## Annual Report of the Committee of Management

For the Year 1928.

The Committee of Management beg to submit to the Governors, Subscribers and Donors their Report for the year 1928.

#### Opening Ceremony.

The chief event of the year was the opening of the Extension on the 3rd of August by Sir Alfred D. Fripp, K.C.V.O., F.R.C.S., who, in the presence of a large and represent ative gathering, was supported by the Mayor (Alderman W. P. Hunt, J.P.), the Sheriff (Councillor A. E. F. Cornwell), and the Members of the Committee of Management. To Sir Alfred Fripp for his kindness in coming and for the interest he shewed in the Hospital the Committee would tender their grateful thanks.

By this very important step forward the Hospital will now be able better to meet the growing demands of the extensive area it is called on to serve.

With these additions, the Committee were enabled, some considerable time before the end of the year, to increase the Bed Accommodation to 102 Beds and Cots, and the urgent need for these additions has shown itself very clearly in the increased number of occupied beds.

The main features of the new wing are as follows :

 New Children's Wards to accommodate 24 patients. with sun-verandahs (which are glazed with Vita-Glass) and gardens. 2. Isolation Wards.

3. New Nurses' Home.

4. New Kitchens and Pantries.

#### In-Patients.

The average daily number of available beds and cots for the year was 81.51 as against 60 for 1927. This figure of 81.51 as against the full accommodation of 102 existing at the end of the year is accounted for by the fact that after the date of the Opening Ceremony advantage was taken of re-furnishing and re-equipping existing wards and, therefore, it was not until later in the year that the full accommodation was available.

The number of cases treated to a conclusion was 1,083, an increase of 79 over the previous year. The number of babies born was 69.

The average daily number of occupied beds was 77.74. The number for 1927 was 70.99, an increase in round figures of 7 beds per day.

The average number of days each patient was resident in the Hospital was 25.70, a slight increase on last year's figures.

The number of major operations performed during the year was 881 as against 732; an increase of 149, or in other words an addition of 20% on the 1927 figure.

#### Out-Patient Department.

The number of new cases recorded was 5,360, an increase of no less than 1,471, and the attendances in this Department attained no less a figure than 22,918.

Of the new cases recorded, this Department had to bear the heavy burden of 832 casualties.

Minor operations totalled 375. For the preceding year the number was 446.

In the Dental Department the number of extractions reached 1,700.

It is felt that mention must be made that 2,167 films were used in the X-Ray Department. This Department has been extremely hard worked, and the cost has consequently been a heavy one but, on the other hand, the importance of the Department can be gauged by the use that has been made of it.

#### Statistics.

On pages 26 to 34 will be found Statistical Tables on the year's work, together with the costs.

These figures are regarded as being very satisfactory, and show the efforts that are being made to meet the increased demands on the Hospital's services.

#### Revenue.

It is very gratifying for your Committee to be able to report that the Income of the Hospital shows an increase of  $\pounds 1,710$  as compared with the previous year. This increase is due mainly to two reasons, the one being the splendid way our supporters and friends have rallied to our aid, and the other an increase in receipts for services rendered.

#### Expenditure.

On this side of the account the total of  $\pounds 10,632$  is shown, an increase of  $\pounds 612$  over last year's figure. An increase, of course, was to be expected, in view of the extension of the Hospital and the greater demands made on its services. It is important, however, to bear in mind that in the increase of  $\pounds 612$ is the interest of  $\pounds 237$  19s. 0d. charged on the Extension Fund overdraft, which normally the account would not have to bear. So soon as we are able to liquidate the debt on the Building Fund, this item will disappear.

However, as is shown, this increase in expenditure has been offset in no uncertain manner by a very much larger increase in receipts. The excess of Income over Expenditure for this year was  $\pounds 634$  7s. 4d.

#### Balance Sheet.

The deficit on the Balance Sheet of the General Fund has now been reduced from  $\pounds707$  18s. 5d. to  $\pounds48$  12s. 11d., and for this very satisfactory state of affairs your Committee gratefully thank all the supporters who made this possible. Owing to the rapid growth of the Hospital it was felt that the time had come when the services of a whole time paid Secretary were required. After very careful consideration of the qualifications of applicants for the post, the Committee appointed Mr. E. S. Foley. Mr. Foley after working for four years in the Bolingbroke Hospital, came with very high testimonials and the Committee feel sure his experience will prove of great value to the Hospital.

The Committee would like to take this opportunity of thanking Mr. H. Kendall for all the work he has done and the time he has so ungrudgingly given as Honorary Secretary of the Hospital for 18 years. They feel that much of its success and growth has been due to his efforts, and they hope they may continue to have the benefit of his experience on the Committee.

#### Carnival Committee.

The Poole Carnival Committee have again made a very handsome donation of £586 to the funds and this Committee would tender to them and to all who by their voluntary efforts and support enabled them to achieve such a splendid result, their grateful thanks. In addition to this the Hospital Fair Committee, with the assistance of the Carnival Committee, were able to hand over to the Hospital the large sum of £423 11s. 1d. To Mrs. Trevanion, the organizer, and all who so ably helped her, this great success is due, and to them the Committee tender also their very grateful thanks.

#### Subscriptions and Donations.

During the year many generous donations were received, and if reference is made to the lists published in the Report, it will be seen how strong has been the support to the Committee, and how much interest has been taken in the Hospital's welfare.

#### Endowment and Extension Funds.

It is with very much pleasure that your Committee are able to record the continued interest and generous support that the Funds are receiving by Mr. George Pope's munificence. During the year Mr. Pope gave the sum of  $f_{1,000}$  to be equally divided between the Endowment Fund and the Extension Fund. For this very valuable help, heartfelt thanks are tendered to Mr. Pope.

#### Ladies' Collecting Committee.

The Ladies' Collecting Committee have again obtained a magnificent collection totalling  $\pounds 588$  3s. 4d. This splendid result exceeds that of last year by over  $\pounds 26$ , and they are to be congratulated on the success which attends the very hard work of their yearly effort.

#### Honorary Medical and Surgical Staff.

Owing to the great increase in the work of the Hospital, the Honorary Medical and Surgical Staff has been considerably augmented, and during the year the following additional appointments were made.

Mr. S. Gordon Luker—Surgeon to the Department of Gynaecology and Obstetrics.

Dr. E. S. Bowes-Medical and Surgical Registrar.

Dr. S. F. Durrans-Assistant Anaesthetist.

Dr. N. H. R. Hatfield-Assistant Anaesthetist.

Dr. J. A. Walker-Assistant Anaesthetist.

Grateful thanks are accorded to the Honorary Medical and Surgical Staff, whose skilled services and devotion have assisted so much towards the Hospital's advancement and the effective treatment of its patients.

Owing to his accepting another appointment which necessitated his leaving the district, it was with great regret that your Committee accepted Mr. S. King Hutton's resignation of his appointment as Surgeon. All connected with the Hospital know only too well how ungrudgingly Mr. Hutton gave of his services in the treatment of all who came under his care, and in recognition of his devotion to the Hospital's welfare, he was invited to accept an appointment as Honorary Consulting Surgeon, and we are pleased to record that thereby Mr. S. King Hutton remains on the Staff.

The vacancy caused by Mr. Hutton's resignation was filled by the appointment of Mr. Noel F. Adeney as Surgeon, and in consequence of the vacancy that arose through Mr. Adeney's appointment, Mr. J. M. Slater was appointed Assistant Surgeon. To the House Surgeon, the Matron, and the Nursing Staff, the Committee of Management acknowledge their appreciation of their devotion to duty, and the care and kindness they have shown to the benefit of the patients.

It is with pride that your Committee are able to announce that the Hospital is now recognised by the General Nursing Council as a complete Training School. This is an important step forward, and it is fully recognised how valuable to the Hospital's interests is the approval thus obtained.

It is with much regret that the resignation of Mr. O. R. Ward from the Committees is reported, and it is desired to acknowledge the valuable help and ready assistance which Mr. Ward at all times so freely gave.

Thanks are due to Mr. E. Osman Brown for so kindly installing a very valuable wireless set, and for this generous gift the patients' gratitude is also conveyed.

Throughout the year patients have received the very kind services rendered by Miss Elsa Van Goethem. Miss Van Goethem has put in a considerable amount of gratuitous work in the Massage Department, and her generosity has, in no small measure, relieved the Hospital of much expense.

In addition to these services she has also made valuable gifts of equipment to the Department, and for her services and her donations, grateful thanks are rendered.

For their interest in, and the help they have given to, the patients, grateful acknowledgement is made of the services given so freely by the Rev. Canon W. Okes Parish, R.D., and the Rev. J. D. Jones.

Acknowledgement with thanks is made for the professional services which Messrs. Dickinson, Yeatman & Manser (Honorary Solicitors) and Messrs. F. G. Wheatley, Pearce & Co. (Honorary Auditors) so generously placed at the disposal of the Committee.

Until her illness, Miss N. Curtis helped considerably to cheer the patients by her services in the capacity of Honorary Librarian, and it is hoped that Miss Curtis will soon be fully restored to health, and able again to take up her duties.

To all the very kind friends who have continually borne the Hospital in mind, by sending Provisions, Flowers, Books, etc., many thanks are due, and given. Many valuable contributions to the Stores were made as the result of the Harvest Festivals, and for this practical and useful assistance, appreciation is expressed to all the generous donors. St. Luke's Guild, during the year, very kindly assisted in providing Bedding Equipment, and this relief to the Hospital's Funds is accordingly acknowledged.

To all those kind friends who responded to the Matron's appeal during the Festive Season, and thereby contributed to the patients' enjoyment during Christmas, many thanks are accorded.

In closing this Report, the Committee of Management desire to appeal for new and increased support to enable them to meet the additional responsibilities that are now thrown on them by the Hospital's extension. Much can be done by those who are already interested, and who so kindly give, if they will plead the Hospital's cause among their friends. It is obvious that, with the increased bed accommodation, the maintenance expenditure must assume greater proportions. Every item in this latter connection is rigorously controlled, and this should encourage supporters to continue their practical interest in the Hospital's welfare.

In view of the progress that has been made during the year, coupled with an improved Balance Sheet, the Committee of Management look forward with confidence to the future.

#### PA'TIENTS' PAYMENTS.

Patients will in future be asked to pay the cost of their maintenance in Hospital if their circumstances permit, but Members of the Hospital Contributory Scheme will have the following privileges :—

They and their dependents will be exempted :--

- 1. From any enquiry as to means.
- From any payment either as an In-patient or Outpatient.

**Contributors** are those who have paid, or authorized their employers to deduct 3d. per week from their wages for the benefit of the Hospital.

Such contribution covers the following **Dependents**: Wives and children under sixteen, parents, grandparents and brothers and sisters living with and dependent upon the Contributor.

Persons who are ordered treatment by any Public Authority and women admitted for confinement are not eligible for free treatment and maintenance.

The decision as to whether any case is suitable for hospital treatment and as to the order of priority in which applicants are admitted lies with the Medical Staff, and therefore a letter from the Contributor's Medical Adviser must accompany all applications, except in cases of accident or sudden illness.

Entrance Forms can be obtained on application to the Hospital.
