

A minute and curious drum of horn, played by using the mouth as a sounding board and thus producing many notes; 2 native tooth brushes, all from Nyasaland; and a war charm, New Caledonia

An antique Benin ivory war whistle decorated with snakes and cowrie-shells, an Indian figure in marble, and a rare ditto in steatite of a god being swallowed by a whale

341 A rare old metal mask used in religious ceremonial dancing, representing a Chinese devil

Another ditto in wood, very old, and with inscription inside; and a well-carved mask of Hotei with movable jaw, Japanese

A scare-devil to keep away disease, cleverly carved from a cocoanut, Nicobar Islands

344 Ancient and rare type of Mexican stone-ware idol, inlaid with metal

Native Curios, Various.

- A Siamese bronze god of archaic type; a ceremonial thunder-bolt, Tibet; a New Guinea charm in the shape of an octopus; and an elaborate chain anklet from Ceylon
- An interesting and very scarce bronze Tibetan "Wheel of Life and Death," supported by the Great Demon of Impermanency and with inscription at back, worn as a charm suspended round the neck and containing the ashes of a deceased Lama mixed with clay
- A Tibetan bronze altar-box in form of a skull with silver teeth, and inscribed with charm words; very rare and curious
