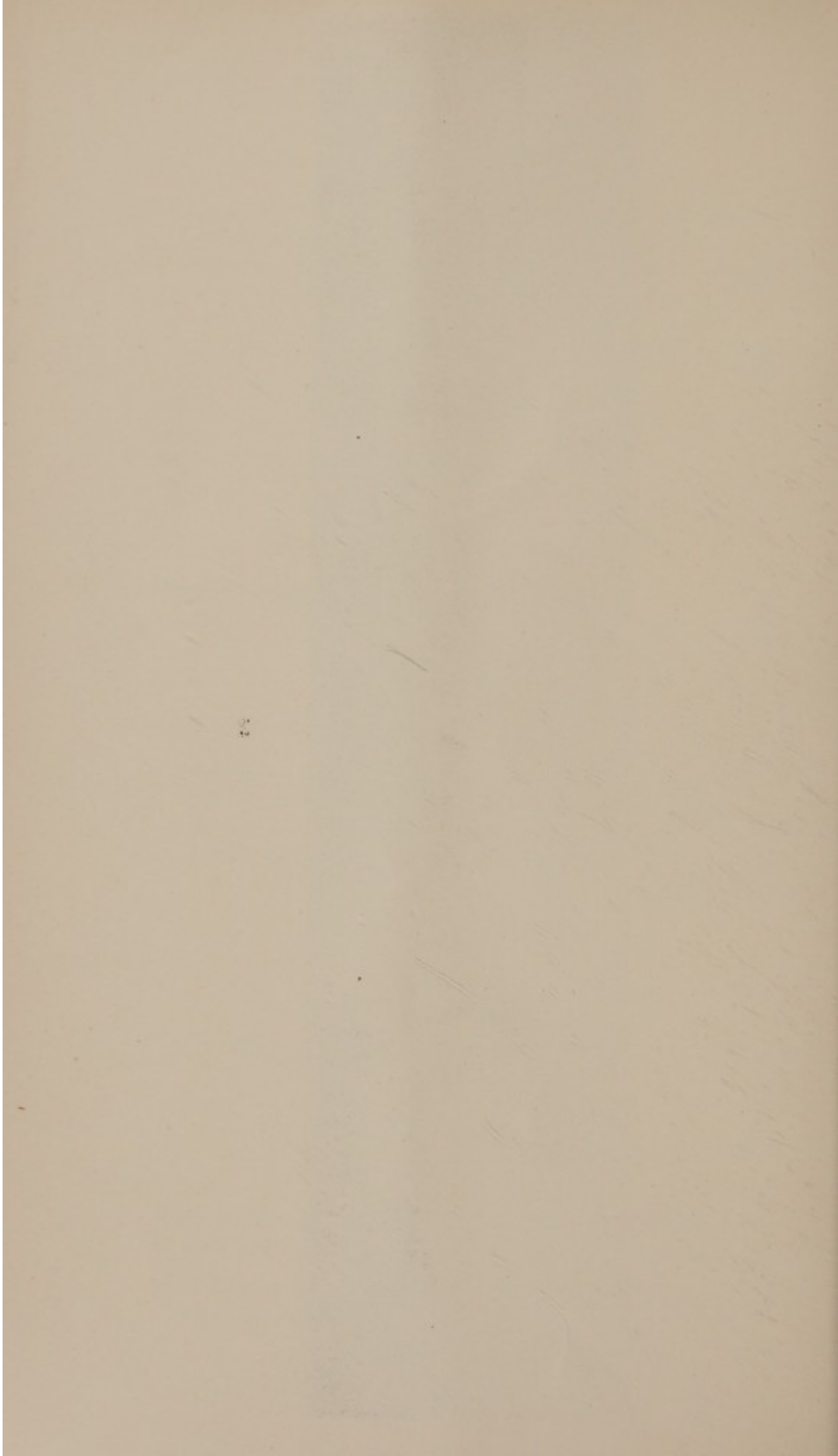

Ferneley painted several examples of this famous picture, and the present example would seem either to be that painted in 1833 for Lord Gardner, or the one ordered by Mr. R. S. Shafto in 1834. Major Guy Paget in his new and exhaustive work on Ferneley deals fully with the subject and quotes an interesting account, written by Squire Osbaldeston himself, of the behaviour of his Field, which led to the painting of the original sketch of The Hunt Scurry.

The celebrated Whissendine Brook is referred to in many old Hunting Songs and Poems, notably "The Dream of an Old Meltonian," by W. Bromley Davenport, M.P. ; and "A Ten Mile Point from Ashby Pastures to Woodwell Head," 1826.

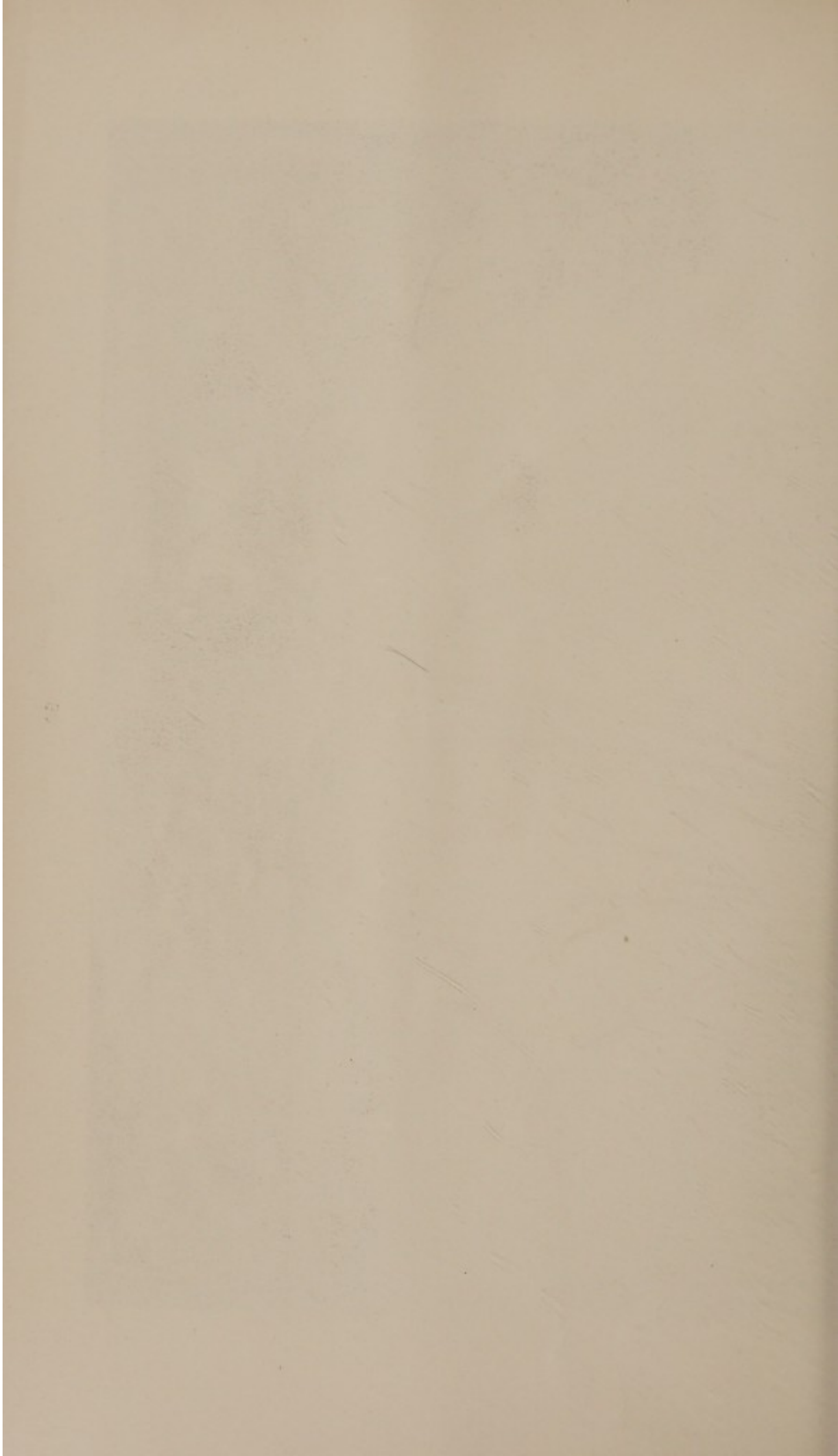
