#### WORKS OF ART, ETC.

- 1 A large painted wood vessel in the form of a bird, another, smaller, a circular painted bowl, dated 1750, a large wooden circular bowl, another, and two others
- 2 A circular painted wood bowl on foot, dated 1852, *Norwegian*, another carved with lid, and three carved wood food bowls, lined with brass, one oval with an iron ring handle
- 3 A carved oak figure of MOSES, and two carved figures of choristers
- 4 A pair of Chinese large painted wood kylins, a Tibetan carved hard wood figure of a sage, and a carved and painted wood figure of a man singing, *European*
- 5 A pair of brass Gothic style lanterns with figures of THE VIRGIN and CHILD
- 6 A pair of gilt metal pricket candlesticks and four others, in carved and gilt wood, *a.f.*
- 7 A pair of Indo-Chinese chased incense burners with pierced covers, set with turquoise, and a pair of pierced and chased Moorish lanterns with ruby glass panes



- 8 A Persian pierced and enamel lantern fitted for electric bulbs, and four others
- 9 A brass pierced Moorish lantern, two others, smaller, a brass censer, a spherical lantern inlaid with silver and copper, and four others
- 10 A tall lantern with circular piercing, with pierced and chased dome, another with lattice piercing, lined with red fabric, a copper brasier and cover, a bucket with copper hoops, and an iron pomegranate inlaid with gold
- 11 A brass jardiniere inlaid with silver, two despatch cylinders, a vase and cover set with turquoise, three circular flat boxes, and sundry other articles
- 12 A large pierced and chased copper mosque lamp, an early copper bowl, repoussé with pyramidal moulding, and a wrought iron stand, *modern*
- 13 A processional cross, and a crosier with angel's heads, and a ship model
- 14 A ceremonial metal banner with bells, enamelled with the Royal Arms, and a painted and lacquered and painted Indian ceremonial paddle
- 15 Two large pewter axes for ceremonial usage as bottles by the appropriate Guilds as inscribed, another formed as a malet, another heart shaped, and a circular one, *German*
- 16 A large key of similar origin, a shuttle, a horseshoe, another with screw neck, the body repoussé with THE HOLY FAMILY
- 17 Two ceremonial hands, a foot, a book and a tailor's iron
- 18 A triangle, a set square, a wheel, a double fish, another formed as a knot, and two badges
- 19 A Persian copper ewer of unusual form chased with arabesques, with snake handle, on pierced foot, and another with double spouts terminating in zoomorphic heads
- 20 A large Persian brass ewer with a dragon in relief, and figures at the junction of the handle, the bodies moulded with bands of conventional ornament
- 21 A Persian ewer with spiral moulding, another with dragon handle, a tankard, and a circular food vessel chased with conventional ornament



- 21A A Persian bowl enamelled with portraits, and a silver and enamel Persian hookah bowl
- 22 A Japanese chased copper kettle with champleve enamel and kylin finial
- 23 A Persian steel dove inlaid with gold on perch, a bowl chased with figures inlaid with gold, and a small vase inlaid with silver
- 24 A pair of Persian revolving mirror cases with sun ornament inlaid with gold
- 25 An early Italian large seal die, a bronze trivet cauldron, three Persian ewers, camel bells and sundry other articles in bronze, etc.
- 26 A large gridiron, another, a pair of tongs, two trivets, a folding trivet, and sundry other articles in iron
- 27 A mahogany brass mounted mechanical bellows, and another
- 28 Four leather camel collars mounted with red cornelian oval plaques
- 29 Sundry leather black jacks, water bottles, and various vessels in skin, wood, etc.
- 30 A Japanese mask of RANYU, in original black and gold lacquer box, 17th century
- 31 Two carved mahogany plinths, an old wood firkin and a barrel
- 32 A model of an Indian village with numerous figures, on glazed case, on stand, 33in. wide
- 33 A post office telegraph wheel for measuring distances
- 34 Four carved wood figures of bears, Swiss, 17th century, 20in. high
- 35 A pair of Empire bronze vases with figures in relief, enriched with gilding, on red marble bases, 16in. high
- 36 A pair of upright gilt wood open show cases, 25in. high
- 37 A large terrestrial globe on stand, by W. & A. K. JOHNSTON, Edinburgh, 1861
- 38 A large wood sleigh with carved lion mask, probably Swiss, 18th century, and a bob sleigh



- 39 Another in carved and painted wood with panels painted with skating and carnival scenes, *Dutch, 17th century*
- 40 Another in carved and gilt wood painted with landscapes and birds, *French, 19th century*
- 41 Another in carved and gilt wood with openwork and panels painted with landscapes and figures, *Dutch 18th century*
- 42 A set of four carved and painted gilt wood wall plaques with oval paintings of interiors with figures of saints, 31in. high
- 43 A Majolica plaque painted with a military portrait, another in Persian style, and two others
- 44 Six early glazed pottery bowls, sundry pieces of glazed Persian pottery, eight small Siamese cups, and other articles, *a.f.*
- 45 Four early pottery jugs, and other various articles in pottery, *a.f.*

- 46 A Persian flint-lock gun inlaid with silver and gold, and another of similar type with ribbed barrel
- 47 A Moorish snaphaunce gun, and four other Persian flint-lock guns
- 48 An Arabian flint-lock gun with engraved silver stock inlaid with brass, and three other Oriental guns
- 49 A Persian flint-lock with rifled engraved octagonal barrel, with brass mounted stock, a Moorish flint-lock inlaid with ivory, and two others
- 50 Two Moorish snaphaunce guns with engraved locks and inlaid ivory butts
- 51 Two Persian flint-locks with engraved steel stocks, two others with brass stocks, and another
- 52 Six various Persian flint-lock guns
- 53 A German wheel-lock gun with rifled barrel, the stock inlaid with ivory, and with powder compartment with ivory slide



- 54 A Persian short flint-lock gun with lock and barrel inlaid with gold, another with silver mounts and two others
- 55 A Moorish short match lock gun inlaid with ivory, a flint-lock with rifled barrel and brass inlay, and two others of short type
- 56 A Persian flint-lock gun with *locka* barrel with chased silver mounts
- 57 A short Moorish flint-lock gun and three others
- 58 Four various Moorish snaphaunce guns
- 59 Six various Persian and Moorish flint-lock guns
- 60 A Persian match-lock gun inlaid with gold, two Moorish snaphaunce guns and a flint-lock
- 61 A Moorish snaphaunce gun with engraved lock, the stock set with coral, and two other snaphaunce guns
- 62 A Moorish snaphaunce gun with chased silver mounts, the stock with red enamel, and two others
- 63 A pair of Burmese pierced and chased silver anklets
- 64 Eleven various cross bows
- 65 Two Moorish match-lock guns and four various flint-locks
- 66 Three Moorish match-lock guns, and three flint-locks
- 67 Four Moorish match-lock guns and two flint-locks
- 68 A Chinese percussion gun, the barrel inlaid with brass and silver, and with inlaid ivory stock, an Indian flint-lock gun with silver inlaid barrel bound with brass, a Persian flint-lock gun, the barrel inlaid with gold, with silver mounts, and an Indian short match-lock with silver and ivory inlay
- 69 A European flint-lock gun with silver mounted lock and butt, another, percussion, two repeating guns, and another
- 70 A Japanese match-lock, the barrel engraved with dragons, a match-lock with brass mounts, an African flint-lock with steel engraved stock, and a flint-lock with octagonal barrel



- 71 Two Indian match-lock guns with silver mounts, a flint-lock gun with carved fish-tail stock, Italian type, North African, and three others
- 71A A box containing a large variety of Oriental daggers, knives, swords, etc.

## FURNITURE, ETC.

- 72 An oak arm chair with carved and shaped back, carved with a panel of figures
- 73 Three old French oak hall chairs with carved backs, one with armorials and monograms
- 74 An old English mahogany corner reading arm chair on cabriole legs, with claw and ball feet, and with adjustable book rests fitted to each arm
- 75 A mahogany carved Glastonbury chair with leather seat and back
- 76 A pair of ebony elbow chairs inlaid with ivory with loose cushions, covered in red damask
- 77 An old English oak corner arm chair, the back carved with dolphins, with carved frieze and gadroon border
- 78 An old English mahogany elbow chair with leather seat and back and with square legs and stretchers, and a mahogany invalid chair
- 79 A Regency mahogany elbow chair with scroll shaped arms carved with lions mask, on cabriole legs with paw feet, upholstered in red velvet
- 80 A carved oak kneeling chair with X shaped side supports and a Chinese black hard wood stand with marble top
- 81 An Oriental mahogany octagonal coffee table carved with animals and tracery
- 82 A Chippendale quadruple chair settee with shaped back with pierced splats, scroll shaped arms, on cabriole legs with claw and ball feet, 7ft. wide
- 83 A set of six Regency rosewood chairs with square shaped backs and openwork splats, covered in green velvet

- 84 A pair of Italian gilt wood stools, the legs carved with figures, with scroll shaped stretchers carved with cherubs
- 85 A Hepplewhite mahogany chairman's arm chair with shaped back and pierced splat, and square fluted legs and stretcher
- 86 An old windsor elbow chair with wheel back, and two others, smaller
- 87 Two ladder back chairs with rush seats, and two carved oak hall chairs
- 88 A French oak settee in *Louis XV style*, with triple chair back, with carved interlaced splats on carved cabriole legs, with claw and ball feet, cane seat, *7ft. wide*
- 89 Four oak triangular corner chairs with turned arms, legs and stretchers
- 90 An Indian lacquered chair with low seat, with shaped and pierced rail back, on baluster legs, two Moorish low chairs with pierced and carved backs, and another, smaller
- 91 A pair of rosewood chairs with rail backs and cane seats
- 92 A French ebonized glazed display cabinet with porcelain side columns, and Sevres plaques with flowers on a pink ground, ormolu mounted, *35in. wide*
- 93 A Dutch corner cupboard carved and gilt with foliage, fitted with drawers and enclosed compartments, with painted panels, *17th century, 48in. wide*
- 94 A Chippendale mahogany settee with triple chair back with shaped and carved scroll tops, with openwork splats with carved cabriole legs
- 95 A pair of French gilt wood torcheres with carved fluted columns on triangular bases, with hoof feet
- 96 Another pair with spiral columns carved with foliage on a black ground, and two others
- 97 An ebonized corner bracket with shelf with porcelain columns and mirror back
- 98 A mahogany miniature cabinet fitted drawers, inlaid with ivory lines



- 99 An old mahogany barber's chair, the arms carved with swans heads, with stuffed seat and back, covered in red velvet
- 100 A Jacobean oak elbow chair with carved panel back, and baluster legs and stretcher
- 101 A French walnut carving chair with shaped arms terminating in carved animal heads, on carved cabriole legs, covered in stamped red velvet, *circa* 1700
- 102 A pair of Spanish oak arm chairs, the backs carved with armorials and crowns with square fluted legs, and carved stretchers, covered in red velvet with applique needle-work
- 103 A set of four Chinese carved black hardwood elbow chairs, and another, smaller
