It was then bought by a Monsieur Delapante, and sold by him to a Mr. Penrice, who purchased it under the strong recommendation of Sir Thomas Lawrence and Benjamin West. On the death of Mr. Penrice, in 1844, the Picture was sold and purchased by Mrs. Holmes, of Brooke Hall, near Norwich, at whose sale in 1912, the present owner purchased it.

MADAME ELIZABETH LOUISE VIGEE LEBRUN.

DUCHESSE DE TALLEYRAND-PERIGORD,

PRINCESSE DE BENEVENT

Catherine-Noël Worlée, known as "La Belle Indienne," was born November, 21st, 1762, at Tranquebar, in India. Married in 1777 George Francis Grand, of French origin, and employed by the East India Trading Company. In 1780, she left India for London, and afterwards resided in Paris. When the Revolution broke out she fled to London, and on her return to Paris later, was arrested, and thrown into prison. In 1798 she was released on the advice of the Duc de Talleyrand, and in 1802 became his wife. She died in Paris a few years later.

She is seen facing the spectator, seated on a crimson sofa, and wears a decolletée mauve satin dress, trimmed with lace at the neck and wrists and tied with a blue bow at the breast, blue sash and white gauze scarf over her shoulders, resting her right arm on a blue velvet cushion and holding a paper in her hand; her lightly-powered hair adorned with a blue bow and falling in ringlets on to her shoulders.

Mentioned in Haldane MacFalls, "The French Genius," page 257—"Vigee Lebrun's Portrait of the Princesse de Talleyrand, in spite of its affectation, is finely lit and as finely carried out.

Mentioned and illustrated in Frederick Loliée "Prince Talleyrand and his Times," pages 209 and 216.

Pierre Nolhac in his "Life of Mme. Vigée Lebrun," mentions Mme. Grand as being painted at three different periods of her life, by Mme. Lebrun: one portrait being in the possession of M. Doucet, of Paris.
