ANNUAL REPORT

THE Board of Management herewith present their Report and the Accounts for the year 1945.

With the return of peace it has been possible for the Hospital to dispense with most of the exceptional measures imposed by the War and to revert to its normal activities.

In April last the Ministry of Health withdrew the additional beds set up as part of the Emergency Hospital Scheme Casualty Service, and it was found possible to increase the bed complement of the Hospital from 90 to 102 beds. The Children's Ward, which during the War had been used as the Air Raid Casualty Receiving Ward, has been reconditioned and returned to its pre-war use and, with a new Kitchen added, makes a complete and up-to-date Children's Ward Unit. There are still some further improvements pending which will add to the Hospital's usefulness and efficiency.

Apart from the cost to be borne by the Government in removing the protective measures, the main portion of the cost of these improvements has been borne by the Children's Ward Fund, which has been subscribed during the War by many generous donors whose names appear in the Schedule to this Report.

Appointments.

In November of last year Miss L. C. De la Court, D.N., resigned her appointment as Matron to take up a similar post at the Royal Portsmouth Hospital, and the Board of Management desire to place on record their very sincere appreciation of Miss De la Court's outstanding services to the Hospital over a period of ten years. Miss P. L. Huxtable, formerly Assistant Matron, was appointed to fill her place, and Miss A. M. Howard, Housekeeping Sister, was appointed Assistant Matron.

On the resignation of Dr. Donald Paterson, Hon. Consulting Paediatrician, Dr. Wilfrid Sheldon was appointed in his stead.

To the great regret of the Board the Rev. A. Shirley resigned as Hon. Chaplain upon his retirement from the living of St. Matthew's Church in October last, and the Rev. Canon F. S. L. Fitz-George, M.C., now Vicar of St. Matthew's, Redhill, has accepted that appointment in his place and has been elected to a seat on the Board.

Mr. A. T. W. Paine was elected to a seat on the Board of Management in January of this year, and both these appointments will be submitted for confirmation at the Annual Meeting.

Accounts.

The Accounts for the year 1945 show total receipts of $\pounds 28,479$ 2s. 3d., and a total expenditure of $\pounds 31,174$ 6s. 8d. — a deficit

of $\pounds 2,695$ 4s. 5d., corresponding with a deficit for 1944 of $\pounds 2,112$. In view of the increase in Staff Salaries and in the cost of provisions and repairs and of nearly every item of equipment and running expenses, this is not an unsatisfactory result. The prime cost of provisions for Patients, Staff and non-resident employees works out at 8s. 10d. a week per head.

They wish to thank the various Associations and individuals who have by means of Concerts or other entertainments contributed gifts to the Hospital, including the East Surrey Hospital Darts' Competition Committee, who have so far given ± 300 towards Bed Endowment Funds, and the Reigate Borough Police whose Concert arranged in December last resulted in the contribution of ± 150 to the Hospital's Funds.

Alexandra Rose Day produced £549 14s. 11d., and the thanks of the Board are extended to all who in any way helped on this occasion. It is hoped that they will continue their help in the current year, Rose Day being already fixed for Tuesday, 18th June, 1946.

Speaking generally, the Hospital has continued its beneficient work with a high degree of efficiency, and for this the Board's thanks are due to the Hon. Medical and Surgical Staffs, Visiting and Consulting, and to the Nursing Staff; the Ladies' Association and the Ladies' Working Party; and to the Clergy and Ministers, V.A.D. Nurses and all others who have willingly given their help.

In the State Examinations, held by the General Nursing Council for England and Wales, 15 Nurses completed their training and passed the Final Examination; and 12 Nurses passed the Preliminary Examination. Miss Sylvia Wright gained the Gold Medal for Merit presented by the Ladies' Association.

The following members of the Board retire by rotation and offer themselves for re-election: Mr. J. A. Paton, J.P., Mr. Norman Walker, J.P., the Mayor of Reigate, Dr. D. Mallam, Lieut.-Colonel F. J. Spranger, O.B.E., J.P., Mr. G. L. Norman and Mr. F. S. Shorter.

The Chairman, Mr. W. W. Paine, feels that in view of advancing years, and after twenty years' work for the Hospital, he can no longer bring to that work the energy and efficiency which its proper conduct demands, and he will accordingly retire at the Annual Meeting, which will be asked to appoint a new Chairman.
