OUT-PATIENT DEPARTMENT.—Once more the Committee would draw attention to the urgent need for building a new Department. Something like 140,000 Out-Patients are treated annually, and the present accommodation is totally inadequate.

The Committee is grateful for a contribution of £217, the proceeds of a Dramatic Entertainment organised by friends of the Committee.

Ladies' Association.—In addition to a contribution of £200, gifts of linen and other useful articles have been received from the Association. The Committee records its warm appreciation of the valuable work of the Association.

Dr. R. J. Minnitt's gift of a Thompson-Rowling Anæsthetic Apparatus to the Hospital is gratefully acknowledged by the Committee. COMMITTEE.—Major Duncan Campbell was thanked for his services as Chairman, and was re-elected. The Rt. Hon. Lord Wavertree and Mr. Samuel Rennie were elected Vice-Chairmen. During the year Mr. W. W. B. Stoddart and Mr. G. R. Stubbs joined the Committee. The latter was appointed Honorary Solicitor to the Hospital.

Obituary.—We record with regret the death of Mr. Theodore Garnett. He was a member of the Committee for forty years, and Honorary Solicitor to the Hospital. As a mark of appreciation of his valuable services, a Cot is named in perpetuity the "Theodore Garnett Cot."

Medical Staff.—The Committee places on record its warm appreciation of the valuable services of the Medical Staff and its loyal co-operation in all matters concerning the Hospital's welfare.

AUDITORS.—The best thanks of the Committee are hereby tendered to Messrs. Chalmers Wade & Co., for their services.

Finally, the Committee is warmly appreciative of the services of the British Red Cross Society, Liverpool Branch; the Liverpool Personal Services Society; the Lady Visitors; and all those who have so generously provided gifts for the benefit of the Patients and Nursing Staff.

"CLIFFORD TEMPLE" Home of Recovery—The cost of maintaining the Home was £1,747 and the Income from all sources including a Donation of £500 from Clifford Temple, Esq., was £1,586, leaving a deficit of £161.

The number of Patients transferred to the Home was 233, and the average stay of each patient 38 days. The average weekly cost per head was £1 7s. 7d.

The Committee wish to emphasise the great benefit patients derive from a period of residence at the Home situated as it is, in ideal surroundings.






