





# DEVELOPMENT.

# Extension Scheme.

Considerable time and thought has been given to the question of the provision of additional accommodation for in-patients, referred to in last year's Report, with the result that a scheme has been adopted, which when carried out, will increase the total number of beds in the Hospital to 189.

The Scheme is to build two ward units of two storeys each. Each ward unit will be self-contained with ward kitchen, clinic room, lavatory and bath room, sluice room and linen rooms. These ward units will give an increase of 108 beds, but when certain suggested alterations to the existing buildings are carried out, this number will be reduced by 23, giving a total increase of 85 beds.

# Paying Patients.

Special single bed wards will be provided for observation purposes, and for patients who may wish to take advantage of the Hospital service and at the same time are able and willing to pay.





# Cost.

It is estimated that the approximate cost of carrying out the whole scheme will be

# FIFTY THOUSAND POUNDS.

A CONTRACT WILL BE PLACED FOR THE FIRST PORTION OF THE EXTENSIONS COMPRISING ONE UNIT OF TWO WARDS, EACH CONTAINING 24 BEDS AND 3 SINGLE BED WARDS, AND IT IS HOPED THAT THE ACCOMMODATION WILL BE AVAILABLE IN ABOUT TWELVE MONTHS.

# Other Services.

Particulars relating to the number of patients will be found on page 16 & 17, and attention is called to the fact that once again the figures show a large increase over those of the preceding year. During the whole of the year the capacity of the wards has been taxed to the utmost. The attendances at the Ear, Nose and Throat, and the Artificial Sunlight Departments continue to grow.

# FINANCE.

For the purpose of easy comparison with the previous year, the figures for the year ended 31st December, 1927, are tabulated in the margin of the Accounts which are published with this Report.

The Committee are glad to report that the income for the past year again shows an increase. Close supervision has been exercised over expenditure, and the average cost per patient per day shews favourably when compared with any other hospital in the country.

The excess of income over expenditure for the year amounts to £457 15s. 2d.

It cannot be emphasised too clearly that the additional wards will call for still greater efforts in order that sufficient income may be raised to meet the substantial additional expenditure which will be necessary when the New Wards are available for use.

# Items of Income.

It will be observed that Workpeoples' Contributions, Annual Subscriptions, Donations and Friendly Societies' Contributions show an improvement.

The Committee particularly wish to thank the Workpeoples' Committee for their consistent and increasing support year by year, and for the keen interest taken in all matters concerning the work of the Hopsital.

# Special Items of Expenditure.

Instruments and Appliances show an increase of nearly £600 and it should be explained that this is principally due to the purchase of a new power unit for the X-ray plant at a cost of over £500. The provision of this has been the means of obtaining X-ray photographs of greater clearness and fuller detail and owing to the shorter length of exposure necessary, resulting in a more rapid and efficient service.

A low pressure heating apparatus has been installed in the X-ray and Massage Department, at a cost of £100. This should result in a saving of fuel and will enable the department to be kept warm day and night, and so protect the X-ray and Electrical equipment from possible damage.

The Guest Hospital offers to those who may be considering the disposition of their property and who are interested in philanthropic work a fitting object for their benevolence.

The market value of the Hospital investments as at 31st December, 1928, was £87,284 16s. 6d., compared with £87,126 8s. 5d. the previous year.

During the year the four main Wards have been redecorated at a cost of £74. Other portions of the Hospital are in need of painting and cleaning and additional expense in this direction must be looked for.

The purchase of provisions, fuel, drugs, dressings and other commodities has received careful attention, and competitive quotations obtained at frequent and regular intervals.

A number of Subsidary Electricity Meters have been installed with a view to the consumption in the various wards and other departments being compared and checked.

# The Trustees of the Hospital.

It is with regret the Committee have to record the death of Mr. J. S. Evers-Swindell, J.P., who was a Trustee of the Hospital for a period of 22 years. Mr. W. H. Thompson (Vice-Chairman of the Committee of Management) has been appointed a Trustee to fill the vacancy.

# The Late Georgina, Dowager Countess of Dudley.

In past years the late Georgina Dowager Countess of Dudley was a frequent visitor to the Hospital, and took an active interest in efforts made on its behalf. She frequently made enquiries as to its welfare and progress, and the Committee extend their deep sympathy to the Rt. Hon. the Earl of Dudley and his family in their bereavement.

# The late Mr. William Hardwick.

By the death of Mr. William Hardwick of Tipton, the Institution has lost a loyal and devoted friend. For over 20 years Mr. Hardwick was an enthusiastic member of the Workpeoples' Committee and his wise counsel and ready help in connection with the efforts of that body were greatly appreciated.

# MEDICAL AND SURGICAL STAFF.

It is with deep regret the Committee record the serious and prolonged illness of Dr. H. C. Brown, who has been an Honorary Physician for 24 years.

The growth of the X-ray work has rendered necessary the appointment of a Clinical Assistant and Dr. Rigby, D.M.R.E., L.R.C.P. has been elected Clinical Assistant to the X-ray Department and his services have already proved of great benefit to the Hospital.

Dr. J. Wilson, having left the district, has resigned his position of Honorary Anaesthetist.

Dr. D. G. Lloyd, M.R.C.S., L.R.C.P., and Dr. J. MacIntyre, M.B., Ch.B., having completed their term of service as House Surgeons, resigned during the year and were succeeded by Dr.W. H. Shilvock, M.B., B.Ch., as House Surgeon and Dr. J. Horwich, M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., as Assistant House Surgeon.

# CONCLUSION.

In conclusion, the Committee desire to place on record their appreciation of the assistance of the numerous honorary workers who have rendered assistance to the Institution during the year, and particularly the Honorary Medical and Surgical Staff, the Honorary Chaplain (Canon A. H. Phelips, M.A.), the Honorary Solicitor (Mr. H. P. Bagott), the Honorary Auditor (Mr. D. Tanfield, F.C.A.), the Honorary Treasurer (Mr. G. F. Chamberlain), the Honorary Consulting Engineer (Ald. F. J. Ballard, J.P.), and the Secretarial and Nursing Staff of the Hospital.

The Committee also desire to express their thanks to Mr. A. T. Butler, F.R.I.B.A., for his advice on matters relating to the fabric of the Institution and to Mr. James Gough, Chartered Accountant, for preparing the accounts for audit.

Special mention must be made of the continued support given by the Ladies of the Linen League, who have again saved the Hospital many pounds by their enthusiasm and work, the Hospital Sunday Fund Committee, the Efforts Committee and the Alexandra Rose Day Committee, who have once again given generous help to the finances of the Hospital.

Thanks are also due to the religious organisations of the district for contributions in kind from Harvest Festivals, the organisers of Harvest Festivals held at Hotels and Inns and many others who have rendered valuable assistance in various ways during the year.

A particular word of thanks must be given to the local Press for their help in bringing to the notice of the public the requirements of the Hospital and recording the services rendered, and to the Police Force of the Borough of Dudley and the surrounding districts for their ready help at all times.

# MEDICAL REPORT.

# TABLE 1.

During the above period 2,034 cases were admitted to the Wards which, with 74 remaining on December 31st, 1927, make a total of 2,108 under treatment as In-patients.

Of these 838 were men, 490 women, and 780 children.

The number discharged cured was 1,793, relieved 105, unrelieved 12, left against medical advice 5, died 100.

The percentage of cured and relieved was 94.0, and the percentage of deaths was 5.0.

Of the total number of 100 deaths, 29 patients died within 24 hours of admission. In addition 7 had sustained fatal injuries, or were moribund from other causes, and died within 48 hours.

The average number of days' stay in fatal cases was 8.2.

The average number of beds occupied daily was 91, and the average stay in hospital was 16.6 days.

## THE GUEST HOSPITAL, DUDLEY.

#### EXTRACT FROM THE RULES.

- 7. As regards persons who were Subscribers prior to 1st October, 1920, Annual Subscriptions shall be due at Michaelmas in each year, and as regards persons who became Subscribers on or after 1st October, 1920, Annual Subscriptions shall be due one year from the date of payment of their first Annual Subscription. All subscriptions shall be payable in advance, and every Subscriber shall be considered as continuing until he sends a written notice of withdrawal to the Secretary, and no Subscriber shall vote whose subscription shall be more than six months in arrear.
- 41. Subscribers shall be entitled to one In-patient ticket for each guinea subscribed, and Donors of twenty-five guineas shall be entitled to two In-patient tickets yearly. Subscribers of half a guinea shall be entitled to three Out-patient tickets yearly; and In-patient and Out-patient tickets shall be interchangeable, on application to the Secretary, at the rate of six Out-patient tickets for one In-patient ticket.
- 42. Every Clergyman, or other Minister of Religion, making a collection, shall, on payment thereof, be entitled to one In-patient ticket for each guinea collected, and to Out-patient tickets as provided in Rule 41.
- 43. Any body of Workmen, subscribing in a collective capacity, shall be entitled to one In-patient ticket for each guinea contributed, and to Out-patient tickets as provided in Rule 41.
- 44. Any Representative duly appointed in writing by any body of Workpeople, Club, or Society, subscribing in one year not less than five guineas; any Clergyman, or other Minister, or duly appointed Representative of any Congregation subscribing by collection in one year not less than five guineas; and any person collecting in one year not less than five guineas; shall, on payment thereof, and so long as such payment continues to be annually made, have a vote at the Annual and Special General Meetings, and shall be eligible for election on the Committee.
- 31. No persons shall be admitted as In-patients but such as are unable to obtain advice and medicine, and none shall be admitted without a recommendation from a Trustee, Subscriber or Donor, except in cases of urgency, or cases that require an immediate surgical operation, and only

surgical casualty cases shall be treated in the Out-patient department. Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 31, Private Patients may be admitted to the Hospital on payment of a fee of not less than two guineas per week, provided always that room for such Private Patient is available in the Hospital, and that such cases be admitted only on the recommendation of one of the Honorary Surgeons or Physicians, and with the approval of the Weekly Board.

- 32. No woman near the time of her confinement, no person in consumption, or disordered in mind, or subject to epileptic fits, or having or suspected to have the small-pox, or other infectious distemper, incurable ulcers, or primary venereal disease, or judged to be not capable of being benefitted, shall be admitted as a patient, except with the consent of the Weekly Board. Except that for the purpose of carrying out the recommendations made by the Local Government Board on the 12th July, 1916, for the prevention and treatment of Venereal Diseases, and any further recommendations made by the Board for the same or a like purpose, the Committee may from time to time enter into any Agreements they think proper, with the Council of the County Borough of Dudley or other Local or County Authorities, notwithstanding that such Agreements may not be in accordance with or may be in opposition to the Rules for the government of the Hospital for the time being, but in settling the terms of such Agreements they shall endeavour so insure that the whole of the expenditure incurred by the Hospital shall be reimbursed by the Council entering into the Agreement, and for the purposes of carrying out these recommendations the Committee may elect and appoint such medical or other officers, either paid or unpaid, as they may consider necessary, and in such manner and subject to such regulations as they may think fit.
- 33. Each In-patient shall be allowed to remain in the Hospital (if the case requires it) for a period not exceeding two weeks for one ticket of admission, and, with the approval of the Honorary Surgeon or Physician, may be re-admitted for an additional period of two weeks on obtaining a second ticket, but not longer. If, however, one of the Honorary Consulting Surgeons or Honorary Consulting Physicians shall certify to the Weekly Board that there is a probability of a cure being effected, the Weekly Board may authorise the re-admission of such Patient for such a period as they think fit, subject to the Patient obtaining a further ticket for each period of two weeks. Out-patients shall be allowed to attend for a similar period for each Out-patient ticket, and under similar conditions. In-patients shall be allowed, on being discharged, to attend the Out-patient Department (if the case requires it) for the then unexpired period of any such ticket, but not longer, unless they obtain an Out-patient ticket. Patients who require a minor operation which does not necessitate their remaining in the Hospital for a longer period than two days, shall be admitted for four Out-patient tickets.

#### IN-PATIENTS.

THE GENERAL RULES OF THE HOSPITAL APPLY.

#### **OUT-PATIENTS.**

The Hon. Ophthalmic Surgeon, Mr. B. H. St. Clair Roberts, attends at the Hospital every Thursday Afternoon from 2 o'clock.

Accidents and Emergencies will receive attention at any time.

No patient will receive treatment without a ticket after the first visit.

Bottles will be supplied at a charge of from 4d. each, which will be repaid when the bottle is returned properly washed.

#### SPECTACLES AND ARTIFICIAL EYES.

The financial position of the Hospital will not admit of the supplying of Spectacles free of charge.

Artificial Eyes will be supplied in exchange for One In-patient Ticket.

On application to the Secretary, One In-Patient Ticket may be exchanged for Six Out-Patient Tickets, or Six Out-Patient Tickets for One In-Patient (or they will be accepted as equal to an In-Patient Ticket).
