

- 462 A 3ft. 6 ditto dressing chest of 4 drawers, bevelled swing mirror over, plate glass top, and a ditto pedestal cupboard with glass top
- 463 A 4ft. 6 tubular brass bedstead with deep box spring mattress, overlay, bolster and 1 pillow
- 464 One pair of heavy double blankets, 3 single blankets, a double eiderdown, and a single ditto
- 465 A mahogany 2-tier bedside table with flaps, a 4-fold Japanese screen, a 2-fold fire-screen, a copper electric kettle, 2 electric coffee percolators, a brass table electrolier, and sundry electrical utensils, etc.
