 - 479 An Imari bowl, a ditto jar and cover, 2 oval dessert dishes, blue and white tea pot, caddy and basin, with monograms, a Delft wall pocket, 2 beaker vases, a 3-handled loving cup, a castle crocus vase, 2 water vessels, 2 metal spill vases, and a saucer, with apple-green border
 - 480 A coloured parian group of 2 ladies, forming a double inkstand, 2 Dresden figures, 2 ditto cups and saucers, 2 vases and covers and a pillar candlestick, encrusted with flowers, cottage inkstand, and 2 figure ornaments
 - 481 Two pink silk lamp shades, painted satin-wood tea caddy, wicker dog basket, 6 window dust screens, with gauze panels, 2 mahogany washstand drawers, red felt hassock, Japanese lamp shade, and a green plushette covered overmantel rest
