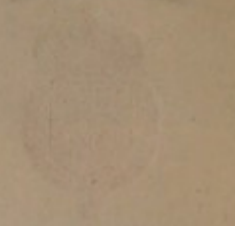
Dear Sir,

One of our clients ~~who~~ has been collecting for many many years, all books on the **DOMESTIC CAT** in all languages, (he has succeeded in collecting some 2,500 volumes or more, and never thought that his Collection would ever be for sale). Of late, however, his income has been curtailed and he is afraid he will have to do without his Collection of CAT-Books.

As in all such collections there are many titles which probably couldn't be found for all the searching in the world - but for which nobody seems inclined to search! So far as I know and can learn this is the most extensive collection in existence on the subject; and I know of few desirable titles which it lacks (Foujita's **LES CHATS** is one)."

He further writes that he would want about 1700 dollars for this Collection.

If you are interested, we will ask our client for the list which he intends to make.

We should be asking 15% commission in addition - and of course you would pay freightage from the United States to London.

To our knowledge, this is the only large Collection of CAT-BOOKS in the world, as the owner bought several collections of books from rival collectors and united them with his own.
