

Rules referring to the Endowment of Cots.

- 1. The Committee may allot a cot to any donor of not less than £250 to the Endowment Fund for the period of the life of the donor. Such donors may name the Cot. A Cot may be named in perpetuity by any donor of not less than £500.
- 2. The Committee may allot a Cot to any Subscriber of ten guineas annually, and such Subscriber may name the Cot, but only for a period during which such payment is continued.
- 3. When a Cot is allotted under either of the preceding rules, the person to whom it is allotted may, whenever the Cot is vacant, nominate a child to occupy it, such child being a proper case for admittance into the Hospital according to the Rules. The Cot shall be deemed vacant, although in fact occupied, if the occupant is not a nominee, and can properly be moved to some other empty Cot in the Hospital.

Extract from Rules referring to the Admission of Patients and the Visits of their Friends.

- 1.—Any sick child under 13 years of age whose parents are unable to pay for medical aid shall be deemed fit to be received as a patient, provided it be not suffering from any infectious disorder; but no child shall be admitted, or permitted to remain as an in-patient, whose case presents no reasonable hope of cure; nor if it may be satisfactorily treated as an out-patient.
- 2.—Children shall be admitted as in-patients according to the discretion of the Acting Medical Officers; each Medical Officer having so far as practicable an equal number of beds at his disposal, if he requires them. A patient admitted by a Medical Officer shall be considered his patient while in the Hospital.
- 3.—Cases of accident or urgency shall be admitted at any hour.
- 4.—When any child has been an in-patient for three months, the Medical Officer whose case it is shall report the circumstances of the case to the House Committee, and they shall then decide whether the child shall be allowed to remain in the Hospital.

5.—No child shall be re-admitted as an in-patient within six months of having been discharged, or whose parents have removed it against the consent of the Medical Officer attending to it, except in either case by the special leave of a Visitor for the month.

VISITORS.

- 7.—Friends of in-patients shall not at any time be allowed to visit them except in cases where in-patients are dangerously ill, and then only on the Medical Officer in charge of the case, the House Surgeon, or the Matron authorising such a visit.
- 8.—Friends of the patients may not bring them any kind of food or drink, except with the express sanction of the Hon. Medical Officer in charge of the case or of the House Surgeon.

THE ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1936.

The Board has pleasure in presenting the sixty-eighth Annual Report of the Hospital and the tenth in respect of

the Kielberg Home.

The in-patients admitted to the Hospital during the year numbered 1,064 compared with 1,104 in 1935, and the daily average of Cots occupied was 47.8 compared with 52.6. In the Out-patient Department the total number of attendances was 35,210 compared with 41,056 in 1935, and 34,685 in 1934. 284 major operations were performed compared with 257 in 1935.

At the Kielberg Home the number of children admitted was 212 compared with 248 in 1935; the average length of stay was 45.8 days against 39.2, and the average daily number of patients was 27.1 against 26.3.

There has been no relaxation in the work carried on in

all Departments.

The attendances at Miss Forshall's weekly Fracture Clinic total 1,086 against 713 for nine months of 1935. The value of such a Clinic, with regular examinations by an orthopædic expert, in preventing disability following fractures is being more and more widely recognised and the subject is receiving the close attention of the Ministry of Health. The Masseuse co-operates with Miss Forshall at the Clinics and carries out remedial treatment, which is an added safe-

guard against the danger of permanent disability.

The Board has to report that many improvements, structural and otherwise, have been put in hand or completed during the year. The most important of these is the provision of increased Staff accommodation, so greatly needed. For this purpose two houses in Brattan Road, Nos. 3 and 5. which adjoin the Hospital, were purchased and are now in course of adaptation in accordance with plans drawn up by the Hospital's Architects. The new property has been connected to the Hospital by a covered corridor and comprises seventeen rooms, with pantry, bathrooms, etc. The Hospital's central heating and hot water supply plants have been extended to supply heat and hot water to the new block and at the same time the heating plant is being modernised by the installation of Automatic Stokers, which will result

in a substantial saving in the cost of fuel. The new premises

will be ready for occupation very shortly.

The X-ray Department has been brought up-to-date and a new shock-proof apparatus installed at a cost of approximately £460. An X-ray Fund was inaugurated and donations totalling £292 have been received. The Board takes this opportunity of expressing its thanks to all who have assisted the Fund.

Other improvements include the installation of new sterilisers in the Main Theatre, the Out-patient Department and the Dispensary, and the installation of an automatic telephone service and a refrigerator. All these have proved very successful and have resulted in greater efficiency in the working of the Hospital.

OBITUARY.

The Board received with the deepest regret the news of the sudden death, on the 4th June, of its President, Mr. Walter Harding. It desires to record its great appreciation of the most valuable services, both in time and money, which he has rendered to the Hospital and the Home over a period of twenty-two years, during thirteen of which he occupied the position of President. It remembers with gratitude his gift of being able to bring so much help and cheerfulness to the children in their sufferings and his constant care and thoughtfulness in all matters affecting the interests of the nursing and administrative staffs.

The Hospital sustained a further loss through the death, on the 14th September, of Dr. H. Laird Pearson, who for thirty years served the Hospital as an Honorary Medical Officer. In 1923, on retirement from active work, he was elected Honorary Consulting Surgeon, a position which he held up to the time of his death. The Hospital and the whole neighbourhood are under a deep debt of gratitude for such valuable services, extending over more than 40 years.

BOARD.

The Board has to report, with regret, the resignation during the year of three valued members, namely; Mrs. Livingstone, Mr. Gordon Ravenscroft and Capt. Surtees, also that Mr. Oscar Prentice and Mr. Basil K. Stratton, both of

whom have rendered long and valuable service, are unable to offer themselves for re-election owing to business engagements preventing their regular attendance at Committee

Meetings.

The following were elected to fill the vacancies on the Board which occurred during the period under review—Miss Nora I. Beausire, Mr. G. Bearsley, Mr. G. E. Harding and Mr. R. M. Synge. Mr. Horace M. Williams, Vice-president, was elected to fill the post of President rendered vacant by the death of Mr. Walter Harding, and Mr. Frank Sharples was elected Vice-president. Both these gentlemen have been valued members of the Board for many years. Mr. Williams acted as Honorary Secretary of the Hospital from 1920 to 1928.

STAFF.

Three members of the Nursing Staff took their Preliminary State Examinations during the year, and all were successful in passing.

KIELBERG CONVALESCENT HOME.

The progress of the children sent to the Home during the year has been very marked, and the tedious and difficult period of convalescence is further brightened by instructive lessons which Miss Rhind is giving in addition to the handicraft classes.

At the American Tea held on the 18th June, the sale of the Children's work realised £10 6s. 2d., while the total proceeds

of the effort amounted to £60 4s. 10d.

The Trinity Church Needlework Guild and the Wirral Needlework Guild continue to send their welcome supply of garments, the former having presented 248 articles and the latter 30. The Home Committee wish to record their very grateful thanks and appreciation to the members for this valuable help. The Committee also wish to extend their thanks to Miss Leyland for her voluntary service in helping with the care of the children.

As announced in last year's Report, the "Birkenhead News" Children's League undertook to endow a Cot at the Home, in memory of the late Editor, Miss J. H. Willmer, following the completion of the endowment of the "Children's

Corner Cot" at the Hospital. The first instalment of £100 has been received, and the Committee wish to place on record their thanks to the Editor, the Officers and all members and associates of the League.

Efficiency Certificates have been granted to Nurses Thomas

and Jones.

Mr. and Mrs. Kielberg and their family continue their great interest in the Home and their visits bring pleasure and encouragement to Matron and the Staff.

The Board takes this opportunity of expressing, on its own behalf and on behalf of the patients and public, grateful acknowledgement and sincere thanks to the Honorary Medical and Surgical Staffs for their continued loyal and skilful service, which is so willingly given, also to the Matrons and members of the Nursing and Administrative Staffs for their devoted labours and constant care and attention to the welfare of the patients.

FINANCE.

This Report is a record of consistently good work and steady progress, but it will be seen from the Income and Expenditure Account of the Hospital (see pages 18/19) that the Hospital's total ordinary expenditure for the year exceeds the total ordinary income by £1,338. Part of the expenditure, it is true, is non-recurring, but even after taking that into account there is still a deficit in respect of recurring expenditure amounting to approximately £1,050.

All possible economies consistent with efficiency are being made, but the figures just quoted show the urgent necessity for a substantial increase in annual income. The Board appeals to all who have the welfare of children at heart to help to bring this about.

REPORT OF THE MEDICAL BOARD.

As in previous years a great deal of work has been carried out by the Staff—the treatment of acute and emergency conditions at Woodchurch Road, and the care of more chronic and convalescent cases at Kielberg.

The Out-patient Department is particularly busy, and it is constantly impressed on the Staff how greatly additional educational facilities for various types of weakly and physically defective children would supplement both medical and surgical efforts and render them of general value.

During the short period since the installation of the new X-ray apparatus its aid to first-class work has been clearly demonstrated to the Honorary Medical and Surgical Staff.


