25. A mass of valuable Arctic data. Over 1,000 items, over 400 autograph letters, manuscripts of the most famous explorers, including a magnificent lengthy series of James, Andrew and John Ross, relating entirely to their famous expeditions, as to preparation, completion, and in retrospect. Also a very fine series of Sir William Edward Parry, and a series of Sir John Franklin. Among others are Sir Joseph Banks, Cook, Elisha Kent Kane, M.D., Melville, Peary, Nansen, Amundsen, Lieutenant Greeley, Humphrey, Barrow and about 200 other famous celebrities. In addition to the correspondence of these explorers, there are about 500 pictures, portraits, maps, etc., all relating to Arctic life and travel. Supplementing the correspondence and pictures are 200 clippings of records of Arctic travel and exploration, chiefly relating to accounts referred to in the original letters of this collection; loose, in four neat cloth dust-proof boxes.
