## REPORT OF BOARD OF MANAGEMENT.

The Board of Management have decided in the national interest that this, their forty-ninth Annual Report, should be in abridged form, and trust that their decision will meet with the approval of the Governors and Subscribers of the Hospital.

At the Annual Meeting, Major W. Harcourt Webb, J.P., was again unanimously re-elected President of the Hospital, and Mr. J. James as Honorary Treasurer. At the first Meeting of the year the Board unanimously re-elected Sir Sidney Law as Chairman, and Mr. J. M. Standish as Vice-Chairman, for the ensuing year. At the same meeting the Standing Committees were re-elected *en bloc* with the addition of Mr. F. S. Green to the House Committee, and Mr. L. Cartwright to the Finance Committee.

**Legacies.**—The following legacies have been received during the year and are most gratefully acknowledged to the Executors of the late :—

In spite of various difficulties experienced in many ways during the year your Board feel they have reason to be satisfied with the year's working and progress. The co-operation of the members of the Medical, Nursing, Clerical, Household and other Staffs has in no small measure contributed to those difficulties being surmounted, and to all Members of the Staffs your Board tender their very grateful thanks. Heartiest congratulations are extended to the successful candidates in the Primary and Final Examinations of the General Nursing Council. Valuable assistance has been received from numerous voluntary workers, and their efforts are especially appreciated.

**Library.**—Many gifts of books received during the year greatly helped to build up a useful sized library, and thanks are accorded to Miss M. Smith who kindly gave much of her spare time to the organisation of the Library. Her work in this direction has been greatly appreciated not only by the Board, but by the patients. In extending thanks to donors of books, the Board at all times welcome further gifts of books and magazines.

**Annual Subscribers.**—Your Board are pleased to report that a number of subscribers decided to enter into a Deed of Covenant to enable the Hospital to recover Income Tax on their annual subscription. To those subscribers who have not yet entered into this form of agreement, your Board appeal again for their kindly consideration. The appropriate form may be found on page 6. Amounts recoverable in respect of Deeds of Covenant completed during the year will be shown in the next Annual Report. An asterisk placed by the Subscriber's name denotes those who are participating.

**The Thomas Corbett Charity.**—A gift of £1,500 has been received during the year from the Trustees of the Thomas Corbett Charity, to be devoted towards the cost of providing a new Operating Theatre. Unfortunately owing to the outbreak of War it was not possible to proceed with this work. The Board are very grateful for this generous gift, and look forward to the time when the new Theatre will be a reality.

**Nursing Salaries.**—The question of salaries paid to Nursing Staffs has been a matter of controversy for a considerable time. Ultimately the Government recommended that a universal minimum scale should be adopted by all Voluntary Hospitals, and offered to make a grant towards the extra cost to Hospitals adopting their recommendations. Your Board decided that the recommended minimum scale should not only be adopted from August 1st, but should be retrospective from May 1st.

**Orthoptic Department.**—Owing to the increasing number of patients recommended for treatment in the Orthoptic Department it was found necessary to extend the number of sessions by two each week.

**Contributory Fund.**—It is with great pleasure that your Board refer to the continued benefit derived from the Corbett Hospital Contributory Fund, and offer their heartiest congratulations to the Workpeople, Employers, Chairman and Committees for their most valuable efforts.

**Income and Expenditure.**—It is gratifying to report that in spite of considerable increases in the cost of commodities the balance of Income over Expenditure amounted to £885. It must of course be realised that this balance is accounted for to a large degree by drastically curtailed purchasing owing to the rationing of many articles, and others being unobtainable. Your Board wish to impress upon the public generally that there is still an accumulated deficit of £757 5s. 6d. to be met, and they feel in view of the somewhat improved earning capacities that next year the income of the Hospital should more than cover this deficit.

The curtailment of this Report makes it impossible for individual reference to be made in the usual way to all the Subscribers and friends of the Hospital who have helped so nobly during the year, but your Board ask them all to accept their very best thanks for the many contributions which together have made such a magnificent result. An outstanding effort during the year which must call for special mention was that made by the Gymkhana Committee who organised the Gymkhana on August Bank Holiday afternoon, and which resulted in £304 15s. 6d. being donated to the funds of the Hospital.

In conclusion, your Board wish to express to the general practitioners of the district, the Press and all who have in any way assisted, their sincere thanks for the kindly co-operation during the year.
