WORKS OF ART, ETC.

ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 22nd, 1943

- 1 A set of the INSIGNIA of the ANCIENT ORDER OF BUFFALOES, in pewter, comprising eight maces with a dove, the crescent moon, orbs, a diamond, etc., *some 28in. long*
- 2 A Jewish brass lamp for seven oil-wick lights, with shield shape back boldly engraved with Hebrew inscription
- 3 Three others with pierced backs, one modelled with Hebrew inscription
- 4 A carved wood reliquary cross and an ivory crucifix mounted on cherry wood
- 5 An Italian bronze gilt pieta, 16th century, *from the Steed Coll.*
- 6 A wax ANGUS DEI in gilt bullion frame, dated 1754, and mounted in glazed case
- 7 An iron-bound coffre-fort with stamped leather covers to the interior compartments and illumination of The Savior Mundi inside the lid, *12in. wide*



- 8 An oak medicine chest with applied balusters fitted with drawers, 17in. wide
- 9 An antique life size bronze head of VENUS, her hair bound with a fillet with a cinquefoil ornament at the centre
- 10 An Indian carved cocoanut bowl on quadruple silver foot and two others, plain
- 11 Two Indian paintings on paper of entertainment scenes in the presence of a Royal party with armed guard, etc., *circa* 1800
- 12 An Indian chased oval metal tray and a pair of damascened vases, an old wood casket with carved bone applique, and an early mechanical burglar alarm, *a.f.*
- 13 A faience Benetier decorated in green and yellow with a figure of a mendicant
- 14 A Persian iron opium pipe with long gold damascened stem, two Chinese bamboo pipes, another in wood with grotesque head and brass mouth piece, and five others
- 15 A Bavarian pipe, the carved wood bowl formed as a lion rampant with silver mounts and a Turkish pipe in red clay with gilt and enamel mounts, *a.f.*
- 16 A green glass mosque lamp with decoration in blue and gold, and another in bowl form with iridescent incrustation
- 17 A pair of Persian lacquer panelled doors decorated with hunting and audience scenes in panels on a chocolate red ground, decorated with a great variety of birds and animals, and with blue gilt arabesque borders, 19in. wide by 6ft. high, 17th century
- 18 A pair of old oak doors, the panels carved with figures of saints, and with sacred inscriptions with old iron bolt, and lock, 16½in. wide by 5ft. 8in. high
- 19 A pair of oars decorated with dolphins and one with the Prince of Wales feathers
- 20 An Indo-Portuguese casket inlaid with engraved ivory and fitted with drawers, 23½in. wide



- 21 Another inlaid with mother-o'-pearl, standing on legs, 26in. wide
- 22 A Moorish silk gold embroidered portiere with panels of inscriptions on a blue ground with column and arabesque patterns, 9ft. high
- 23 An old hide covered trunk and three others, smaller
- 24 A musical box in inlaid rosewood case, 16in. wide, a.f.
- 25 Another with under cabinet containing four extra cylinders, 22in. wide
- 26 A Regency mahogany stationery case with drawer, side racks, paper weights, and writing slide with metal gilt mounts, 22in. wide
- 27 A pair of Moorish painted wood wall candelabra for three lights, an early oak carved wood bracket with mask head, another carved with flowers and an old wood salt box
- 28 Two old English wood hand churns, and a pair of carved wood candlesticks, a.f.
- 29 An Indian circular mirror on lacquered stand, another rectangular inlaid with silver and ivory, and a hand mirror inlaid with mother-o'-pearl
- 30 A mahogany adjustable shaving mirror with magnifying glass, and another with double magnifying glasses
- 31 Two Moorish painted wood brackets, a mahogany circular stand, a small wood folding coffee table stand, and a cylindrical glass machine for generating frictional electricity
- 32 Two Kris with carved wood hilts and four others
- 33 A Kris with gold hilt formed as a figure set with rubies and a sapphire, *the head has been broken off*, the blade inlaid with silver, in waved lines
- 34 Another with the hilt formed as a figure of a man in silver gilt with gold applique blade, another with carved wood hilt and chased silver scabbard, and another with engraved silver scabbard



- 35 Two Kris with ivory hilts, two with carved wood hilts and four others
- 36 A Japanese sword with sharkskin scabbard, and two others with lacquer scabbard
- 37 Another, large, with leather scabbard and three others
- 38 Four Japanese swords with black lacquer scabbards
- 39 A long Japanese sword with open bamboo scabbard, another with lacquer scabbard and sharkskin grip, and three others
- 40 A Chinese sword with green sharkskin scabbard with gilt metal mounts, and a Japanese dagger with white sharkskin scabbard
- 40A A pair of steel octagonal tapered Goads with bronze hilts formed as dragons heads, in leather scabbard
- 41 A Japanese dagger with wood and ivory scabbard, an Indian knife with leather scabbard, and three hunting knives
- 42 A Ghurka knife in leather scabbard, and three others
- 43 Six others, one with silver inlaid hilt
- 44 A large Ghurka knife with leather scabbard, another, and a kris with silver bound wood scabbard

#### FURNITURE, ETC.

- 45 An inlaid mahogany specimen cabinet fitted with eighteen drawers, 38in. wide
- 46 Another with fall down front enclosing small drawers
- 47 A mahogany cheese stand with turned legs and under platform, 20in. wide
- 48 A Chippendale mahogany low table with drawer, on cabriole legs, claw and ball feet, 21in. wide, and a fruitwood spinning wheel



- 49 A walnut oval low table with shaped and moulded border, on cabriole legs, carved with shells, 36in. wide
- 50 An old oak chest with metal lock plate and mounts, 35in. *wide*
- 51 An oak cupboard enclosed by a pair of doors with raised and sunk panels, with moulded border, 55in. *wide*
- 52 A mahogany side table with carved front with cabriole legs carved with shells, on ball and claw feet, 53in. *wide*
- 53 A Hepplewhite triple chair shield-back settee, with acanthus carved splats and square tapered legs with cane seat, 66in.
- 54 A pair of large oak Gothic style arm chairs covered in red velvet
- 55 A windsor elbow chair with wheel back and two others
- 56 Two windsor elbow chairs with shaped backs, and another
- 57 A Sheraton mahogany chair with shaped rail back and two others
- 58 A set of four mahogany chairs in Chippendale manner with openwork backs carved with foliage and rosettes, on carved cabriole legs and ball and claw feet
- 59 A Georgian inlaid mahogany architect's table, 34in. *wide*
- 60 A Georgian mahogany corner chair with super imposed back extension on cabriole legs with X stretcher
- 61 An oak Glastonbury chair and another with rail back
- 62 A set of six oak chairs of Chippendale design with carved shaped backs and open carved splats, on cabriole legs with claw and ball feet
- 63 A mahogany triple chair back settee in Chippendale style, with shaped and pierced splats, on square legs and stretchers, 66in. *wide*
- 64 A walnut chair of Queen Anne design on carved cabriole legs with claw and ball feet, and two others
- 65 A SET OF FIVE AND TWO ELBOW HEPPLEWHITE MAHOGANY CHAIRS with shaped backs with carved lattice splats with paterae and festoons on turned legs, cane seats
