Size 9ft. 9in. x 7ft. 9in. English XVIII. Century.
The above carpet was worked between the years 1740-1745 by an ancestress of the present owner, and has been in her family ever since. There is no written record of the cause of the Royal Arms in the centre, but it has been suggested that the carpet might have been used on the occasion of a Royal visit to Scotland, as the husband of the lady who worked it held an official court position at that time.
