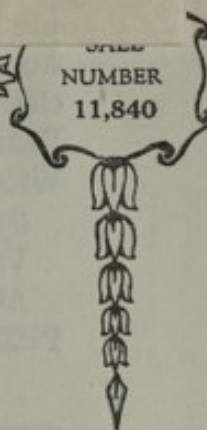

- 208 A pair of easy chairs *en suite*, each with loose cushion
- 209 A ditto couch *en suite*, with bolster cushion
- 210 A pair of ditto easy chairs
- 211 A couch, covered in yellow silk damask
- 212 A carved wood Indian pedestal with marble top, and a ditto jardiniere stand
- 213 A 3ft. oak combination bedstead with hair mattress
- 214 An oval mirror, in mahogany frame, a pierced brass fender, and a towel horse
- 215 A mahogany writing table, fitted 3 drawers
- 216 A circular mahogany tea table, on club legs
- 217 Eleven satinwood and rosewood standard chairs, with stuffed seats in velvet (1 a.f.)

- 225 A Louis XV. ormolu cheval fire screen with glass panel
- 226 A clock with striking action, in marble case, surmounted by bronze equestrian figure and tiger
- 227 A pair of bronze Marli horses
- 228 A Chinese carved wood cabinet, fitted shelves, with sliding panelled front
- 229 A 4ft. mahogany writing table, fitted drawers
- 230 A brass standard lamp, fitted for electric light, 2 brass jardinieres, an oak hat rack, and 2 wood brackets
- 231 A 3ft. mahogany chest of drawers, on stand
- 232 An oak hall table, fitted 2 drawers and gong of 4 bells
- 233 An easy chair, in cotton, with loose cretonne cover
