- 150 Okimono : Ivory. A HARUGOMA dancer on a hobby horse and a man and child imitating the playing of musical instruments on a lotus leaf and a lantern 4¼in. high ; and a group of five boys with a ladder 4½in. high 2
- 151 Okimono : Ivory. A white Egret standing on a straw rain coat lying on a log 5½in. high ; and a Group of three cranes beside a shrub, signed *Ichisuisai* ; 5in. high 2
- 152 Okimono : Ivory. Two men carrying fluttering strips of *gohei*, dancing, one blowing a conch, and a dog running beside them, 4¼in. high ; and a Garden holding up a big melon, with a child holding a branch of fruit, 4½in. high 2
- 153 Okimono : Ivory. A Group of three badgers, signed *Okada*, 2½in. high ; and two Frogs on a nelumbian leaf 3¼in. high 2

- 167 A VOTIVE PLAQUE, in form of a temple, hanging picture with rollers at each end, *copper, overlaid with repoussé figures and ornaments in high relief, gilded*, double pierced border, and mouldings of foliated scroll design separating the figures; the central portion consists of a sunk panel divided into two halves. In the upper part on a nine tier lotus throne is the newly-born Buddha, with Maya, Brahma, Vishnu, Siva, and two Gandharras; in the lower half is represented the pious self-sacrifice of King Maradhwaja, surrounded by Brahma, Vishnu, Siva, and the mendicant Krishna. Surrounding the sunk panel are 22 square divisions enclosing the Guardians of the four Quarters and other emblematic figures; *47½ in. high, 27 in. across at the top, 38 in. across at the bottom*
- 168 A VOTIVE PLAQUE similar in shape to the preceding but with an ornamental arched frieze, the framework of *gilded copper*, with sunk central panel surrounded by 25 rectangular divisions containing emblems and figures, *all in fine ivory or semi-precious stones, opal, turquoise, garnet, jade, crystal, sapphire, etc.*: a rough estimate shows over 18,000 pieces used in this elaborate decoration *4 ft. 4 in. high, 27 in. across the top, 37 in. across the bottom*; back lined with brass, having a central crossed Dorje emblem. No other of the size is known
- 169 A TEMPLE CH'OR-TEN, brass, of five square terraces with domed tomb for enclosing the relic of the peculiar Tibetan type; concave tapering sides inlaid with jewels, surmounted by a square plinth for the pyramidal spire with a CATRA at the summit.
