

### **Rules referring to the Endowment of Cots.**

1. The Committee may allot a cot to any donor of not less than £250 to the Endowment Fund for the period of the life of the donor. Such donors may name the Cot. A Cot may be named in perpetuity by any donor of not less than £500.
  2. The Committee may allot a Cot to any Subscriber of ten guineas annually, and such Subscriber may name the Cot, but only for a period during which such payment is continued.
  3. When a Cot is allotted under either of the preceding rules, the person to whom it is allotted may, whenever the Cot is vacant, nominate a child to occupy it, such child being a proper case for admittance into the Hospital according to the Rules. The Cot shall be deemed vacant, although in fact occupied, if the occupant is not a nominee, and can properly be moved to some other empty Cot in the Hospital.

### **Extract from Rules referring to the Admission of Patients and the Visits of their Friends.**

- 1.—Any sick child under 13 years of age whose parents are unable to pay for medical aid shall be deemed fit to be received as a patient, provided it be not suffering from any infectious disorder; but no child shall be admitted, or permitted to remain as an in-patient, whose case presents no reasonable hope of cure; nor if it may be satisfactorily treated as an out-patient.
- 2.—Children shall be admitted as in-patients according to the discretion of the Acting Medical Officers; each Medical Officer having so far as practicable an equal number of beds at his disposal, if he requires them. A patient admitted by a Medical Officer shall be considered his patient while in the Hospital.
- 3.—Cases of accident or urgency shall be admitted at any hour.
- 4.—When any child has been an in-patient for three months, the Medical Officer whose case it is shall report the circumstances of the case to the House Committee, and they shall then decide whether the child shall be allowed to remain in the Hospital.

5.—No child shall be re-admitted as an in-patient within six months of having been discharged, or whose parents have removed it against the consent of the Medical Officer attending to it, except in either case by the special leave of a Visitor for the month.

### VISITORS.

7.—Friends of in-patients shall not at any time be allowed to visit them except in cases where in-patients are dangerously ill, and then only on the Medical Officer in charge of the case, the House Surgeon, or the Matron authorising such a visit.

8.—Friends of the patients may not bring them any kind of food or drink, except with the express sanction of the Hon. Medical Officer in charge of the case or of the House Surgeon.

## ANNUAL MEETING.

17th February, 1936.

The Chair was taken by the Deputy-Mayor, Councillor A. W. BAKER, J.P.

2. The Hon. Secretary read the Annual Report.
3. The Hon. Treasurer read the Annual Statement of Accounts.
4. The following resolutions were passed:—

## THE ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1935.

The Board has pleasure in presenting the sixty-seventh Annual Report of the Hospital and the ninth in respect of the Home.

The In-patients admitted to the Hospital during the year numbered 1,104 compared with 1,072 in 1934, and the daily average of Cots occupied was 52.6 compared with 51.5. In the Out-patient Department the total number of attendances was 41,056 compared with 34,685. 257 major operations were performed compared with 267.

At the Kielberg Home the number of children admitted was 248 compared with 203 in 1934 ; the average length of stay was 39.2 days against 47.2 and the average daily number of patients was 26.3 which was the same as last year.

The increasing amount of work with which the Hospital is being called upon to deal has inevitably necessitated a larger nursing staff, and the need for increased staff accommodation in the Hospital has, in consequence, become very acute. This is a matter which has had the attention of the Board for some time and it is hoped soon to have plans formulated to deal with the situation.

The Fracture Clinic held weekly by Miss Isabella Forshall, M.B., F.R.C.S., has proved a great boon in reducing the danger of permanent disability and in releasing beds for more acute cases.

The work done in the Holttum Laboratory of Pathology, as detailed elsewhere, continues to play an important part in helping the Medical Staff in their diagnoses and in combating the spread of infection.

The Hospital has now been fully recognised as a Training School for Nurses, following an inspection by a representative of the General Nursing Council in February, 1935. All the nurses, seven in number, who took their preliminary State Examination in May were successful.

The Board has to report with regret the resignation of three valued members, namely, Mrs. Leslie Hughes, Mr. C. J. L. Cottle and Mr. Neil McLaren. In addition to giving

much time to the Hospital itself, Mrs. Hughes was its representative on the Birkenhead Charities Ladies' Committee.

The following have been elected to serve on the Board : Mrs. Edward Lloyd, Mrs. Donald Yorke, Mr. A. Parker, Mr. G. Ravenscroft and Mr. H. B. Vernon.

Mrs. Marquis has kindly undertaken to represent the Hospital on the Birkenhead Charities Ladies' Committee.

Mr. W. D. Wattleworth was appointed Honorary Secretary in succession to Mr. F. C. Gregory, who had held the position for over six years. Throughout the period he held the office Mr. Gregory was unremitting in his attention to the affairs of the Hospital and Home, and the Board desires to place on record its appreciation of his very valuable services.

Dr. A. V. Russell was appointed Honorary Physician in succession to Dr. R. W. Brookfield, who found that other calls upon his time made it necessary for him to resign. Dr. Brookfield had held the appointment for four years, and his services are greatly appreciated.

It is with great regret that the Board has received an intimation from Mr. W. T. Wood that, for business reasons, he will be unable to accept re-election as Honorary Treasurer. Mr. Wood has now been Honorary Treasurer for thirteen years and the Hospital and Home owe him a great debt of gratitude for the vast amount of work which he has so willingly and efficiently done during his term of office and for the keen interest which he has always taken in their affairs. It is pleasing to know that his retirement will not sever his connection with the Charity, as he has consented to become a Patron.

## OBITUARY.

It is with feelings of deep regret that the Board records the deaths of Mr. Joseph Heap, Mr. P. H. Hope, Mr. W. Horlick and Mr. Samuel Ravenscroft. Mr. Heap was a Trustee of the Hospital and Mr. Hope had been a former active Committee member, while

Mr. Horlick and Mr. Ravenscroft had been generous friends.

### STAFF.

Miss J. W. Allsobrook, who had been Matron of the Hospital for over twelve years, resigned the position in May. During her time of service the number of beds was almost doubled and the Hospital became a Training School for Sick Children's Register. Thanks are due to her for the very efficient manner in which she carried out her duties and dealt with the many problems arising out of the expansion of the Hospital's activities.

Miss A. L. Trowbridge was appointed to succeed Miss Allsobrook and began her duties on 1st July.

Sister-Tutor Parkinson has been appointed Assistant Matron and Sister-Tutor.

Miss E. K. English, who had been Registration Clerk and Assistant to the Almoner for nearly three years resigned in September to take up another position. Miss B. Alison Gray was appointed to succeed her.

### THE KIELBERG CONVALESCENT HOME.

Continued its excellent work of convalescent treatment for the children. The Matron received a surprise visit from Mr. F. K. Kielberg in July and was greatly encouraged by his appreciative remarks on the work and the management.

The Home Committee wish to record their thanks to the Trinity Needlework Guild for 232 garments. The Annual Sale of the Children's Handicraft and Peter Pan Stall, held on June 10th, raised a sum of £15 nett for the Home.

Efficiency certificates were granted to Nurses Hinchcliffe, Egerton and Ellis.

One of the most gratifying features of the year has been the completion of the endowment of **the "Birkenhead News" Children's Corner Cot**, the result of a magnificent effort which has been made during the years 1928-1935, in which period £500 has been raised. The Board wishes to record its very special thanks to the Editor, the Officers and all members and associates of the Children's League, and to express its appreciation that a further effort is to be launched to endow a Cot at the Kielberg Home, in memory of the late Editor, Miss J. H. Willmer.

The Board wishes once again to express its appreciation of the work of the Ladies' Committee, and of all the kind friends who have assisted. The activities of these Committees include house-to-house collections by Lady Collectors, the organisation of Pound Day and Egg Days, and the valuable work of the Ladies' Linen Guild. The Subscription list would be much smaller if it were not for the persevering efforts of the Lady Collectors, and in this connection special thanks are due to Mrs. Swan, who has re-organised the Rock Ferry district and gained a substantial increase there. It also records its very sincere thanks to all members of the Honorary Staff. Their time and services have been most willingly given and the value of the skill and knowledge which they have placed at the disposal of the Hospital cannot adequately be expressed.

## FINANCE.

The expenditure of the Hospital during 1935 exceeded income by over £500 and this report cannot be closed without emphasising the need for increasing the list of annual subscribers. It is a regrettable fact that a certain number of subscriptions are lost each year, partly through the death of subscribers or through their removal to some other part of the country, and to make up the loss thus taking place the Board

would appeal to all annual subscribers to bring the Charity to the notice of friends who do not already subscribe and specially to the notice of newcomers to the district.

Knowledge is extending its power to combat sickness and suffering, but as the work of the Hospital and Home increases, so does the expenditure. An adequate expansion of income is vital if the work of relieving the sufferings of children and of helping to improve the health of the future citizens of the town is to continue to grow in value and scope, but if each present subscriber could




