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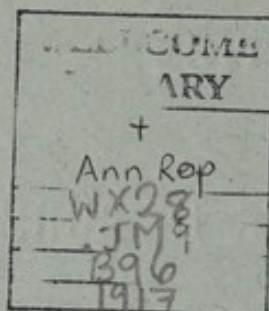

HOSPITALS AND DISPENSARIES IN BURMA

FOR THE YEAR 1917.

I held charge of the Office of the Inspector-General of Civil Hospitals, Burma, throughout the year 1917. In spite of depletion of staff and other special conditions consequent on the great war, the record of work done has been on the whole satisfactory.

2. At the beginning of the year 1917, there were 282 Hospitals and Dispensaries in the Province. The statistics of the Contagious Diseases Hospital at Mandalay have been included in the returns for the first time this year. Two dispensaries (Special Dispensary for Women at Maymyo, and Public Works Department Dispensary at Machega in Putao District) were opened during the year. Eleven dispensaries had to be closed during the year, ten on account of withdrawal of Sub-Assistant Surgeons for military duty, the eleventh (Twante Canal Dispensary, Insein District) being closed on the 10th March 1917, owing to the scene of operations having been shifted very close to Rangoon.

3. The ten dispensaries closed consequent on war conditions were :—
(1) Tilin (Pakokku District); (2) Nammawngun (Southern Shan States); (3) Budalin (Lower Chindwin District); (4) Massein (Upper Chindwin District); (5, 6 and 7) Travelling Dispensaries, Pakokku, Seyat (Chin Hills) and Paletwa (Arakan Hill Tracts); (8) Bòkpyin (Mergui District); (9) Branch Dispensary, Pynmana (Yamèthin District) and (10) Railway Dispensary, Mahlaing (Meiktila District). At the close of the year under report, only 274 hospitals and dispensaries were working in Burma.

4. The number of in-door and out-door patients treated at State-public, Local Fund and Private-aided Institutions amounted to 1,867,529 against 1,858,485 in 1916.

In-door Patients.—The number of in-door patients treated was 69,403 in the year under report against 68,238 in 1916. Of these, 51,240 (73·8 per cent.) were "Cured"; 6,808 (9·8 per cent.) were "Relieved"; 4,431 (6·4 per cent.) were "Discharged Otherwise", and 4,008 "Died." The death-rate was 5·77 per cent. of the total treated as against 6·29 per cent. in 1916. The total accommodation available was 3,770 beds for males and 1,177 for females, or an increase of 100 beds over that of the previous year.

Out-door Patients.—In the year under report, one million seven hundred and ninety-eight thousand one hundred and twenty-six persons were attended to as out-patients against 1,790,247 in 1916, the daily average attendance being 9,639 against 9,411 in the year previous. The average daily attendance was more than one hundred at (1) General Hospital, Rangoon, 484, (2) Gyobingauk, 148, (3) Kemmendine Male Dispensary, 147, (4) Sagaing, 144, (5) Maymyo, 134, (6) Mandalay 132, (7) Bhamo, 129, (8) Toungoo, 115, (9) Bassein and (10) Zìgòn, 105 each and (11) Myitkyina, 101. The percentage of patients represented by friends was 16·58 in 1917 against 15·68 in 1916.

5. Arranged according to the greatest order of prevalence, the principal diseases treated were :—

"All other diseases of the Digestive system" 421,353, "Malaria" 225,097, "Ulcers" 154,493, "All diseases of the respiratory system except Pneumonia and Tubercle of the Lungs" 146,235, "Diseases of the skin other than Ulcers" 144,949, "Injuries" 136,101, "Diseases of the Eye" 129,972, "Dyspepsia" 86,317, "Diseases of the Ear" 48,582, "Rheumatic fever and Rheumatism" 38,293, and "Diseases of the Nervous system" 30,549.

Of the epidemic diseases, the number of cases of cholera, plague and small-pox treated at the hospitals were 347, 1,013 and 435 against 253, 1,108 and 1,228 cases respectively in 1916.

The total number of deaths returned was 4,008 in 1917 among in-patients, and these were ascribed chiefly to "Injuries" 491, "Pneumonia" 350, Tubercle of the Lungs 311, "Plague" 305, Malaria 292, "Dysentery" 282, "Anæmia" 233, "Diarrhoea" 224, "All other diseases of the Digestive system" 184, "Diseases of the Nervous system" 131, and "All other Infectious Diseases" 107.

The death-rate under these diseases during 1917 is compared below with that in the previous year:—

Most of the deaths in the hospitals occur among patients brought in a moribund condition and who are so hopelessly ill that recovery cannot be expected.

6. *Military Police Hospitals.*—The total number of patients treated at the Military Police Hospital were 16,008 (15,371 Police *plus* 637 Civil) in-door patients, and 94,787 (76,781 Police *plus* 18,006 Civil) out-door patients, against 15,094 in and 109,706 out-patients in 1916, and the decrease occurs chiefly among the out-patients both under Police and Civil. "Malaria" as usual contributed the largest number of cases treated, *vis.* 24,774. "All other Diseases of the Digestive system" 14,326, "All other Diseases of the Respiratory system except Pneumonia and Tubercle of the Lungs" 13,324, "Ulcers" 9,340 and "Injuries" 8,834 come next in order of numbers. There were 110 deaths among the in-door Police patients treated, 33 from Pneumonia, 16 from Malaria, 12 from All other Infectious Diseases, 6 each from "Tubercle of the Lungs" and "Plague."

7. *Railway Hospitals and Dispensaries.*—The total number of patients treated at the Railway Medical Institutions increased from 1,03,053 in 1916 to 113,579 in 1917. There was no change in the in-door accommodation provided, but the number of patients treated in-door rose from 864 in 1916 to 1,119 in the year under report, Malaria 186 and Injuries 160 contributing the largest numbers. There were 52 deaths in 1917 as against 32 in the year previous and the chief causes were "All other diseases of the Digestive system" (9), "Malaria" and "Pneumonia" (5) each and "Plague" and Tubercle of the Lungs" (3) each.

8. The attendance by classes shows an increase except under "Others." There was a satisfactory increase of 10,015 among the Burmese, while the number of patients under "Mahomedans," "Hindus" and "Europeans and Anglo-Indians" showed a rise of 2,914, 1,801 and 161 respectively. The ratio percentages of the different classes to the total treated were as follows:—

It was satisfactory to note that the attendance of Burmese females and children shows an appreciable increase over the figures for the year 1916.

9. No less than 56,148 operations were performed during the year under review against 52,786 in 1916 or an increase of 3,362. The number of patients operated on likewise showed an increase from 52,560 in 1916 to 55,655 in the year under review. The death-rate *per mille* among the patients operated on was 6'3 in 1917 against 4'7 in the year previous. In Rangoon, 373 abdominal and 152 Gynaecological operations were performed with a mortality of 11 and 9 *per cent.* The higher death-rate is ascribed to a larger number of cases being operated on for Cancer of the Uterus in greatly debilitated patients.

10. The year under report opened with a balance of Rs. 85,003 against Rs. 79,817 in 1916. Under receipts, Government subsidies decreased from Rs. 9,27,804 in 1916 to Rs. 8,95,485 in 1917 and the grants from Local Funds including Municipalities increased from Rs. 8,41,136 in 1916 to Rs. 10,02,491 in 1917. Subscriptions and donations received from the public during the year under report fell from Rs. 60,816 in 1916 to Rs. 59,761 in 1917. This total excludes miscellaneous receipts under which there has been a fall of Rs. 6,451

during the year under report. There has, however, been a net increase of Rs. 1,27,011 under receipts during the year 1917. The total expenditure on Hospitals and Dispensaries during the year under review amounted to Rs. 20,09,847 as against Rs. 18,72,930 in 1916. The increase in cost is Rs. 1,36,917 and it occurs under all the heads of expenditure. The construction of a new hospital at Toungoo, the improvements to the Akyab Hospital and the construction of European and special wards at Tavoy Hospital accounts for an increase over a lakh of rupees, while the rise in prices of articles of diet and Europe and bazaar medicines necessitated a further increase in the cost of upkeep. Rs. 52,500 was invested during the year under report mostly in the purchase of Post Office Cash Certificates, and thus the year closed with a balance of Rs. 75,097 in 1917 against Rs. 85,003 in 1916.

11. *Donations.*—The thanks of the Medical Department are due to the persons and corporations mentioned below for their donations, etc. mentioned against their names and also to several other kind-hearted and generous gentlemen and corporations whose names have been omitted for want of space for their gifts in money and kind to patients treated in the hospitals:—

Messrs. The Burma Oil Company continue to supply electric light, water and other services as in previous years to the Syriam Hospital.

The Burma Oil Company and the Rangoon Oil Company carry out without charge petty construction and repairs to the Civil Hospital, Yenangyat, and also supply furniture, fittings, etc. which can be made in their work-shops.

The several oil companies at Yenangyaung contributed a total sum of Rs. 4,736 towards the maintenance of the Civil Hospital there.

The Customs Department gave Rs. 2,000 to the Rangoon General Hospital and Rs. 120 to the Civil Hospital, Tavoy.

Several firms and merchants in Rangoon subscribed freely to the provision of increased comforts to the patients in the Rangoon General Hospital.

The Hon'ble Mr. Jamal, C.I.E., donated a sum of Rs. 1,500 towards the construction of a ward for females at the Civil Hospital, Allanmyo.

The Burma Mines Company paid this year Rs. 1,600 as donation to the Civil Hospital, Maymyo.

The public of Sale and Kyaukse towns have subscribed about Rs. 340 and Rs. 670 towards a fund for the construction of a ward for in-patients.

Mr. Manekjee Palonjee of Myaungmya, besides building a commodious *Zayat* in the hospital compound at Mawlamyainggyun for the use of patients' relations and friends, made money contributions to the Civil Hospitals there and at Wakema and Myaungmya.

Babu Rookmanand has built a cook-house for higher class Hindus attending the Civil Hospital, Moulmein.

Sirdar Dewan Singh and Merchants, Law Lio and Yin Moh Hok and Babu Tharachand were instrumental in collecting and contributing subscriptions and donations for the provision of greater comforts to the sick in the Civil Hospital, Lashio.

12. *Rangoon General Hospital.*—In spite of depletion of Indian Medical Service Officers consequent on the war and numerous transfers amongst the junior staff necessitated by Military exigencies, the work at the Rangoon Hospital was carried on successfully. The attendance during the year increased by 320 over that of 1916, and 426 more operations were performed than in the year previous, with a lesser death rate of 12 *per cent.* in the year under review as against 13 *per cent.* in 1916. The average daily attendance among out-patients increased from 467 in 1916 to 484 in the year under review. The accommodation available in the *extern* department is found to be too small to deal with the large number of persons seeking relief thereat. The plans to enlarge the building for the out-patients department though ready are hung up owing to war conditions. The average daily attendance of in-door patients has fallen from 485 in 1916 to 465 in the year under report, but this is more than the accommodation available (443 beds). There was overcrowding generally and this fact emphasizes the need for the early establishment of an infirmary in Rangoon for chronic and incurable cases. At present, the Rangoon General Hospital has to deal not only with patients resident in Rangoon, its suburbs and the adjoining districts, but also with patients in the whole of Burma who resort to this institution in ever-growing numbers. The nursing staff is reported to be insufficient, but nothing to increase

the staff can now be done while conditions imposed by the war prevail. The work of the Police Surgeon has increased so much that he does not find time to attend to Pathological work for which plenty of materials are available. The creation of a separate appointment as Pathologist appears necessary after the war is over. The X-ray and Electro-Therapeutic method of treatment was adopted in the case of 1,365 persons in 1917, and the number of X-ray photographs was 895 against 801 in the year previous. The work in the dental department also shows an increase, no less than 1,482 patients having been treated in 1917 against 1,345 in 1916. The students of the Burma Government Medical School, Rangoon, have also been given practical training in this department. The Laundry department has given complete satisfaction; but owing to higher cost of washing materials, there was a slight increase in the working cost: 472,239 pieces of hospital linen were washed during the year 1917 against 470,704 in 1916. The discrimination scheme continued to be worked satisfactorily. The cost of upkeep of the Rangoon General Hospital was Rs. 4,31,323 or Rs. 23,287 more than in 1916, as very many articles required for the treatment and nursing of patients had to be got at very high prices.

13. *Vaccinal Condition of Small-pox Patients.*—Out of the 158 cases of small-pox treated at the Contagious Diseases Hospital, Rangoon, 113 were vaccinated and 45 were not vaccinated. The number of deaths among the protected cases was 3 or 2·7 per cent., while the number of deaths among the non-vaccinated cases was 5 or 11·1 per cent. Of the 50 cases (which excludes 4 suspects) treated in the Moulmein Hospital, 29 were unprotected of whom 8 (or 27·6 per cent.) died, the number and death rate among the vaccinated being 2 and 9·5 per cent., respectively. Nine cases of small-pox were treated at Mandalay, 4 at the Contagious Diseases Hospital and 5 at the Civil Hospital with no deaths. All the 9 were vaccinated. Thirty-nine persons were treated at the Mergui Hospital, of whom only 13 bore marks of successful vaccination. None of the latter died, while 11 deaths occurred among the unprotected cases, the mortality rate being 42·3 per cent.

14. *Burmese Nurses.*—There were under training in 1917, 10 pupils in the Rangoon General Hospital and 3 in the Mandalay Hospital. Proposals are under consideration to have the number of pupils increased from 3 to 6 a year in the Mandalay Hospital. Four of the pupils in the Rangoon General Hospital have passed their examinations. The Rangoon General Hospital gave training also to 20 pupils sent by the Dufferin Hospital.

15. *Results-System Midwives.*—In the year under report 8, have passed their final qualifying examination. As usual, 10 new pupils were received at the Dufferin Hospital, Rangoon, in 1917 for training in midwifery as the nominees of certain local bodies, and of these three had to be sent away owing to inability to follow the lectures, and the rest are now undergoing training.

16. *Pasteur Institute.*—Three hundred and thirteen persons underwent a full course of anti-rabic treatment at the Burma Pasteur Institute, Rangoon, in 1917. The patients came from as many as 52 places, and of these 34 were Europeans and Anglo-Indians, 75 Burmese, 3 Chinese, 136 Hindus, 44 Mohamedans and 21 "Other nationalities."

17. *General.*—There have been no changes in the cadre of sanctioned appointments in the Medical Department except in the case of Sub-Assistant Surgeons, where, by the abolition of the appointment of the second Sub-Assistant Surgeon for the Civil Hospital, Yamethin, a reduction of 1 in the cadre was effected. During the year under review, 1 Indian Medical Service Officer, 2 Military Assistant Surgeons, 8 Civil Assistant Surgeons and 52 Sub-Assistant Surgeons were deputed to Military duty. The number of Sub-Assistant Surgeons on the rolls at the beginning and at the end of the year 1917 was 360 (inclusive of 3 temporary men) and 385 (including 7 temporary men) respectively against the sanctioned cadre of 378 and 377 on the 1st January 1916 and the 31st December 1916.

18. *Conclusion.*—My thanks are due to the various officers and subordinates of the Medical Department who, in spite of adverse circumstances imposed by the war, have as a rule continued to carry out their duties satisfactorily.

CLASSES I AND II.—These include all institutions maintained by Provincial Funds and under Government management. The fact that an institution possesses endowments or receives contributions from Local Funds or private subscriptions should not be regarded as a reason for not classing it as "State," so long as Provincial and Imperial Funds are practically responsible for all the charges connected with it. Class I—"Public" are State dispensaries which are open to the poorer classes of the public. Class II are "State" dispensaries which serve only a special section of the public as indicated in the sub-classification attached.

CLASS III.—Local Fund dispensaries include all institutions which are vested in local boards or Municipalities or guaranteed or maintained by Local or Municipal Funds. The fact that such an institution is aided by private subscriptions, or receives assistance from Government in the shape of part of the salary of the Medical Officer, grants of medicine, or otherwise, should not be regarded as a reason for not classing it as a Local Fund dispensary so long as its existence is practically dependent upon Local Funds.

CLASS IV comprises institutions supported by private subscriptions or guaranteed, but receiving aid from Government or Local Funds.

CLASS V comprises institutions maintained entirely at the cost of private individuals or associations. The fact that Government supplies superior inspection or registers should not be regarded as a reason for not treating it as a private non-aided dispensary.

CLASS VI comprises all railway dispensaries whether maintained by State railways or others.

NOTES.

1. Transfers of dispensaries from one class to another should be noted in the column of "Remarks."
2. Hospitals of the different Funds should be shown as private-aided or non-aided, as the case may be.
3. Dispensaries of a purely itinerant character should in no case be included in the statement.
