- 84 A JAPANESE BRONZE GROUP, representing the initiative and resource of the celebrated Chinese Statesman, Sze Ma Kwang, who, when a boy, finding that one of his play-mates had fallen into a great jar for storing water and was in danger of drowning, broke the jar with a stone, thus releasing the water and saving the boy's life, on a wood stand carved as water, 28in. high; on a table stand, $41\frac{1}{2}$ in. high by 25in. by 22in. 3
- 85 An old Chinese bronze Incense Bowl and Cover, with four gilt lion head handles and fine Cloisonné decoration, 12in. diam.
- 86 A Canton enamel Koro and Cover, decorated with figure panels, $7\frac{1}{4}$ in., and a pair of Celadon Vases, moulded with a dragon and a phoenix, $6\frac{3}{4}$ in. 4

- 87 A large Jewish Vase, brass, bulbous body, short broad neck, with repoussé designs of a broad band representing Egyptian scenes below a band of Hebrew inscription, and above and below these narrower bands with processions of animals, all in relief, *12in. high, diam. at neck 11½in.*
- 89 A fine Sou-Chow red lacquer Box and Cover, carved with an extensive landscape with figures, etc., *12½in. diam. 2*
