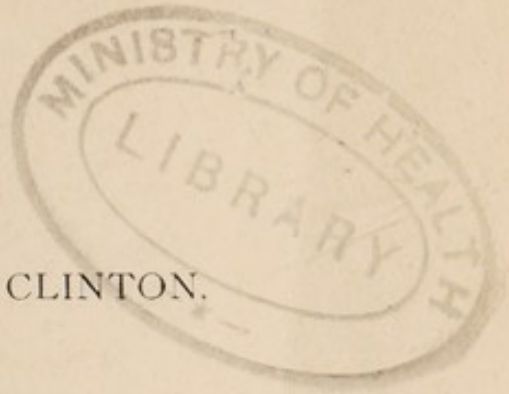

THE FORTY-FIRST
ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE
BUDLEIGH SALTERTON COTTAGE HOSPITAL

THE COMMITTEE has pleasure in presenting the Annual Report for the year ending November 30th, 1929.

At the commencement of the year eight Patients were in Hospital and 140 have been admitted since, making a total number of 148 cases treated during the 12 months. An increase of four on last year. The increase would have been much larger had the Hospital not been closed entirely for three weeks and partially for some six months, owing to the enlargements and improvements made during the year. The average duration of a Patient's stay in Hospital works out at $16\frac{1}{2}$ days. Fifty Patients have attended the Hospital for massage treatment. There were three deaths during the year.

Fifty-three operations were performed. Eleven being of a major character, and 22 cases of accidents were admitted.

Six Patients received Free treatment from the Needy Patients' Fund, and 26 under the Wage Earners' Insurance Scheme.

Eighteen new Subscribers have been obtained during the year and the Subscriptions show an increase of £14 5s.—and the Donations an increase of £114 10s. 6d., exclusive of the Donations given to the Building Fund. The Committee thanks the Subscribers for their continued and generous support.

The total Fees received from Patients amount to £722 10s. 7d., an increase of £158 6s. 4d. on last year. Thirty-eight Patients received treatment in the Private Wards, and the Fees from these amount to £629 11s., an increase of £280 18s. 8d. The sum of £52 13s. 4d. was received from various Health Insurance Societies, and £12 7s. 6d. from the Devon C.C. for treatment of School children.

Rose Day was most successful, realizing £127 19s. 3d., an easy record, and the Committee thanks Mrs. Irwin Clark, Miss Miles, Miss Milne and the Ladies who so kindly collected and all who helped in any way to secure such an excellent result. The Fête run instead of the Stalls, was a great success.

Miss Fradd kindly arranged a most excellent entertainment by the girls at Ingleside School for the benefit of the Hospital and the Committee was most grateful for the sum of £17 10s. 3d. as a result of the same.

Throuh the kind offices of Lady Alison a Donation of £15 was again received from the S.W.R.S.W. Society. This appears in the list of Donations to the Building Fund.

Heavy expenses were incurred by the Hospital last year in treating the Typhoid cases and, as the treatment was given by the Hospital in the public interest, the Council made a grant of £30 towards the extra costs. Pound Day and the Linen Guild always prove of great assistance to the Hospital and the Committee thanks Mrs. Fulton and Mrs. Hartree, and all who so kindly assisted them and those who generously contributed.

The Committee acknowledges with thanks the very efficient manner in which the Medical and Nursing Staff have carried on the work of the Hospital during the year.

To Mr. Maurice Goodman for his kindness in auditing the accounts and to all who have in any way assisted the Hospital the Committee tenders its grateful thanks.

The Hospital has been enlarged, improved and re-decorated throughout, and has now accommodation for 20 Patients. The new Women's Ward is up to date in every respect, a light, sunny and airy Ward, fitted with Vita Glass and all modern improvements and will, the Committee considers, compare favourably with any ward of the same size in any Hospital.

The various improvements will cost from £1,600 to £1,700. There was a very generous and prompt response to the Committee's appeal, and the Committee thanks all who have so generously contributed towards the cost. £80 15s. was raised by a Food Fair; £40 from Theatricals, arranged by Mrs. Rowlandson; £20 1s. 6d. from the Women's Institute; and £7 10s. from a dance got up by Miss Marks. All the accounts are not yet in, and it is estimated that rather

over £200 is still required to meet the cost. As the wireless set in the Hospital was not strong enough to supply the enlarged building, this set was removed to the Nurses' quarters and a new wireless installed for every Bed in the Hospital. This complete set was very kindly given by Mrs. Howard of Upmead, and the Committee and Patients are very grateful to her for her generosity.

The plot of land at the top of Boucher Road has been secured for the Hospital from the Rolle Estate; had this not been done the land would have been built on, to the detriment of the Hospital.

A very successful Carnival was held in the late Autumn for Budleigh Salterton and District. The sum of £40 was kindly contributed to the Hospital from the receipts. This was received in December, too late for inclusion in the accounts, but the Committee desires to take this opportunity of congratulating the organisers of the Carnival on their very successful effort, and of thanking them for their contribution, and also the Motor Club for their kindness in giving the Hospital £5 out of their portion of the proceeds.

The Annual Meeting of the Wage Earners was held in the Long Room of The Feathers Hotel, on November 30th. Mr. J. W. Palmer presided, and Mr. Hartree and the Hon. Secretary attended, as representing the Hospital Committee. The Report for the year was read by the Hon. Secretary, Mr. H. P. Perriam.
