- 69 A CIRCULAR URN-SHAPED INCENSE BURNER with side handles, and band of raised decoration under rim ; *on carved wood stand*

- 70 A Pair of Kyilins, figures of a lion with embroidered ball ;  $13\frac{1}{2}$  in.  
 (2)
- 71 A Figure of the Goddess Kwan-Yin, with child and one attendant,  $9\frac{1}{4}$  in. ; and another with dragon and two attendants,  $8\frac{1}{2}$  in. ; *faulty*  
 (2)
- 72 Another pair, seated on lotus thrones holding a peach ;  $8\frac{1}{2}$  in. (2)
- 73 A male seated Figure, 8 in., and a female standing Figure, 13 in.  
 (2)

## GREEN GLAZES.

- 74 A pair of shallow Bowls with green glaze, decorated with incised branches in brown and yellow, seal mark ; 8 in. (2)

## ORANGE GLAZES.

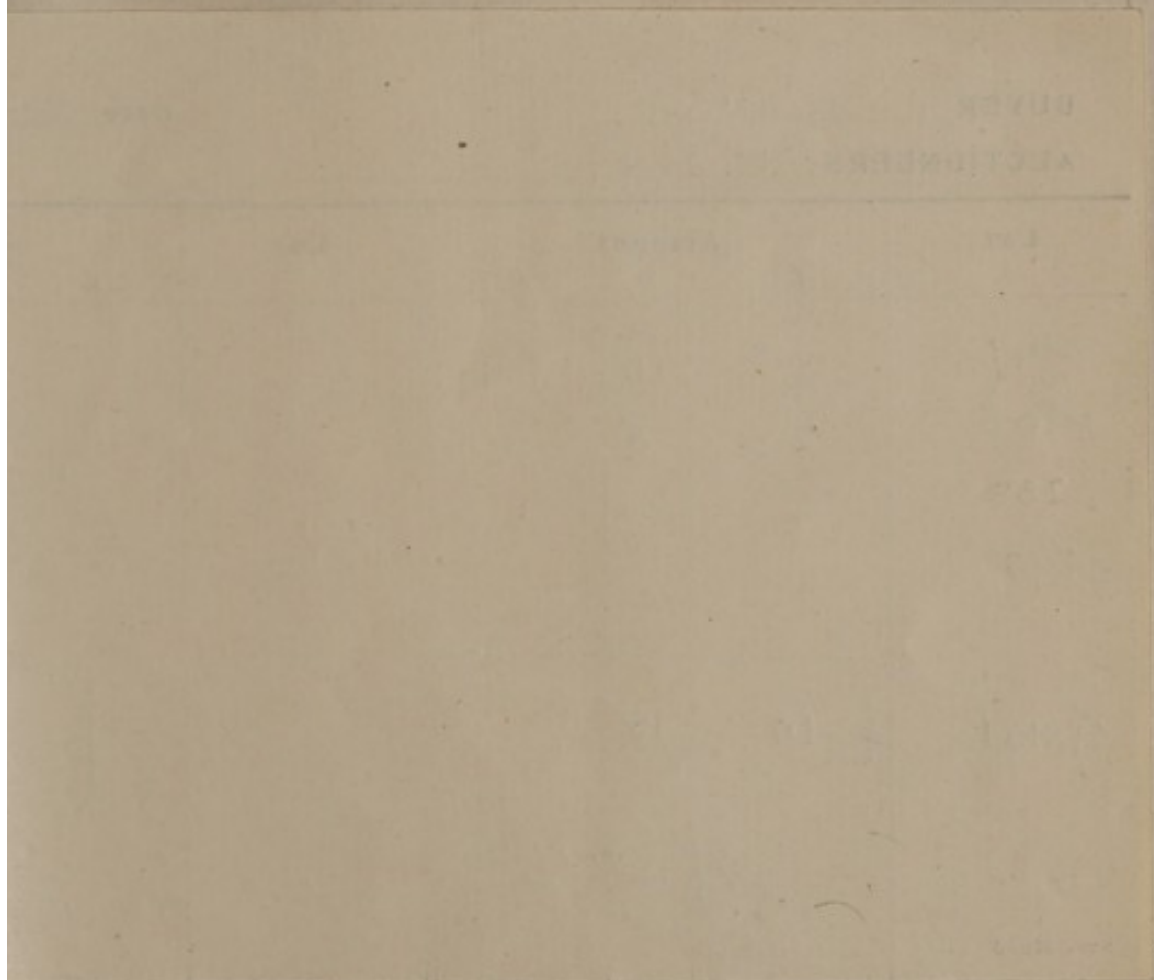
