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THE ROSENHEIM COLLECTIONS.

IT is but seldom in the present day that an auction room is found to contain so varied an assortment of objects of human interest as is to be seen in the collections of the brothers Max and Maurice Rosenheim. In their variety they recall the sales of the middle of the last century, of which the Debruge collection was a classical example. This is the more noteworthy, inasmuch as the Rosenheims possessed neither the early training nor any tradition that would naturally lead to such activities in their leisure hours. They were both continuously engaged in commercial affairs, with but little time to give to their collections, and yet they succeeded in gathering together in their unpretending home at Hampstead a great assemblage of Works of Art, Drawings, Engravings for Goldsmiths, minor Sculpture, including Renaissance bronzes, ivory and wood carvings, Astronomical Instruments, of Ceramics, of Silver Plate and Jewellery, and, not least, an important cabinet of Italian and German Medals of the Renaissance, and there is, in addition, a Library of curious early printing, as well as a number of Luther Tracts, and a comprehensive collection of "Ex Libris" (Bookplates). An uncommon feature of the library is a series of volumes of the kind called "Album Amicorum." In these the owner of the album invites his friends to set down their names, and generally an allusive aphorism, on a page of the volume, of which the principal feature is often the illuminated coat-of-arms of the friend who signs. The fashion of carrying these volumes had a great vogue in the Continental Universities in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, and it is easy to believe that there was some competition among the possessors of them to obtain the signatures of the great scholars of their circle. Mr. Max Rosenheim published in *Archaeologia* a very full account of the practice, and described both his own albums and those elsewhere.

In nearly all the fields covered by these collections the Rosenheims possessed minute knowledge, and were consulted by the authorities both in England and abroad. Their house at Hampstead was, in fact, the centre of a group of art lovers and connoisseurs who could always rely on a warm welcome, and on the probability that a visit would lead to an increase of knowledge.

The conditions under which all these activities were pursued by the two brothers have an almost idyllic aspect, as their more intimate friends realize very well. That collections so formed should be dispersed, is in some ways a melancholy ending, but there are other points of view—they may well find resting places in hands equally sympathetic.
