Information useful to Subscribers

Recommendation Forms can only be used during the year for which they are issued. One Ticket entitles a patient to attend the Hospital for three months ; at the end of which time a fresh one is required.

There are no special in-patient recommendation forms ; such patients are admitted at the discretion of the Surgeons.

No food or intoxicating beverages are allowed to be introduced into the Hospital without the knowledge of the Matron.

Friends of in-patients are allowed to visit them on Wednesdays and Sundays from 2 till 4, but on no other day without special leave.

Out-patients not bringing their own bottles are charged 3d. each for large and 2d. for small bottles. By special arrangement with the Official Opticians, patients can purchase the spectacles ordered for them at greatly reduced prices.

At the first visit to the Hospital with a recommendation form, patients are given a card with a reference number on it ; this should always be quoted when enquiries are made concerning patients.

This Institution being established for the relief of those who are **POOR AND UNABLE TO PAY FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE**, subscribers are most urgently requested not to give these recommendation forms indiscriminately. In doubtful cases the Secretary will be pleased to advise as to the best course to pursue.

Surgeons' Report for 1940

The total number of patients treated during the year 1940 was 6,914, of whom 4,903 were new patients, while 2,011 were under treatment at the beginning of the year. The number admitted to the Wards as In-Patients was 1,728, and there were 17,230 attendances at the Out-Patient department. There were 2,146 operations performed during the year, of which 1,084 were major and 1,062 minor procedures, while in addition there were 489 patients requiring removal of foreign bodies from the eye.

Twenty-five cases of Ophthalmia Neonatorum were admitted.

Five deaths occurred, the causation being Meningitis (two cases), Pneumonia, Cavernous Sinus Thrombosis and a severe brain injury.

The most striking feature of the year's figures has been the increase in the work of all departments of the Hospital. Compared with the previous year the figures show an increase of 1,030 new patients, 3,770 attendances, 336 In-Patients and 240 operations. At the same time there was a decrease of 7 Ophthalmia cases and 15 operations for Mastoiditis. A reference to last year's report shows that this last item is particularly interesting, the figures for the last four years being as follows: 1937, 103; 1938, 108; 1939, 73; 1940, 58.

A very large number of men and women serving in H.M. Forces have been treated in the Out-Patient department and the Wards, and we have also dealt with numerous evacuees from all parts of the country.

We should like to take this opportunity of expressing our gratitude to our colleagues Mr. Edmond, Doctors Lavelle, Mackenzie, Rope, Stote and Symons and also to Mr. Hoggins, for their valued assistance.

We also desire to record our appreciation of the loyal services and efficiency of Dr. McGarrity, the Matron, Nursing Staff and Almoner, whose loyal co-operation has done much towards the success of the Hospital.

ANNUAL REPORT

Your Committee have pleasure in presenting their Annual Report covering the 123rd year of the Hospital's existence.

During the whole of the year we have been carrying on under the shadow of the War, and emergency beds have been kept free for the use of the Government Authorities. Happily, these have not been required, but the number of cases treated in the Wards and Out-Patients' Department is the highest for many years, as a glance at the figures appearing in the Surgeons' Report on page 3 will confirm. Subscribers will be interested to know that, during the year, cases applicable to the military or ancillary services put in 1,345 attendances in the Out-Patients' Department, and 1,818 Bed Days in the Wards, for which the Government accept financial responsibility.

Changes in Staff are unavoidable under present conditions ; on the whole we have been fortunate, and the work has been carried out most efficiently and to the satisfaction of your Committee. Dr. E. Gordon Laurence (who had been with us for some years as House Surgeon) is now acting as Assistant Surgeon, while Dr. McGarrity has returned to us as House Surgeon. We are also very glad to have with us again our Honorary Anæsthetist, Dr. A. V. Mackenzie. To Sister Spring, who recently left us to be married, we extend our good wishes and thank her for the many years of useful service she gave to this Hospital.

The largely increased number of attendances and operations, coupled with the inevitable rise in prices—not only of food but of everything else—has considerably increased the total outgoings. These factors have caused your Committee great anxiety, especially when it was observed that the Subscriptions and Donations fell consistently during the year. However, the situation has been made easier by (a) The Shropshire Voluntary Hospitals Contributory Association which contributed £2,612 1s. 7d., and the payments made for Military patients which amounted to £867.

While the falling off in Subscriptions and Donations is to be regretted, it must be remembered that many works and similar organisations which used to contribute under these headings are now included in the Contributory Association. Even so, we have suffered very considerably from the withdrawal of Subscriptions, due to the War and heavy taxation of incomes.

The Committee are indebted to Mrs. L. V. Morris who generously gave £500 to endow a cot in the Children's Ward. The ceremony of dedication was carried out by the Chaplain on the 6th November, 1940.

It is perhaps a distressing fact that finance plays such an important part in the work of our Voluntary Hospitals, and there are some who are only too ready to stress the difficulties of rising costs, high taxation, and the uncertainty of the future. While recognising that there is cause for concern, your Committee have every confidence that the Voluntary Hospitals will surmount these difficulties. In so doing, they will no doubt have to adjust themselves to changed conditions, but the Hospitals have now become a great co-operative movement in which there is an opportunity for every individual of every class to play his or her part, and we, who are responsible for the administration of your Hospital believe that, if we face the future with confidence in our supporters (and this confidence we possess) the Voluntary Hospitals will emerge successfully.

Your Committee base their confidence on the magnificent support which has been given to them by all classes of the community during the past year. To quote a few examples: The outstanding success of the Shropshire Voluntary Hospitals Contributory Association; the many subscribers and donors who have maintained—and in some cases increased—their contributions, notwithstanding the difficult times through which we are passing; the generosity of the lady who gave £500 to endow a cot; the numerous legacies from friends of the Hospital who have passed away; and lastly but by no means least in importance, the Trustees of the late Mr. Charles Clement Walker who kindly gave us £200 towards the purchase of heat storage cookers for the Kitchen.

Turning to the other side of the picture, there were, as is stated in the Surgeons' Report, 17,230 attendances in the Out-Patients' Department and 2,146 operations performed. The Hospital

has fifty-three beds, and during the year the average daily number in residence was forty-nine. When one remembers that a few beds must be kept vacant for emergencies, some idea will be obtained of the pressure at which the Staff have had to work during the year.

Speaking of the Staff, leads us to acknowledge in no formal manner their excellent work. The figures quoted in the preceding paragraph tell their own tale, but only those who come into contact with the actual working of the Hospital, know and realise the wealth of human endeavour contributed by the Staff in dealing with the numerous patients who come under their care. Your Committee thank Doctor Anderson, Doctor Laurence and all their co-workers for their skill and ability so ungrudgingly given at all times; they also express their gratitude to our Matron, Miss Robson, the Nurses and other members of the Staff, without whose aid and loyal co-operation it would be impossible to achieve the results of which mention has been made.

The Ladies' Guild continues to do excellent work, and during the year a very large number of articles of equipment and clothing have been supplied. To all the ladies who have helped in this connection we extend our grateful appreciation.

The St. John's Ambulance Brigade and The British Red Cross Society continue to give most valuable assistance which is gratefully acknowledged.

In conclusion, your Committee record their appreciation of the many gifts and kindnesses from Subscribers and Donors, and those responsible for Church and other Collections and Pound Days. Also to our friends the Press who are ever ready and willing to help us at all times.

RULES.

1.—This Institution shall be called “THE EYE, EAR AND THROAT HOSPITAL FOR SHROPSHIRE AND WALES.”

2.—The Officers of the Institution shall consist of a President ; not less than three Trustees who shall be Governors, in whom the property and funds of the Institution shall be vested ; Hon. Treasurer ; Hon. Consulting Surgeon ; Surgeons ; and a Committee of not less than nine Governors. The Committee shall retire yearly at the Annual General Meeting, which may re-elect them.

3.—Donors of £21 and upwards in one sum shall be Governors for life, Annual Subscribers of £1 1s. 0d. and upwards shall be Governors.

4.—The Annual General Meeting of the Governors shall be held upon a day not later than the 30th April in each year as the Committee shall appoint. Five Governors to form a quorum.

5.—Special Meetings of the Governors shall be called by the Secretary when necessary or when required (in writing) by any five of the Governors ; the Secretary to give 7 days' notice (by post or advertisement) of such Meeting, and to state in such notice in general terms the purpose for which such Meeting is convened, and no other business shall be transacted thereat.

6.—The Reports of the Committee and Surgeons, the statement of accounts for the past year, the list of subscribers and the Rules of the Institution shall be printed and circulated among the Governors prior to the presentation to the Annual Meeting.

7.—At the Annual Meeting a Committee shall be appointed consisting of nine or more Governors, the general business of the Institution transacted and any special business of which notice shall have been given as provided by the next rule. The President, Treasurer and Hon. Consulting Surgeons shall be respectively elected at the General Meeting, whether Annual or Special, which shall be first held after a vacancy in those offices respectively shall arise.

8.—A Governor desiring to bring forward any special business at the Annual General Meeting shall give notice thereof in writing to the Secretary 14 clear days before the date of such meeting.

9.—The President, Treasurer, and Senior Surgeon shall be *ex-officio* Members of the Committee.

10.—The Committee shall meet at the Hospital once in each month, and at such other times as any three of their number shall (by writing) require ; the Secretary to give three days' notice (by post or otherwise) of such Special Meeting, stating in such notice in general terms the purpose for which such meeting is convened, and no other business shall be transacted thereat.

Three Members of the Committee shall form a quorum for the despatch of business. At their first meeting following the Annual General Meeting the Committee shall elect one of their number to act as Chairman for the ensuing Hospital year, and minutes of the proceedings at all meetings shall be taken by the Secretary. The acts of the Committee for the time being shall be valid, notwithstanding any vacancy in their number.

11.—The Committee shall control, manage and superintend the affairs of the Institution, and shall have power to appoint Sub-Committees and to appoint and on occasion to dismiss all or any persons (other than the Hon. Officers) required to conduct the business of the Institution.

The Trustees shall not exceed five in number. In the case of death, resignation or bankruptcy of any one or more of the Trustees, the vacancy may, so long as there are still three surviving or continuing Trustees, be filled up at the next Annual General Meeting, but in case at any time the number shall be reduced to less than three, one or more new Trustees shall be immediately elected by the Committee, subject to confirmation at the next Annual General Meeting. On any such appointment the Trust Fund and Securities may be vested in such new and continuing Trustees (if any) jointly, or the Trustees shall be empowered, if they think fit, to place the Trust Funds and the Securities representing the same and the real property of the Hospital in the sole name of Lloyds Bank Limited as Custodian Trustees.

12.—The Committee shall have power to request the Trustees to invest all monies which in their opinion are not required for current expenses at the Institution. Any sums of money which the Trustees may receive for investment of which they may be requested by the Committee to invest shall be invested by them in their own names or in the names of not less than three of them in some or one of the stocks, funds or securities not being bearer securities or transferable by mere delivery and endorsement hereinafter mentioned or referred to, that is to say in any stocks, funds or securities in which Trustees are authorised by law to invest (except real securities in Ireland) or in the preferred ordinary stock of any Railway Company in Great Britain, in the guaranteed or Preference Stock of which Trustees are authorised to invest by law as aforesaid or in the Debenture Stock of the Buenos Ayres Great Southern Railway or in the Stocks or Bonds of the Mersey Docks

and Harbour Board, or of the Corporation of Shrewsbury, or of the Shrewsbury Gas Light Company, or any security specially authorised by a resolution of the Committee.

The Trustees shall (in addition to the ordinary power of varying investments) have power at any time at the request of the Committee to sell and convert into money any Stocks, funds or securities held by them and to apply the proceeds in effecting any improvement in the Hospital which may be thought necessary or desirable or in purchasing additional property for the purposes of the Institution, or in meeting the liabilities of the Institution, but (except in case of special urgency) the Committee shall, before making request for any such sale or conversion as aforesaid, submit the matter to the Governors at an Annual or Special Meeting.

The Trustees shall have and exercise a discretion in the continuance of any investments standing in their names, but shall not be bound to require the realisation of any security unless thereto requested by the Committee, and no Trustee shall be liable for any loss which may arise by reason of the insufficiency of any investment or the depreciation thereof. All such requests by the Committee to the Trustees shall be made by way of resolution, duly entered on the minutes of the Committee and communicated in writing to the Trustees.

13.—Any Candidate for the office of Surgeon must be a Medical Practitioner duly qualified and registered in the United Kingdom, and must have attended for not less than six months the Clinical Practice of some Ophthalmic Hospital, or of the Ophthalmic Department of some General Hospital, in which not less than 20 beds are set apart for Eye patients, and must have spent not less than six months in the Special Study of the diseases of the Ear and Throat, and possess such other qualifications as the Committee shall from time to time require. He shall produce his certificate of registration and (if required) a certificate of age.

Any Surgeon or Assistant Surgeon having completed his sixtieth year of age shall, *ipso facto*, cease to hold his appointment, but the age of retirement may be extended for a period not exceeding five years at the discretion of the Committee of Management should they consider it in the interests of the Hospital.

If any of the Surgeons from ill-health or other unavoidable cause be unable for a lengthened period to attend to his duties, the Committee may then make such temporary arrangements as shall seem to them necessary.

14.—All questions at any meeting shall be determined by a majority of the Governors present thereat ; every Governor shall have one vote, and the Chairman a casting vote in addition, when necessary.

15.—The Annual Subscriptions shall be payable in advance, and be due on the 1st January in each year, and unless notice of withdrawals shall have been given in writing to the Treasurer or Secretary one month at least before the 1st January, the Governor shall be considered to continue his or her subscription. No Governor shall vote at any meeting if his or her subscription for the previous year be not paid, nor unless he or she shall have been a Subscriber for two months preceding such Meeting.

16.—The Hospital shall be opened Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays only (Bank Holidays excepted), at such hours as shall be appointed for the Relief of the Poor suffering from the diseases of the Eye, Ear and Throat, who shall be admitted by the Governors' Recommendations, and be treated gratuitously for the space of three months. Cases of accidents shall at all times be eligible for admission without recommendations.

17.—**The Institution being established for the relief of those who are poor and unable to pay for medical assistance, the Senior Surgeon shall have full power to decline to treat any person who is in his opinion able to pay for treatment as provided at this Hospital, reporting the same to the Committee at their next meeting.**

18.—No woman advanced in pregnancy, no person insane, suspected of having any infectious disease, subject to epileptic fits, or suffering from advanced pulmonary tuberculosis, shall be admitted as an In-patient.

19.—Annual Subscribers of 10s. 6d. or donors of £10 10s. shall be entitled to recommend one patient annually, and annual subscribers of one guinea, or donors of £21 0s. 0d. shall be entitled to recommend three patients annually. Such subscribers and donors only can purchase additional recommendations, price 10s. 6d. each.

20.—Every Clergyman or Minister of Religion who shall make collections in his Church or Chapel for the benefit of the Institution shall be entitled to two recommendations for the then current year for each guinea remitted.

21.—Members of Approved Societies who are eligible for Ophthalmic Benefit shall not be given a Recommendation Form, but must make the usual arrangements with their Society for treatment through their own Medical Practitioner.

22.—Recommendations shall only be available for the year for which they are issued.

23.—When patients living at a distance from Shrewsbury require constant attention, or when living in Shrewsbury, cannot (by reason of poverty) find a lodging suitable for the proper treatment of their case, discretionary power shall be given to the Surgeons to admit them as In-patients. No patient shall remain at the maintenance of the Hospital beyond the period of three months without the special sanction of the Committee.

24.—A Book shall be kept at the Hospital, in which the name, age, residence, and disease of every Patient, and by whom and when recommended, and when and with what result discharged, shall be entered by the Surgeons, which book shall be at all times open to the inspection of the Governors.

25.—If patients are irregular in attendance or neglect the directions of the Surgeons, they may, provided that the Senior Surgeon agrees, be discharged, and the circumstances of the case shall be reported to the Governor recommending and to the Committee at their next meeting.

26.—A limited number of beds shall be used for the reception of such paying Patients as the Committee of Management from time to time may deem to be eligible. The charge to paying Patients shall be four guineas per week or such other charge as the Committee of Management may from time to time fix.

27.—Subscriptions shall be received by the Treasurer, and by the Secretary ; and the Secretary shall pay over to the Treasurer all sums received by him not later than three days from the date of such receipt.

28.—An Auditor, or Auditors, who shall be a Member or Members of the Institute of Chartered Accountants, or of the Incorporated Society of Accountants and Auditors, appointed by the Annual General Meeting, shall annually examine the accounts with the vouchers and personally inspect all the securities of the Institution, and shall prepare and certify a statement of accounts to be produced or read at the Annual General Meeting.

29.—The powers of making, altering and repealing rules shall be vested only in the Annual General Meeting, but no motion for any new rule or for the repeal or alteration of any existing rule shall be considered unless a written notice thereof shall have been given to the Secretary at least 14 days before the day of meeting. The Secretary shall give to the Governors notice in writing of all such proposed motions not less than 7 days before the day of meeting.

30.—A Donation of £1,000 shall entitle the donor to dedicate a bed, and a Donation of £500 to dedicate a cot, but these sums may be varied at the discretion of the Committee.

This Hospital is one of the Constituents of the Shropshire Voluntary Hospitals Contributory Association, members whereof are not required to produce a recommendation form, but, in place of it, the official voucher of the Contributory Scheme certifying membership, together with a letter signed by their private doctor addressed to the Hospital.

OPHTHALMIC BENEFIT.

Most Approved Societies have adopted what is known as Ophthalmic (Additional) Benefit, under which there are available private consultations with specially qualified medical men, and which entitles their members to examination of the eyes and, if necessary, to a prescription for spectacles.

In cases where a member of the Scheme belongs to a Society which provides Ophthalmic Benefit, he should consult his panel doctor, who, if he thinks that the patient needs ophthalmic examination or treatment, will inform the patient how to proceed.

If the Approved Society to which the member belongs does not provide Ophthalmic Benefit, then he is eligible for treatment, either as a contributor or by recommendation.
