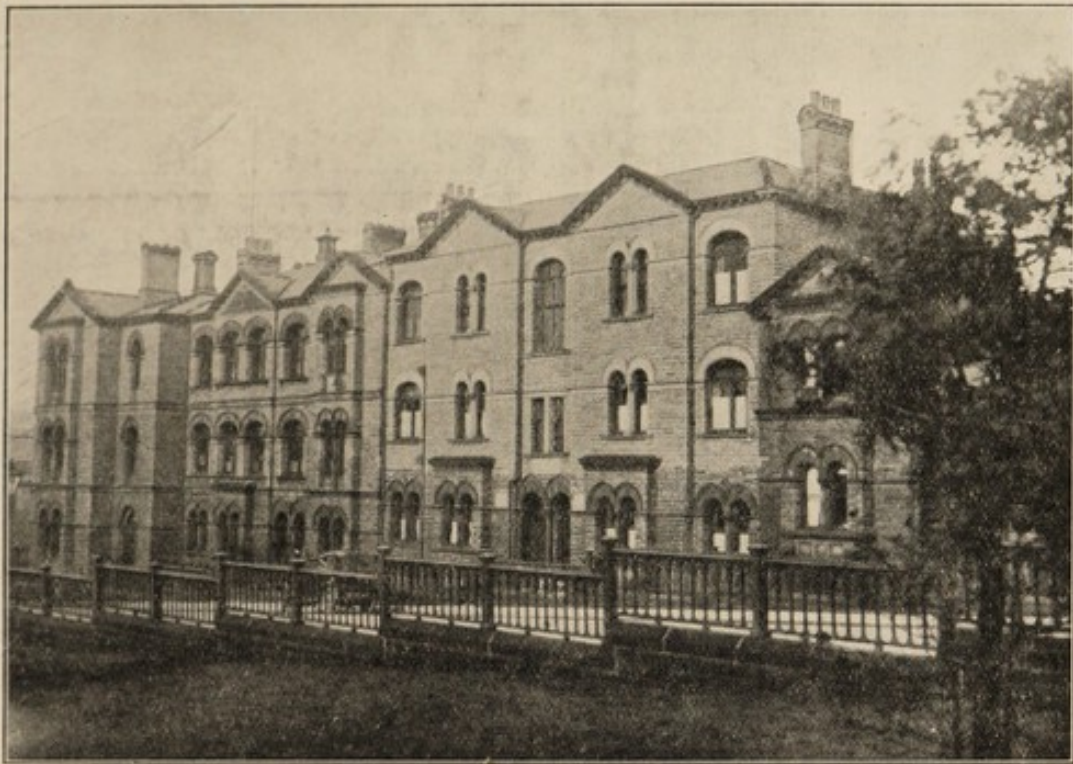
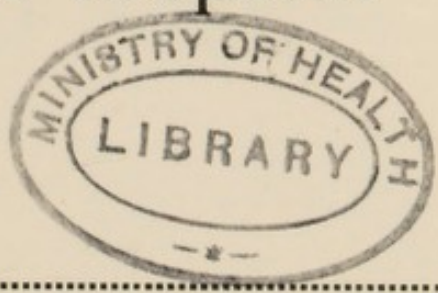

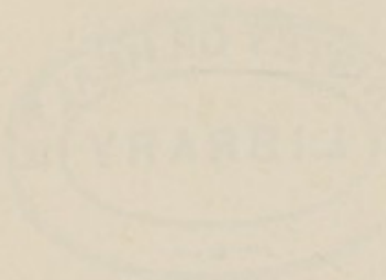

The Hospital has ten wards (public and private), with 30 beds, an up-to-date Operating Theatre, with sterilizing room adjoining, an X Ray Room and Waiting Room, a Massage Room, Board Room, Casualty Ward, Surgery and Waiting Rooms, Sun Ray and Radiant Heat Bath, excellent staff bedrooms and quarters, well-equipped kitchen, storage and sanitary facilities, and is served by an electric passenger lift which travels to all floors. The Hospital is heated by modern central heating as well as open fires.

The enlargement of the Hospital was completed, and formally opened on 21st April, 1928, by the Chairman of the Board, and is proving the necessity for the enlargement by the increased efficiency now displayed in the Hospital's work.

The Governors have pleasure in presenting the final statement of the Enlargement Fund, and rejoice to record that the whole cost has been subscribed. The Board tenders sincere and grateful thanks to the organizers and officers of the Shipley and District Hospital Week, which resulted in the raising of the magnificent sum of £2,005 12s. 5d. for the Hospital. The Board desire to place on record their appreciation of the energy, enthusiasm and devoted service of all who took part

in the attainment of this result, and their gratitude for the strenuous endeavours which were necessary to arrive at such a success. The proceeds were utilized, by the request of the Hospital Week Committee, in the liquidation of the balance needed to complete the Enlargement Fund (£988 1s. 2d.), £1,000 was added to the Endowment Fund, and the balance, £17 11s. 3d., was placed to General Account.

To many other persons and organizations the Governors offer thanks for generous support.

The Board asks for the continued and increased support of the Subscribers and Donors, in view of the greater expense now incurred in the upkeep of the Hospital. It is the aim of the Governors to continue to give the most efficient and sympathetic service to all those to whom the Hospital can be of benefit and assistance.

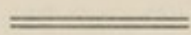
