

UNIQUE ELIZABETHAN MEDICAL CHARM STONE, made of a rare polished black stone with spots, curved to fit the Brang body; this stone had special curative properties for diseases of the spleen, it was worn fastened over the affected spot; the only other specimen known to exist is in the British Museum. (The stone and workmanship of this piece are considered by several experts to resemble strikingly that of Ancient Mexico; it is possible that it was brought over in the earliest days of the Conquest of Mexico)






