- 4 Three cotton dresses, another, printed, and a quantity of cotton bodices.
- 5 Four embroidered cotton dresses, and four others, silk, etc., *English, early XIXth century.*
- 6 Four silk brocade dresses, and two petticoats, *English, XIXth century.*
- 7 A dress of blue silk brocade, trimmed with black lace, *Victorian*, and two others of pink and blue silk damask.
- 8 A dress of red silk brocade, *XVIIIth century*, another of pink silk, *Victorian*, a printed dress, a ditto petticoat, and a small panel of brocade.
- 9 A quantity of bodices, of silk brocade, lace, etc.
- 10 A quantity of bodices of printed cotton, four jackets, two capes, three bonnets, and three other pieces.

- 110 Another, painted with insects, flowers and fruit in panels on diaper ground, on three feet, *Ming*, 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. diam., wood cover and stand.
- 111 Another, painted with a garden scene and figures, on three feet, *Ming*, 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. diam., wood cover and stand.
- 112 Another, painted with dragons and flames, on three feet, *Ming*, 9in. diam., and wood cover.



- 113 A Nankin hexagonal vase and cover, painted with phoenix and cranes in shaped panels, and with conventional scrollwork, *Ming*, 10in. high, and wood stand.
- 114 Another, painted with ducks, fish and lotus plants, 6½in. high, wood cover and stand, and a square shaped vase, painted with dragons and formal flowers, 6¼in. high, *Ming*.
- 115 A Nankin square vase, painted with kylins at play, the borders with joey heads, etc., *Ming*, 5¾in. high, wood cover and stand.
- 116 A Nankin vase, painted with formal peony branches, *Ming*, 7½in. high, and wood stand.
- 117 A pair of Nankin octafoil vases and covers, painted with dragons and phoenix, *Ming*, 6½in. high.
- 118 A Nankin vase, painted with figures in a garden, 7in. high, and another, with formal flower branches, 6½in. high, *Ming*, and one wood stand.
- 119 A Nankin vase with cylindrical neck, painted with formal peony branches, *Ming*, 9in. high, and wood stand.
- 120 A vase with yellow glaze, painted with formal peony branches in blue and red, *Ming*, 5¾in. high.
- 121 A Nankin vase, hexagonal shape, painted with formal lotus branches, 5½in. high, and a beaker, with flowering trees, 9¼in. high, *Ming*.
- 122 A pair of Nankin beakers, painted with garden scenes and figures, *Ming*, 7¼in. high.
- 123 Five Nankin plates, painted with river scenes, buildings, and figures, and with diaper borders, *Ming*, 8¾in. diam.
- 124 Five Nankin saucer dishes, painted with river scenes, figures in boats and on the banks, *Ming*, 8in. diam.

- 131 A Nankin circular dish, painted with dragons and clouds, *K'ang-hsi*,  $13\frac{1}{2}$ in. diam.
- 132 A Nankin large circular dish, painted with a basket of flowers in the centre, the shaped border with flowers and emblems in alternate panels on scale and diaper pattern grounds, *Ming*,  $19\frac{3}{4}$ in. diam., and hardwood stand.
- 133 A Nankin oblong shallow jardinière, the exterior and border painted with flower branches, *Ming*, 18in. wide.
- 134 A Nankin circular dish, the centre and borders incised and painted with lotus and peony branches on yellow ground,  $13\frac{1}{2}$ in. diam.
- 135 A circular dish, incised with dragons and flames under the glaze, *blanc de chine*, 15in. diam.
- 136 A circular dish, *blanc de chine*,  $15\frac{3}{4}$ in. diam.
- 137 A vase, modelled with cranes and lotus plants on yellow ground, the border with formal peony branches, and with kylin masks in high relief, *famille verte*, *K'ang-hsi*,  $10\frac{3}{4}$ in. high.
- 138 A pair of figures of quail, with mottled blue glaze,  $6\frac{1}{2}$ in. high.
- 139 A pair of figures of parrots, with green, yellow, and aubergine glazes,  $7\frac{1}{4}$ in. high, and two others,  $7\frac{3}{4}$ in. high.
- 140 A pair of seated figures of kylins, on oblong pedestals, with green, yellow and aubergine glazes,  $7\frac{3}{4}$ in. high.
- 141 Another pair, nearly similar,  $9\frac{3}{4}$ in. high.
- 142 A pair of seated figures of Kwan-yin, on lotus thrones,  $11\frac{1}{2}$ in. high.
- 143 An oblong box and cover, surmounted by a kylin, and with green, yellow and aubergine glazes, *K'ang-hsi*,  $3\frac{3}{4}$ in. wide, and a kneeling figure of a boy, holding a bowl,  $6\frac{1}{4}$ in. high.

- 144 A quatrefoil shape pedestal, painted and enamelled with flowers, on *rouge de fer* diaper ground, and pierced,  $4\frac{1}{4}$  in. high, and another, circular, with turquoise and dark blue glazes,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in. diam., wood cover and stand, *Ming*.
- 145 An oblong pedestal, modelled with four kylin masks, and with turquoise borders on aubergine ground, *Ming*,  $6\frac{1}{2}$  in. wide, wood cover and stand.
- 146 A circular koro with aubergine glaze, on three feet, *Ming*, 5 in. high, wood cover and stand.
- 147 A pillow, modelled with a peony branch in cream, in low relief on grey ground, *Sung*,  $9\frac{3}{4}$  in. wide.
- 148 A bottle shape vase, with splashed blue and brown glazes,  $14\frac{1}{2}$  in. high.
- 149 An oviform vase, with *sang de bœuf* glaze,  $14\frac{1}{4}$  in. high.
- 150 Another, *sang de bœuf* splashed with blue,  $13\frac{1}{2}$  in. high.
- 151 A standing figure of an immortal holding a child, his costume enamelled with flowers and fruit on blue ground, *famille rose*,  $20\frac{1}{2}$  in. high.
- 152 A teapot and cover, enamelled with boys riding buffalo, and with flowers on *rouge de fer* and gilt ground, a milk jug and cover, and a tea cup and saucer of the same service, *famille rose*, *Yung-chêng*.
- 153 A pair of turquoise figures of parrots, on pierced rock bases,  $8\frac{1}{4}$  in. high.
- 154 A pair of Nankin circular dishes, painted with a boy on a balcony, the border with flowers in panels, and with emblems, *K'ang-hsi*,  $12\frac{1}{4}$  in. diam.
- 155 An oviform vase and cover, painted and enamelled with figures in panels, and with formal flower branches on green ground, *K'ang-hsi*,  $19\frac{3}{4}$  in. high.

- 166 A Queen Anne walnut small bureau, with inlaid borders, the fall-down front enclosing divisions, etc., and with three drawers under, 36in. wide.
- 167 A Queen Anne walnut chest of five drawers, with moulded borders, on stand, with drawer and club legs, 40½in. wide.
- 168 A mahogany four fold screen of Chippendale design, with pierced fretwork border, the panels mounted with Japanese prints, 45in. high.
- 169 A William and Mary oak small oval folding table, on spirally turned gate legs and plain stretchers, 32in. wide.
- 170 A Chippendale mahogany small chest of five drawers, and writing slide, 34½in. wide.



- 171 A Georgian mahogany dressing table, with two drawers and moulded border, on club legs, 39in. *wide*.
- 172 A Chippendale mahogany arm chair, the seat and back covered with green velvet, and with carved scroll elbows, on square legs.
- 173 A Chippendale mahogany chair, the fluted and pierced back carved with foliage scrolls.
- 174 A QUEEN ANNE WALNUT BUREAU BOOKCASE, enclosed by a pair of doors with mirror panels and with moulded cornice, the fall-down front enclosing small drawers, etc., and with five drawers under, 41in. *wide*.
- 175 A Charles II walnut day bed, the back pierced and carved with amorini supporting a crown, and with foliage scrolls, spirally turned side columns, legs and stretchers, cane seat and back panel, 57in. *long*.
