a grant-in-aid equal to the cost of the nursing establishment, in addition to the annual assignment. With this additional aid most of these hospitals should be able to introduce long delayed improvements and local supporters will be encouraged to greater efforts.

The statistics of many hospitals well illustrate the proverb that where there is a will there is a way. Some Committees set about their business in the most praiseworthy manner, whilst a few think to throw their burden on to the taxpayers of other districts. This attitude is fortunately rare.

VIII.—SPECIAL HOSPITALS.

15. *General Hospital, Rangoon.*—The Rangoon General Hospital is the premier institution in Burma and is the teaching unit for students of Rangoon University. It continued to enjoy its high popularity ; and it is seriously overcrowded throughout the year. The need for more hospital accommodation is urgent. The Rangoon General Hospital admitted 16,479(17,619) with a daily average of 889 (838).

It is not out of place to mention here that for the treatment of Cancer, a Radium Clinic was established at the Rangoon General Hospital through the generosity of the Rangoon Turf Club which donated Rs. 35,000. It started to work with effect from the 1st May 1939 and in 8 months, 46 patients were treated. The clinic is hoped to develop greatly its work in course of time.

Dufferin Hospital, Rangoon.—This institution fully maintained its high reputation with admission of 6,372 (5,767) and daily average of 183 (172)

General Hospital, Mandalay.—This hospital is an important institution for Upper Burma. Its importance and work will further grow in volume if the Burma Government Medical School is shifted from

Rangoon to Mandalay. The proposal for the transfer of the School from Rangoon to Mandalay is now under consideration of Government.

16. The provision of X-ray facilities is now becoming more satisfactory, and X-ray sets exist at Akyab, Syriam, Pegu, Bassein Tavoy, Taunggyi, Mergui, Toungoo, Mandalay, Maymyo and Rangoon General Hospital.

In addition sets are expected to be installed in the near future at Prome and Lashio.

No progress has yet been made with a proposal for the proper training and registration of Pharmacists and Compounders, included in which is the scheme for the registration and inspection of all vendors of drugs and poisons.

17. I must acknowledge with thanks the response made by all members of the Medical Department to the steadily increasing demands made upon them.
