It is nothing but a defence of an indefensible mistake—and not very ably pleaded. The best thing that could happen to the Glasgow Infirmary (and what would save much human life) is that it should be burnt down. There will be no other safety for it. Almost all its air reaches it over burial-ground. Now the mistake has been tripled. But, depend upon it, Dr. McGhie knows all this just as well as you or I..."

Now the D.G. has not the least idea of administrative unity. He would not hesitate to make annotations on the Senate's Reports—he being the Chairman. He is also vacillating—without intelligent principle—and always throws off his own

responsibility upon his own Chief . . ."
