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


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CLINICAL REPORT 1938



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Clinical Report for the Year ending 31st December, 1938

THE Intern Report deals with 838 mothers and 846 infants. Average duration of stay in Hospital, 16.6 days.

445 of the patients were primiparæ, and 393 multiparæ.

825 of the children presented by the vertex and 21 by breech.

8 cases of twin birth.

Infants stillborn 23. Rate 2.7%.

Infant deaths 12. Rate 1.4%.

Maternal pyrexia 19 cases. Rate 2.3%.

No maternal death occurred.

6 emergency cases were admitted.

2 mothers were transferred to other institutions. Both cases did well.

125 mothers were admitted for ante-natal treatment.

CASES OF TOXÆMIA OF PREGNANCY ADMITTED FOR TREATMENT.

67 cases. 3 babies died. 3 babies were stillborn. Fætal mortality 9.0%.

ECLAMPSIA.

No case.

ACCIDENTAL ANTE-PARTUM HÆMORRHAGE.

8 cases. No maternal death. 2 babies were stillborn. Fœtal mortality 25%.

Treatment:-

- 4 Artificial rupture of the membranes.
- 1 Artificial rupture of the membranes and Willett's forceps.
- I Leg brought down.
- 2 Nil.
- 2 Cases required blood transfusion.

PLACENTA PRÆVIA.

6 cases including 1 emergency and 2 transferred from the Out-Patient department.

No maternal death. I baby died. 3 babies were stillborn. Fœtal mortality 66.7%.

Treatment:-

2 Cæsarean Section.

3 Version.

I Nil.

VERTEX PRESENTATION.

825 cases of vertex presentation occurred.

The occiput was anterior in 621 cases, posterior in 176. In 28 cases the occiput did not rotate spontaneously. The treatment and result of these was:—

Spontaneous delivery, face to pubes, 10 cases. 1 child (twin) died..

Manual rotation and forceps delivery, 18 cases. 2 children were stillborn.

TRANSVERSE PRESENTATION.

2 cases. I baby was stillborn. Placenta prævia centralis. Fætal mortality 50%.

Treatment:-

Internal version and delivery as breech.

PROLAPSE OF CORD.

2 cases. 2 babies were stillborn. Feetal mortality 100%.

1 case Hydramnios (Forceps delivery).

I case first of twins. Breech.

ANTE-NATAL VERSION.

In 65 cases of breech presentation, external version was performed, 9 cases under an anæsthetic.

UNCOMPLICATED BREECH.

9 cases. 4 babies were stillborn.

Causes of stillbirths:-

I prematurity.

I toxæmia and prematurity.

1 deformity of chest.

I prolapsed funis (twin).

Fœtal mortality 44.4%.

COMPLICATED BREECH DELIVERIES (Excluding Breech by Version).

10 cases. 1 baby was stillborn—difficult extraction. Feetal mortality 10%.

POST-PARTUM HÆMORRHAGE (20 ozs. measured clot). 21 cases. No maternal death.

MANUAL REMOVAL OF PLACENTA.

12 cases. No maternal death.

INDUCTION OF LABOUR (Spontaneous Delivery).

Method A.—Medical Induction (i.e., castor oil and quinine). 163 cases. Stillbirths 3—(a) Postmaturity.

- (b) Pre-natal death at 5 months.
- (c) Cleft palate, talipes, etc.

Neonatal deaths, o. Fætal mortality 1.8%.

CÆSAREAN SECTION. 5 cases. No maternal death. 1 baby died. Prematurity and atalectasis. Placenta prævia. Fætal mortality 20%. Indications for Operation:— Contracted pelvis and disproportion
CRANIOTOMY. I case. Indication for Operation:— Failed forceps. Uterine fibroids.
