

# PATIENTS TREATED.

A comparison of the statistics of the year under review with those of the preceding year shows the following results:—The total number of In-patients treated to a conclusion was 2,300, against 2,149, an increase of 151; the average total daily number of patients was 99, against 99, the same as last year; the largest number of patients resident on any one date was 118, and the lowest 84.

The average time each patient was resident in the Institution was 15.70 days, against 16.76 in 1927.

The deaths which took place within 24 hours of admission numbered 28. The percentage of deaths to cases treated was 4.43, deducting deaths occurring within 24 hours of admission the percentage becomes 3.22, against 3.68 for 1927.

In addition to the 2,300 cases treated in the Wards, 9,250 Out-patients (many of whom attended several times) have received treatment in the Medical and Surgical Out-patients Department, and also in the Special Departments. Out-patient attendances for the year total 59,262, against 51,575 for the previous year.

The pressure on the bed accommodation continues, the volume of work performed exceeds that in any other year in the history of the Hospital. There has been an average of 170 persons awaiting admission to the Wards.

# Workmen's Collections.

Contributions from workmen, staffs and other employees shows an increase of £396 16s. 0d. over the amount received during 1927. The Committee express thanks for the support given, and also again appeal most urgently to those who do not contribute through this source. All trades and occupations are represented among those benefitting at the Institution, and that they should be more largely represented in the list of contributors is the earnest wish of the Committee.

# Congregational Collections.

An increase in contributions from this source is reported, and it is gratifying that the Churches in both town and district have taken such a warm interest in the affairs of the Hospital during the year. The gifts of Fruit, Vegetables, Flowers, Eggs, etc., from the various Church Festivals are deeply appreciated.

# Entertainments.

The Committee are grateful for the continued support given to the Institution by the Sports, Whist Drive and Dance Committees, and the promoters of all other entertainments. A detailed list is found on pages (50-52). We do not forget the services of the various Aid Committees and Women's Institutes in the outlying areas, the Darlington Rotary Club for their initiative in organising many of these Committees, the Teachers and Scholars in the Schools under the Darlington Education Authority, Mr. William Hossent, the Organiser and Honorary Secretary of the Mayor's Xmas collection, and also the interest of the Mayor and Mayoress (Coun. J. F. J. and Mrs. Smith) in the collection, yea, to all who by their contributions or labours have shown interest in the Institution's welfare the Committee tenders most grateful thanks. Special mention may be made of

the Darlington Railwaymen's Carnival Committee for their continued interest in our work, their generous contribution to the funds is received with profound thankfulness.

# Gift in Kind.

Many and varied have been the gifts in kind received during the year—books, magazines, periodicals, etc., etc., too numerous to mention in detail. To all donors we tender thanks.

# Patients' Donations.

The donations received from patients during the year shows an increase of £172. No greater tribute to the Hospital services could be paid.

# New Memorial Hospital.

It is anticipated that within the next few weeks many of the Hospital Staff will be transferred to the New Administration Block. This is a step forward.

The Committee have decided to proceed with the erection of two and probably three Ward Blocks, with Operating Theatre and the necessary adjuncts; with the completion of three blocks 150 beds will be available, which is 50% more than is contained in the existing Hospital. Now that the Administration Block is completed, and is to be occupied by the Staff in the very near future, and the funds in hand (although insufficient to meet the full cost which will be incurred) justify a start being made with the New Ward Blocks, the Committee intend to go forward with that portion of the building which will give to the town and district a Hospital equal to its immediate needs. This course is to be pursued in the hope that the general public will endorse this policy of progress and render all the financial support necessary.

The Committee gratefully acknowledge receipt of many contributions during the year to the New Memorial Hospital Building Fund, particulars of which will be found on page (58).

# Conclusion.

The Committee cannot conclude this Report without again referring to the great and beneficent work carried on at the Institution, and large numbers of patients must be extremely grateful for the care and attention they have received, nor would this Report be complete without mention being made of the skill and devotion of the Medical and Surgical Staff, Matron, Sisters, Nurses, and all the other officers of the Institution, not

omitting the excellent services of the Honorary Auditor (Mr. J. W. Watson, A.C.A.), and the Press for all they have the interest of the Hospital.

# Annual Report

OF THE

# Ladies' Hospital Committee, 1928.

The monthly meetings (eleven in number) held during the year have been well attended.

Mrs. Rogerson, who has been a member of the Committee since 1905, has in consequence of leaving the district for approximately one year, tendered her resignation, which has been accepted for that period. Lady Pease has kindly consented to fill the vacancy.

The Committee has visited the Hospital regularly, and kept in close touch with the work of both the Nursing and Domestic Staff.

Patients and their friends have readily testified to the excellent attention given them, and have never hesitated to express their warm approval of the service rendered by the Institution. The devotion of the Staff to their duties is a feature of the Hospital.

Many changes have taken place in the personnel of the Nursing Staff, Sister Davies, after thirteen years' excellent service, has left to qualify for advancement in her profession. The Committee regret her departure, but Miss Davies takes with her the best wishes of all at the Hospital.

The limited accommodation in all parts of the Hospital is a great disadvantage, but everything possible is being done for the comfort of all concerned.

Special mention must be made of the regrettable Railway Disaster in June. The manner in which the Matron and Staff dealt with the unfortunate victims is most praiseworthy. In all, as a result of the accident, 30 patients were admitted to the Wards, and many more received first aid and hospitality before returning to their homes.

The following money-raising efforts have been made by the Committee with the assistance of the Matron and Staff:—

A "Pound Day," held on the 16th April, resulted in £50 4s. 10d. being received in cash, together with three pigs, 2,000 eggs and 997 lbs. of goods.

The Annual "Garden Fete," held at THE ELMS on 12th September, was very successful, the proceeds amounted to £266 10s. 4d. The Railwaymen's Carnival Committee contributed to the success by offering a bicycle as a prize.

Sir Chas. Starmer again assisted us in raising funds for the Xmastide festivities by opening his grounds to the general public. The Committee as well as the public appreciated his kindness. The display of Chrysanthemums merited the generous collection which was made.

The Linen League held its Annual Meeting in October, Mrs. E. Lloyd Pease was elected Chairman, and Mrs. Hartley, Honorary Secretary. The amount collected during the year for materials was £112 19s. 4d., and 1,690 garments were contributed. The Ladies' Committe thank all those who have given of their time and labour in this great work. It would be very pleasing to enlist more subscribers and workers, the needs of the present Hospital increases, and the Committee would like to make progress with supplies of linen, etc., for the New Hospital. Particulars can be had from Mrs. Hartley, 41, Stanhope Road.

The Hospital has again treated a record number of patients, and the Ladies' Committee congratulate the Matron and Staff on the performance of their duties under such exceptional conditions.

# ENDOWMENTS OF BEDS AND COTS.

A Legacy or Donation of £1,000 endows a bed in perpetuity. A Legacy or Donation of £500 endows a Cot in perpetuity.

Beds and Cots thus endowed will be indicated by brass plates bearing inscriptions in accordance with the wishes of the donor or subscriber.

This system of commemorating friends is of great value to the Hospital, and the Committee desire to draw attention to it, in the earnest hope that the example of the donors may be followed by other philanthropic friends.

WARD TABLETS AND COPIES OF INSCRIPTIONS.

SOLDIERS' WARD. This Ward is dedicated to the memory of Charles I'Anson, J.P., Fairfield House, in this town. He was one of the Hon. Secretaries of this Hospital from its commencement in Russell Street in 1864, until his death in 1884.

CHILDREN'S WING. This Tablet was placed here by the Committee of the Darlington Hospital and Dispensary in grateful recognition of the maintenance by the late Miss Emma Gurney Pease for many years of a Children's Hospital in Victoria Road, Darlington, which work has been taken over by and now forms part of this Institution, and towards which Miss Pease and her sister (Miss Jane Gurney Pease) contributed largely in many ways.

JOHN PEASE WARD. This Ward is dedicated to the memory of John Pease, of East Mount, in this town, the principal founder of the Hospital in Russell Street in 1864.

CHILDREN'S WING. Darlington Co-operative Society, Ltd., Jubilee Cot, 1868—1918.

SEWING ROOM. In memory of Sophia Whitfield, for 20 years the highly valued Matron of the Russell Street Hospital, Darlington, who died on the 24th December, 1884, aged 48 years, leaving by her Will upwards of £300 to the funds of this Institution.

NEW WING. Messrs. T. M. Barron and H. M. Graham, Executors of the Will of the late A. A. W. Cocks, Esq., of Low Middleton Hall, in this County, contributed out of the charitable funds bequeathed to them by the Will of Mr. Cocks, the sum of £2,500 towards the erection of the New Wing of this Hospital, and £2,500 towards the general maintenance fund of the Hospital.

HARTLEY WARD. This Ward is dedicated to the memory of John Hartley, F.R.C.S., who was one of the Honorary Surgeons of this Hospital from 1897 until his death in 1914. For 17 years he devoted himself ungrudgingly to the relief of the suffering patients.

HARTLEY WARD. This Piano is the result of the persevering

efforts of Mr. John Potter and the patients, and is intended to cheer and amuse those who may follow them in the Men' New

Ward. February, 1916.

GIFTS IN MEMORIAM.

HALL STATUTE. This Statute was presented by Mrs. James Edward Backhouse in memory of her uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Backhouse, who were warm supporters of the

Hospital. March, 1899.

Polystat. This Polystat was given by Mr. and Mrs. Brydon in memory of their son, Dr. John E. Brydon, who was House Surgeon in this Hospital from the 25th March, 1909, until the 15th April, 1910. He was gassed and died in France on the 26th June, 1917.

X-Ray Apparatus. This X-Ray Apparatus was presented by Mrs. J. E. Watson in memory of her nephew, Private John Albert Wilson, who fell in France on the 17th March, 1918.

Tablet Placed in Vestibule. To perpetuate the memory of his mother, Elizabeth Geldart, the sum of £7,602 was bequeathed to the Hospital by her son, John Edward Geldart, of Darlington, who died on the 28th July, 1913, and this Tablet has been erected by the Committee in appreciation of his generosity.




