201 Fine specimen of a Jivaro chief's shrunken head, long hair, and with cords in lips (Ecuador, South America)

- Another, with features well preserved, short hair, and no cords in lips
- Skull with lower jaw (damaged), exceptionally massive and with remarkably narrow and highly-ridged crown (Eskimo, Arctic America)
- 204 British Columbian skull of a woman of the extinct *Chin-Tsei-talo-Ialo-Nooten* Indians (Fraser River, B.C.), and a skull of a Negro, found on Fraser River (both with lower jaws)
- 205 Australian skull (damaged), no lower jaw, and a low type of skull dug up at Blandford, Dorset, about 100 years ago (no lower jaw)
 - North New Guinea skull of a chief, with face reconstructed and with shells inserted for eyes and cane pegs in place of some teeth
 - Trophy skull with lower jaw bound on and roughlycarved frontal, bound with fibre rope and attached to a carved meat-hook for suspension (North New Guinea)
 - New Hebrides artificially deformed skull, face has been reconstructed with fibre and clay, but this is much broken away (Mallicolo)
 - New Britain skull mask, used in the Torebian spirit dances, made from the front portion of the skull of a chief, the features being reconstructed in clay, and with a cross-bar for holding in mouth of dancer who was to impersonate the dead chief
 - Solomon skull with reconstructed face, with cut pearl shell decoration inserted and hair attached, nose and ears are broken; an old specimen, and very scarce
