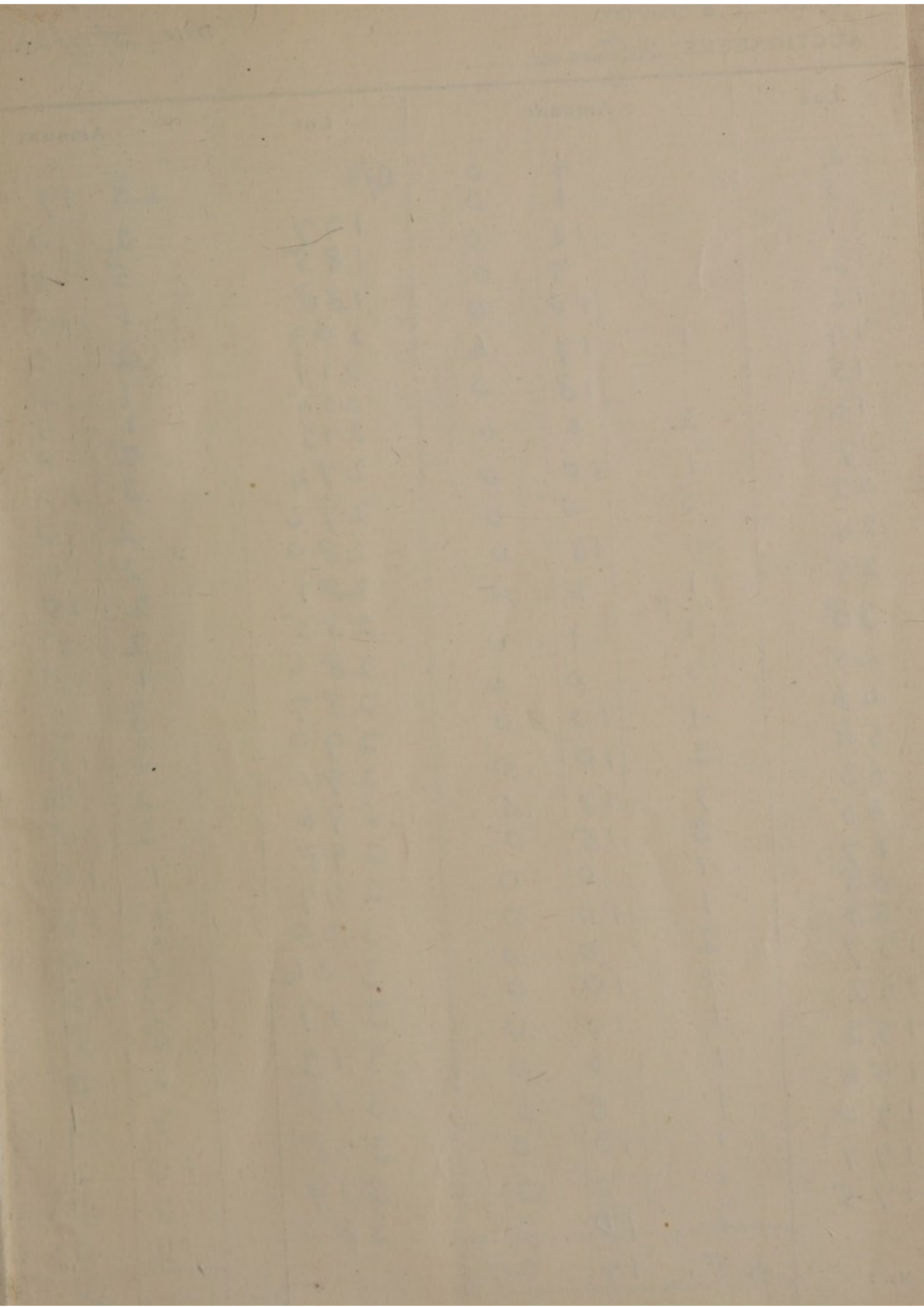

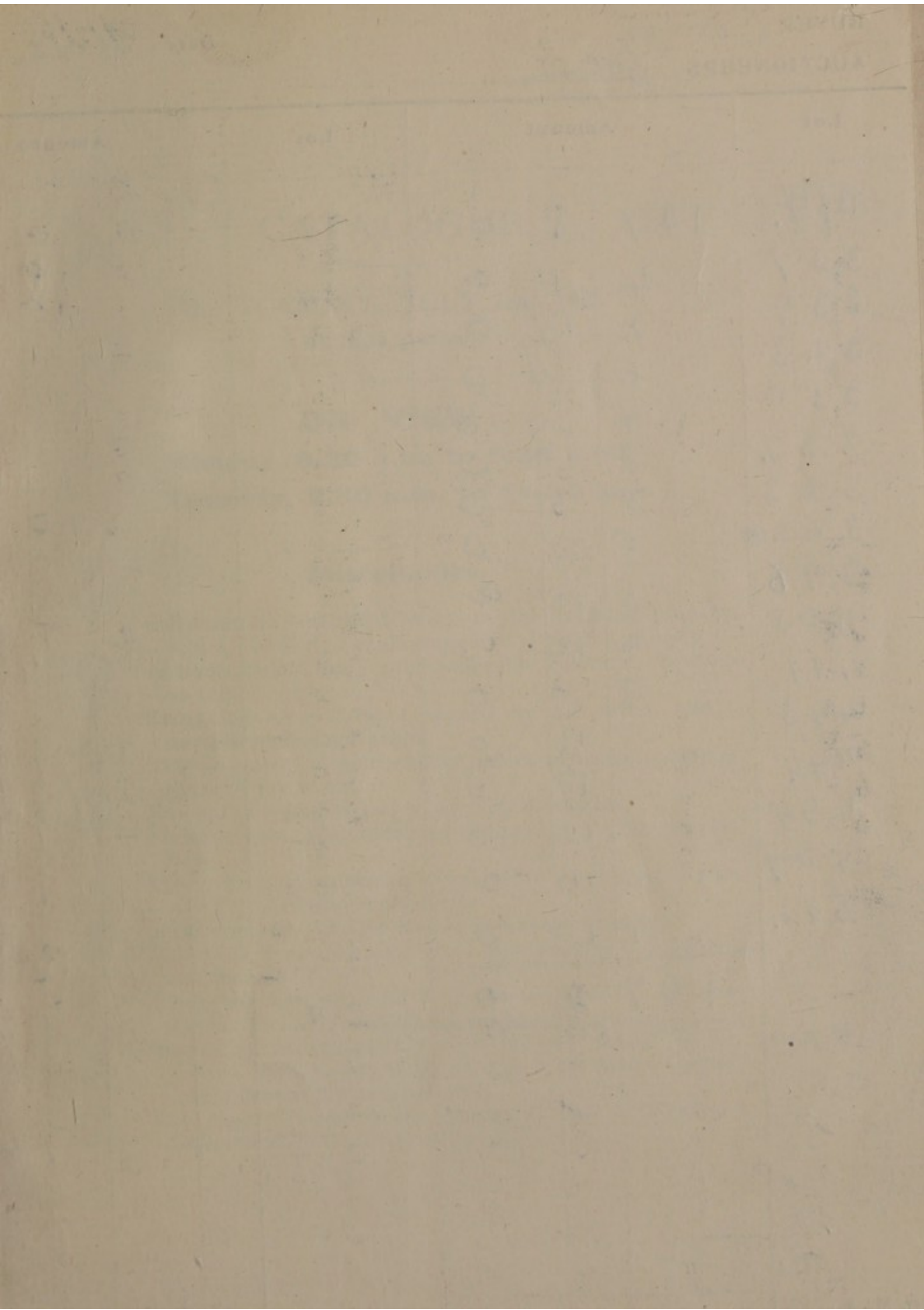

- 194 An English musketeer's sword of the 17th Century, with swept hilt and reversed curved quillons; the blade is inscribed ME FECIT SOLINGEN
- 195 A *fine executioner's or headsman's sword, with bronze pommel and quillons, the blade is marked with the running wolf, and inscribed S+S—"Sacrificium Sanctum," the monogram of the Free Judges Tribunal; German 17th Century*
- 196 An English Cromwellian trooper's broadsword, with long 2-edged blade and pierced shell guard
- 197 An early 17th Century Highland claymore, with basket hilt of rare type
- 198 A 2-handled sword with grooved blade and chiselled hilt
- 199 A basket-hilted Highland broadsword, with tall conical pommel, the 2-edged blade dated 1737
- 200 A Colishmarde rapier, the hilt finely chiselled with figures in relief; it bears traces of gilding

- 208 A curved sword in silver-mounted scabbard, bearing Georgian hall-marks

- 210 A fine Russian flintlock pistol, the stock of walnut wood mounted with engraved silver
- 1/101-257/211 An old English powder flask of large proportions, with engraved brass mounts
- 40/212 A figure, mounted, with buff leather boots, cabasset, etc., 2/101-ward in the costume of a pikeman of Elizabeth's reign
- 213 A *cup-hilted Spanish 16th Century rapier of fine quality, with chiselled and pierced hilt, the quillons of great width; the long 6-sided blade is grooved and inscribed*
- 214 A Colishmarde rapier, with finely pierced and chiselled hilt
- 215 A French rapier of the 17th Century, with pierced shell-guard; the fine quality blade of diamond section is grooved and inscribed
- 216 An English mortuary broadsword of the Commonwealth period, with chiselled basket hilt and back-edged grooved blade
- 217 A *very fine early Colishmarde rapier with silver hilt; the shell-guard is inscribed and dated 1672*
- 218 An early Scottish claymore, with basket hilt of rare type
- 219 A fine French 17th Century broadsword, with double ringed guard; the blade is inscribed Sahogon, and marked with the running wolf

- 222 A 16th Century pikeman's pott helmet, or cabasset, of bright steel ; *circa* 1580
- 223 An Indian gold-mounted sword, a scimitar, and a dagger with silver-mounted sheath
- 224 A fine closed helmet of bright steel, with fluted skull in the Maximilian manner ; it has a bold vizor of the bellows type, and is pierced for breathing ; at the base of the skull appears a plume holder

- 226 A reinforcing plate, or placcate, of bright steel, used in the tilt yard
- 227 An oak chest, containing numerous genuine pieces of ancient armour of the 16th and 17th Centuries

- 229 A Spanish 17th Century broadsword, with cup hilt ; the 2-edged blade bears an armourer's mark
- 230 A rare and fine Italian broadsword, entirely of steel ; it has a very broad blade, small guard, and 2 knuckle bows ; mid-17th Century
- 231 An English Cromwellian trooper's broadsword, with pierced guard and 2-edged blade ; 17th Century
- 232 A fine 16th Century French rapier, with swept hilt of unusual design, and long '4-sided blade
- 233 A rare military officer's sword, with gilded hilt and silver grip ; the blade is engraved and inscribed Nova Scotia Fencibles (this sword retains its original tassel)
- 234 An Italian rapier, with finely pierced blade, and embossed silver hilt
- 235 A fine swept hilted Spanish rapier, with blade of diamond section and chiselled hilt ; 16th Century
- 236 An English Royalist broadsword, with embossed hilt, and inscribed grooved back-edged blade ; 17th Century

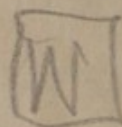
