- 269 A silver neck chain, 4 ditto, set with various stones, and gold bracelet, in case, set with stones and pearls
- 270 A pair of gold earrings, a ditto brooch, set with jade stones, and 5 gold brooches
- 271 Five silver wrist watches, and a ditto keyless watch
- 272 Ten gold and other brooches, set with various stones
- 273 A silver serviette ring, 30 loose stones, 2 bead necklaces, spade guinea, and other coins
- 274 Two gold studs, and a gold watch chain, fob and seal
- 275 A gold lorgnette, in case, and 2 ditto scarf pins, set with pearls and other stones
