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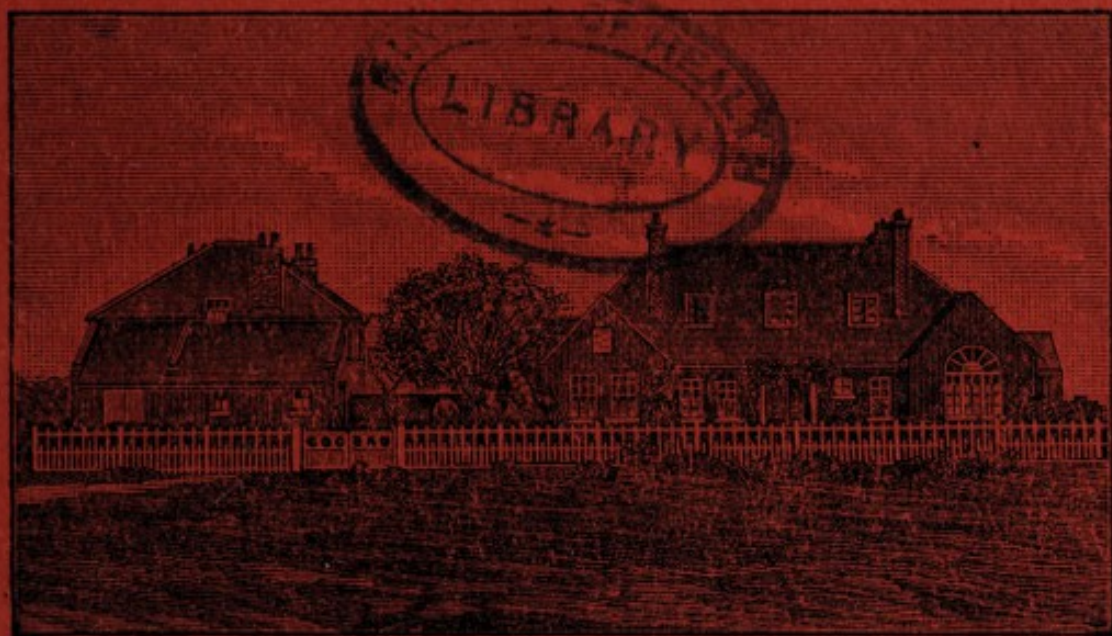

REPORT of the COMMITTEE of MANAGEMENT for the Year ending 31st December, 1928.

THE number of Patients admitted to the Hospital during the year was 313, and included in this number are 149 child Patients under 14 years of age. The increase of Patients was 84 on the number admitted in 1927. The number of Operations performed was 206, an increase of 95 on the previous year.

The X-Ray department dealt with 238 ordinary, and 57 dental patients, and a total of 685 films were taken.

In the Massage department 62 Patients attended, and the total number of treatments amounted to 912.

Under arrangements made with the Educational Committee of the Essex County Council a large number of children were operatively treated for enlarged tonsils and adenoids.

Acting on the advice of the Medical Officers of the Hospital a blind to completely darken the operating theatre was ordered at the end of the year to enable certain operations which can be better performed in artificial light, to be carried out in the day-time. (This has now been installed and is considered a success).

The X-Ray plant has been overhauled and brought up to-date with new additions and alterations.

The interior re-decoration of the Hospital was carried out during the autumn.

The Committee have to acknowledge the generous gift of a new wireless set, presented by Mr. A. Burns, which is much appreciated by the inmates of the Hospital.

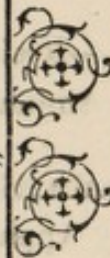
